- · PSAT 8/9; All Grade 8 & 9 Students
- · PSAT / NMSQT: All Grade 10 & 11 Students

Important Deadlines

- September 16: Deadline for EB Language Support Requests
- Students who have IEPs, 504 plans, or Emergent Bilingual students (who require language supports for testing) are eligible for specific accommodations.
- Accommodations requests must be submitted to College Board for review &
- PSAT Make-up Days: October 17 and 18

Why take the PSAT?

College Readiness: Evaluates the essential knowledge and skills needed for college and career readiness. Qualifying scores allow students to take college credit courses (no remediation)

Literacy and Math Skills: Measures critical reading skills, writing skills, math reasoning and problem-solving skills

Scholarship Opportunities: Provides an opportunity to enter the competition for National Merit Scholar scholarships

Advanced Course Scheduling:

May be used to determine eligibility for advanced courses, including HCC Dual Credit courses


Fechas límite importantes

- 16 de septiembre: Fecha límite para las solicitudes de adaptaciones para EB estudiantes
- . Los estudiantes que tienen IEP, planes 504 o estudiantes bilingües emergentes (que requieren apoyo lingüístico para las pruebas) son elegibles para adaptaciones específicas.
- Las solicitudes de adaptaciones deben enviarse al College Board para su revisión y aprobación.
- Días de recuperación del PSAT: 17 y 18 de octubre



there's so much more to come!










