- 2. John Haugen presented a narrative of the NATEX Corporation and the history of the firm with Houston Independent School District. The goal, as presented from the NATEX team, for the vision of the project is:
 - a. Communal spaces emphasizing collaboration and flexibility
 - b. Interaction between interior and exterior connections
 - c. Establish a clear sense of entry
- 3. The NATEX Corporation expressed the desire to quickly process the needs of the Kashmere High School by the following methods:
 - a. Facility assessment
 - b. Review maintenance issues
 - c. Set priority list
 - d. Finalize space requirements
- 4. HISD Facilities Planner, Dave Funk, and the PAT reviewed and finalized the Guiding Principles established from the previous month's meeting. The Guiding Principles for the Design and Renovation of Kashmere High School are as follows:
 - Kashmere High School will have flexible and adaptable learning spaces that will accommodate and meet the academic and social needs of its diverse learners.
 - Kashmere High School has a strong community presence. The newly renovated environment should reflect and honor over 50 years of a prestigious legacy of academics, fine arts and sports.
 - Kashmere High School shall provide a functional and educationally stimulating environment that will provide safety and security for students and the community.
