PURPOSE

The purpose of this meeting was to review and discuss further Community Meeting and to provide an update on remote parking.

NOTES:

- Michael Scott, Senior Project Manager with the HISD Bond Office, welcomed visitors and members to the meeting.
- Mr. Scott presented and reviewed with the PAT updated slides reflective of the remote parking options at Westside Tennis Center (WTC).
- In reviewing the parking options noted, the PAT requested that the following items be revisited/researched:
 - Vehicular and pedestrian access off of Briar Forest Drive in lieu of Wilcrest Drive
 - Possibly change the route of the shuttle bus from Hayes Road to Lynbrook via Sandy Spring Road
 - Have feasibility or dry run be performed on the actual bus route in an effort to measure duration and timing
 - Have a traffic study completed in an effort to gauge the flow of vehicular traffic on the actual bus route to and from WTC
 - HISD to look into suitable options for staff who arrive early and leave late
 - HISD to verify with City of Houston(COH) current on street parking ordinances
- Mr. Scott advised that he would be scheduling a meeting with principal Cumby and HISD transportation in an effort to finalize outstanding items relative to the shuttle bus route and driver
- Several PAT members expressed concerns regarding the resolution of the COH building code issue involving current location of classrooms.
- Principal Cumby offered a solution which would be verified by cre8 via a meeting with COH Building Department plan reviewers. Once confirmed by cre8 with COH, RGCI would be providing an update to the PAT via Principal Cumby.
- One PAT member confirmed that he would be applying for 2018 Spark Park funding via a walk through to be performed in January 2017. Spark Park criteria mandates that the area be accessible after hours.
- o The PAT requested that the use of existing playground equipment be confirmed by cre8; Division One confirmed the current scope of work for same for the new building.
- o Mr. Scott confirmed that he would follow up with HISD regarding the relocation of the existing furniture currently located in the existing temporary buildings.
