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**PURPOSE:** Discussion will focus on interior renderings and graphics.

## AGENDA:

#### **DISCUSSION:**

- 1. VLK reviewed the floor plans with selected floor finishes and color scheme.
- 2. Finish floor in media lounge was rendered as LVT instead of stained concrete. VLK will continue to study options for this space. PAT preferred a warmer stained concrete.
- 3. VLK presented updated renderings of interior spaces and courtyard.
- 4. If budget allows, PAT discussed the use of large digital walls in various locations throughout the school, such as Media Lounge, Front Entry or Large Group Instruction (LGI). The walls would allow for large presentations to be broadcasted in overflow spaces.
- 5. PAT was concerned about the audience's view in LGI space; VLK to study site lines.
- 6. If budget allows, PAT would like to see the use of a smart podium and document camera on the stage of LGI.
- 7. Marker boards were favored in the learning commons / hallways in lieu of smart boards.
- Lori discussed her concerns of the number of outlets needed in learning commons. She stated that long computer cords create a trip hazard in the halls. PAT discussed the use of overhead outlets, floor outlets or using furniture that comes equipped with outlets. Floor outlets are not permitted per HISD standards.
- 9. Lori is working towards sending an updated furniture plan. Lori to be in contact with VLK when the furniture plan becomes available.
- 10. If possible, Lori would like to discuss the servery layout with HISD food services for a more sophisticated serving area. It is understood that it may be too far into the design to make additional changes to the design without delaying the process and incurring additional costs.
- 11. PAT would like to see the cafeteria with a modern café furniture layout rather than a traditional school cafeteria.
- 12. Overall, PAT liked the graphics that were presented and will work with VLK on developing graphics.
