
## 2024 AP School Honor Roll

## PSAT on October 16

On Wednesday, October 16, 2024, all 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students will take the PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test). This test measures for the knowledge and skills that are essential for college readiness and success. The College board is the organization that develops and scores the PSAT/NMSQT tests as well as the Advanced Placement exams and the SAT.

For 9<sup>th</sup> graders, the score sets a college readiness baseline, and then in 10<sup>th</sup> grade, the score provides a check on the progress in comparison to that baseline.

For 11<sup>th</sup> graders, the scores from the test help narrow their college choices. The results can also qualify the student for the National Merit Scholarship competition and open up future college scholarship opportunities.

On test day, students should:

Arrive at school by 7:30 am

Wear their Westside photo ID

Bring their Chromebook AND charger (all testing is done digitally)


Be prepared to turn in all electronic devices and accessories (they will be secured and returned at the end of testing)

Please note that if a student's electronic device disturbs the testing environment by making a sound, per school policy, the device will be confiscated for two weeks, and the Testing Coordinator will report the irregularity to the College Board. This may result in the test not being scored. Please note that this applies even if the phone is not in the student's possession, for it will still have created a disturbance to the testing environment.

Scores will be available in your student's college board account in November; we no longer receive paper score reports.

Finally, no visitors are permitted on test day.

- September 16: Deadline for EB Language Support Requests
- Students who have IEPs, 504 plans, or Emergent Bilingual students (who require language supports for testing) are eligible for specific accommodations.
- Accommodations requests must be submitted to College Board for review &
- PSAT Make-up Days: October 17 and 18

## **Important Test Details**

- PSAT is an online assessment
   Total time for testing is 2 hours and 14 minutes
   An online graphing calculator is available for all students
- A Math reference sheet with Math formulas is provided

## Why take the PSAT?

College Readiness: Evaluates the essential knowledge and skills needed for college and career readiness. Qualifying scores allow students to take college credit courses for semediating) (no remediation)

Literacy and Math Skills: Measures critical reading skills, writing skills, math reasoning and problem-solving skills

## Scholarship Opportunities:

Provides an opportunity to enter the competition for National Merit Scholar

Advanced Course Scheduling: May be used to determine eligibility for advanced courses, including HCC Dual Credit courses





## Cell Phone Policy


- Cell phones must be placed in backpack throughout the entire school day.


