### Westside Students Exhibit at Houston Museum



A group of Westside students exhibited their hand-crafted model of an ancient game board at the Houston Museum of Natural Science last weekend. After a months-long design and build process, in collaboration with Archaeology Now, Archaeology Institute of America—

Houston Society, the students set-up and demonstrated the game as part of an interactive museum exhibit.

Before the debut, the team of students had an opportunity to consult on their project, via SKYPE from the Westside Learning Commons, with worldfamous Assyriologist. Dr. Irving Finkel. Dr. Finkel is the Assistant Keeper of Ancient Mesopotamian Script. Language, and Culture at the British Museum in

London. He discovered and translated the ancient cuneiform tablet from the 3rd century BC that contained the rules for the board game, "The Royal Game of Ur", which our Wolves reconstructed in life-size.

## School Policy Refresher: Uniforms

As a mid-year refresher, please review the <u>Westside Uniform Policy</u>. Please take particular note: **no hoodies**, **no Adidas pants** (nor other athletic pants), and **no non-uniform jackets** are to be worn during the

school day. Students who are out of uniform will not be admitted to class. Repeat offenders risk losing exam exemptions, and may be ineligible to participate in some organizations and programs.

#### **Westside High School Uniform Policy**

IDs: Student School IDs must be worn around the neck at all times. IDs may not be shared, borrowed, or defaced to obscure the photo. No exceptions.

#### MONDAY-THURSDAY: OFFICIAL WESTSIDE UNIFORM

#### Tops:

Students must wear official uniform shirts purchased from the Westside School Store

- Polo-style and crew neck t-shirts (long- and short-sleeves) are available in white, royal blue, and black
  - o If an undershirt is worn, it must be solid white, royal blue or black.
  - o No "game day" exemptions, no club/organization shirts may be worn Mon-Thurs
  - o Normal uniform policy is required for field trips (exemptions allowed only if required for activity)

#### **Uniform Pants and Skirts:**

Students must wear Khaki or Black uniform-style pants, jeans, skirts or shorts

- An optional official plaid skirt is available and can be preordered through the vendor (http://custompromostore.com/westside/).
- Only brown or black belts may be worn, but are not required
- No leggings, jeggings, gym shorts, warm-ups, workout/athletic-wear, track pants, body-hugging, nor
  excessively tight/baggy pants
- · Pants must not fall below the waistline
- . Skirts, skorts, and shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee

#### Outerwear/Jackets:

If students wish to wear a jacket/sweatshirt inside the building, allowable options include:

- Official uniform jackets/sweatshirts purchased at the school store, including grey crewneck sweatshirt, royal blue fleece jacket, black ½-zip fleece pullover, and black water-resistant jacket
- · Official Westside letterman jacket
- Official Westside organization jackets with the following: school logo or school name, long-sleeves, full-zip, and base color of black, white, royal blue, gray or silver. Quarter-zip pullovers do not qualify.
- No hoodies are allowed inside the building

#### Headwear:

- No headwear, including hats, caps, visors, bandanas, scarves, wave caps, athletic headbands, etc.
- · Religious head coverings are permitted

#### FRIDAY: OFFICIAL WESTSIDE SPIRIT DAY (or Thursday if Friday is a holiday)

#### Tops:

In addition to normal uniform shirts, students may wear an official Westside-sponsored club or organization spirit shirt with base color of royal blue, black, grey, or white.

• Spirit shirts must have the official Westside logo, a "W", or Westside name imprinted.

#### Pants:

In addition to normal uniform, students have the option of wearing blue jeans

Strict blue jeans policy--no rips, tears, frays, holes, embellishments, or cut-offs. No sagging jeans.

Outerwear & Headwear: Same as Mon-Thurs

Students who are out of uniform will not be admitted to class

All students are expected to be in full uniform beginning on the first day of school




