The purpose of this meeting was to finalize the Guiding Principles and identify and prioritize campus needs.

## NOTES:

- Travis Stanford provided a brief report on the progress of the 2007 Bond Project work. He mentioned that a Construction
  Manager At Risk has been selected and the scope is being developed. A schedule, including a phasing plan, will be
  completed very soon along with a more detailed description of the work will be completed and will be provided when
  completed. He confirmed that incomplete 2007 Bond scope will be completed.
- Gloria Barrera asked if there were any comments or edits regarding the proposed Guiding Principles. Principal Schur mentioned that the proposed Guiding Principles had been shared for review and comment. The group was in favor of proceeding with the Guiding Principles as provided by Waltrip PAT members.
- 3. Ms. Barrera provided an overview of the next steps in the planning process and described the activity for this meeting. The goal is to create a detailed list of what works and what doesn't work at Waltrip HS today. The final action resulted in a list that was created by the group and subsequently voted on to determine priorities for the 2012 project. The effort assisted the PAT in defining what features were the most important for the design team to further develop into a scope for the campus.

- 4. Group Discussion was broken up into the three categories shown below:
  - a. What doesn't work at Waltrip High School
    - i. Flow of hallways (cut throughs)
    - ii. Water needed in Rm. 124 (Robotics Lab)
    - iii. Dance Room size is too small and floor is improper (tile)
    - iv. Front office not customer service friendly
    - v. "4 Corners", traffic jam
    - vi. Restrooms, all, including Boy's, Girl's, and faculty
    - vii. 34th St. curb appeal & functionality, what is first impression?
    - viii. Electrical outlets inadequate in many areas.
    - ix. Wireless network inadequate in many areas.
    - x. More data drops needed.
    - xi. Drop off zones, getting in and out of building is difficult
    - xii. Front porch
    - xiii. Science Lab sink drainage not functioning properly
    - xiv. Band Hall does not meet needs of program
    - xv. Air Conditioning-rebalance? Is it under proper control?
    - xvi. Auditorium technology, including sound reinforcement and lighting
    - xvii. Security (Doors)
    - xviii. Gyms are not large enough to hold entire student body
    - xix. Desks/Furnishings are old and not functional.
    - xx. Locker Room does not meet needs of program.
    - xxi. Weight Room does not meet needs of program.
    - xxii. Community Attendance/Bleachers Community not encouraged to attend events due to lack of bleachers/seating for outside athletic events.
    - xxiii. Tennis, softball, non-existent concessions
    - xxiv. Fire drill egress is difficult because students have to weave in and out of buildings, especially assembly areas.
    - xxv. Teacher Document Camera/Computer placement at teaching station requires teachers to have their back to students.
    - xxvi. Swimming Pool Access only thru Locker room showers
    - xxvii. No place for community meeting/host for digital meetings
    - xxviii. Provide more service in Library
    - xxix. Elevator Issues
    - xxx. Auditorium stage too small
    - xxxi. 12th grade hallway
    - xxxii. Storage/Shops
    - xxxiii. Swimming pool not usable
    - xxxiv. Instructional space size in "old" wing
    - xxxv. Renovation of cafeteria area, including courtyard
    - xxxvi. Auditorium aisle has too much slope
    - xxxvii. Eating on floor by Auditorium not sanitary
    - xxxviii. Stairwell circulation not controlled students go in both directions on same stair
    - xxxix. Daycare is located too far away from drop off area.
      - xl. Tables in Science Labs are coming apart
      - xli. Need Auditorium accessible entrance (ADA)
      - xlii. Need Band Hall lockers
      - xliii. Math teachers w/o smart boards
    - xliv. Pedestrian safety (Ella and Lou Ellen St) sidewalks
    - xlv. Technology Labs (shape)

- 7. A Community Meeting will be held on Nov. 7, 2013, at 7:00pm. This is an opportunity for the community to be informed about the upcoming 2012 Bond project at Waltrip HS. A presentation will be made by the Architects and HISD Planning regarding the progress to date. There will also be an opportunity to address any questions the community may have concerning the project.

## **ACTION ITEMS:**

- 1. Conduct focused meetings on Educational Specifications for use during the PAT Workshop. (HISD Facilities Planning and Waltrip HS staff.)
- 2. Gensler to develop concepts to share with PAT at workshop to assist in further prioritizing and decision making.

## **NEXT MEETING:**

• Review the Draft Educational Specification that will be created by HISD Planning in response to feedback and direction from Principal and teachers.
