PURPOSE: The purpose of this meeting was to present adjustments to the floor plans and the progress of the design.

NOTES:

- 1. Dr. James McSwain, Principal, welcomed the PAT and introduced Mr. Lester Yuen, Gensler to provide a project design update.
 - a. Lester Yuen described the steps taken in planning and the evolution of the design to its current state.
 - b. Iona Brucker, Gensler began the presentation by reviewing the site plan. Currently, Gensler is working with the landscape architect to develop a low maintenance solution.
 - c. The locations of the air-handling units on the first floor were shown.
 - d. The food service consultant is in the process of designing a layout for the kitchen.
 - e. It was noted that acoustical control panels for the second floor are being studied.
 - f. The library / multi-media rooms have been separated.
 - g. The multi-purpose room has been located between the mini-theater and the recital hall.
 - h. It was noted that the library is on the fourth floor. It has been re-located towards the center of the floor, close to the stairs. The library plan layout is being developed and will be reviewed at a future meeting.
 - i. It was noted that Music spaces are located on the fifth floor. These spaces are being further refined.
 - j. The Science/Wet lab layouts are being studied. These are located on the third floor.
 - k. The main theater and its lighting are being studied.
 - I. Mr. Robert Barrera, HISD Project Manager asked if the science ventilation hoods will be vented or ventless. Gensler will investigate both types of science room ventilation hood.
 - m. Mr. Yuen noted the locations of the four stairwells, freight elevator and the two passenger elevators.
 - n. It was noted that the southeast stair is planned to have exterior glass walls to offer a view of the cityscape.
 - o. Mr. Yuen noted that the colors shown in the renderings are preliminary and that Gensler will be developing finish boards for review by the PAT at an upcoming meeting.
