PURPOSE: This meeting focused on a project status update, floor plan review and finish color selections.

DISCUSSION:

- 1. Ms. Gloria Barrera welcomed all attendees.
- 2. All representatives of Harrison Kornberg, Corgan, Houston ISD, and the Rice & Gardner team introduced themselves.
- 3. Charles Jacobs with Harrison Kornberg Architects presented the floor plans and the site plan. The floor plan has not changed since the last PAT meeting in August. This presentation was to refresh the PAT's memory of the design and to bring new members up to speed.
- 4. Principal Crook described the courtyards as a key to how the new facility will function. The courtyards will act as a staging area for pick up and drop off while keeping the students safely inside the school but give them plenty of room to play. Principal Crook believes it is critical to have separate areas for the middle school and the high school.
- 5. Matisia Hollingsworth, HISD Senior Manager Construction Services, suggested that Principal Crook consider any equipment that he may be re-locating into the new building and let the design team know so they can incorporate into the plans.



QUESTIONS/ANSWERS:

- 1. Principal Crook asked what the status is of the Joe Sample sound booth. Charles Jacobs responded that the area for the booth is provided on the first floor adjoining the stage but that there is no equipment included in the project.
- 2. The robotics teacher asked if there will be 220v in the robotics workshop. Charles Jacobs responded that 220v power will be provided.
- 3. Principal Crook asked about adding doors from the courtyard directly into the corridor to expedite student egress. The design team will investigate this request.
- 4. Teachers asked about the location of the Special Education learning centers. Charles Jacobs explained that there are special ed learning centers in both the high school and the middle school.
