

Last week, a team of Westside students participated in the Special Olympics Basketball State Competition on the UT campus in Arlington. Ms. Kodlubanska, Ms. Suleimanji, Coach Deon Williams and parent coach William Sam escorted our students on the 4-day trip.

Among the hundreds of athletes from around the state of Texas, Westside's delegation included 18 students from our Skills for Lifelong Learning (SLL) and Structured Learning Center (SLC) classes. Some athletes compete in the team

basketball tournament, others participate in the individual skills competition. Each practices and prepares and strives for improvement.

Ms. Kodlubanska points out that sports is very satisfying for individuals with intellectual disabilities. Even though it is adapted, it feels real and is fulfilling for the athletes. She shared that the annual trip is a highlight of the year for the students, "Something to look forward to; compete, have fun, make lasting friendships, and grow in independence and sportsmanship."







Showcase of Excellence in Instruction

Westside was selected to participate in a Texas Education Agency (TEA) program to develop a lesson that will be posted for use by other Texas teachers from across the state. English 1 teachers Gigi George, Emily Gelsinger, Kendra Johnson, and Travis Koneschik worked with Scott Disch, Westside's Instructional Coordinator, along with Dean Edith Gonzalez, to design the lesson which focused on identifying and analyzing character foils in literature. The group was facilitated by Ms. Mendy Wandling from TEA Region 4.

About 270 freshmen participated in the lesson, which included assessments. Additional elements of formal observations and student interviews are used to develop the finished product.









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English 2 Presents District Improvement Plans

On May 21, Ms. Dummar's and Ms. Hebert's Pre-AP English 2 students presented district improvement proposals for failed school districts (past and present) in the state of Texas.

Students were assigned a district and developed improvement plans based on four weeks of research, data analysis, and analytical writing. They studied successful districts to learn about best practices and possible solutions.

In addition to writing a research paper (most 12-25 pages long!), they showcased their findings on trifold display boards and gave oral presentations which included a Q & A element.




Where Are They Now?


