

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Important HISD Announcement Re: Vaping—HB 114

Parents and Guardians,

We would like to notify you of an important new policy change that has been passed by the 88th Texas Legislature and will be taking effect immediately in our district for September 1st, 2023.

House Bill 114 (HB 114) has been enacted to respond to the increasing concerns around e-cigarettes, vaping, marijuana, and THC related products amongst our youth. The Bill mandates that any student found in possession of, under the influence of, selling, gifting, or delivering these substances within a 300-feet radius of any school premises, will be immediately removed, and placed in a Disciplinary Alternative Education Program (DAEP).

Please discuss the implications of this new law with your children, emphasizing the importance of adhering to school policies and laws for their own educational success and for the betterment of the school community.

Por la presente le comunicamos un cambio importante de política que ha sido aprobado por la 88^a Legislatura de Texas y entrará en vigor en nuestro distrito el 1 de septiembre de 2023.

El Proyecto de Ley 114 (HB 114) de la Cámara de Representantes ha sido promulgado en respuesta a las crecientes inquietudes relacionadas con el vapeo y el consumo de cigarrillos electrónicos, marihuana y productos relacionados con el THC entre los jóvenes. El proyecto de ley exige que cualquier estudiante que se encuentre en posesión de estas sustancias, o que esté bajo su influencia, o vendiéndolas, regalándolas o repartiéndolas en un radio de 300 pies de cualquier instalación escolar, sea retirado inmediatamente y colocado en un Programa Escolar Alternativo Disciplinario (DAEP).




