# **Testing Information**

# The Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS) Test

TELPAS is an assessment program developed by the Texas Education Agency for students in Texas public schools who are learning the English language. Texas annually assesses the English language proficiency of students who have been identified as English learners (ELs) in four language domains—listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

Testing Window: February 19 – March 7, 2025

Audience: Students identified as English learners

#### Spring TSIA2 Testing available at Westside High School for Seniors

The Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2) is a series of tests for students enrolling in public colleges and universities in Texas. The tests help Texas schools determine whether a student is ready for college-level courses in the areas of reading, writing, and math.

Not all Texas college students have to take TSIA2. If your student has met college readiness standards on a standardized test like the SAT, they may be <u>exempt</u>. NOTE: SAT Scores are available in your student's <u>College Board</u> account.

#### **SAT School Day**

SAT® School Day allows states, districts, and schools to offer juniors the opportunity to take the SAT during their regular school day at their home school, expanding access to a globally recognized college admission test.

- Test Date: Wednesday, April 2, 2025 Audience: All 11th grade students
- No registration necessary
- FREE
- Students will need a photo ID and their laptop and charger on test day.

For the 25th consecutive year, Westside wrestling will be represented at the State Championships.

Seniors Santiago Ramirez and Jamarion Moore both dominated their way to the regional finals and secured their spots the UIL State championships this weekend.

This will be the second consecutive year for Moore, while Ramirez became only the second wrestler in school history to become a FOUR TIME STATE QUALIFIER.

Ramirez also was voted UIL Region III MOST OUTSTANDING WRESTLER. This is the THIRD CONSECUTIVE YEAR a Westside wrestler was voted by the coaches as the best Wrestler in the Greater Houston Area.

Ramirez finishes as a FOUR time regional finalist and a THREE time Regional Champion. In four years he had a record of 15-1 at regionals, his only loss in the finals as a Freshman. Jay and Santi will look to finish with a bang as the wrestle in the UIL STATE TOURNAMENT this weekend at the Berry Center in Cypress, TX.

# Cell Phone Policy


- Cell phones must be placed in backpack throughout the entire school day.

   Failure to follow these guidelines will result in consequences as outlined in the student code of conduct.








