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PURPOSE: Discussion focused on Madison High School's Capacity Model and Space Requirements.

DISCUSSION:

- 1. Steven Gee, HISD Project Manager welcomed the participants.
- 2. Guiding Principles
 - a. The Project Advisory Team (PAT) reviewed the Guiding Principles draft prepared at the last PAT meeting.
 - b. Principal Sonja Williams then reviewed the three recommendations that she received form the PAT.



- c. The three revisions from Linda Scurlock, Dr. Josolynne Reed and Brenda Brazil addressed wording concerns within the Guiding Principles. All three request for revision where voted on accepted by the PAT.
- 3. Capacity Model
 - a. LaJuan Harris explained to the PAT how the planned square footage and construction budget of the school was calculated
 - b. Ms. Harris stated the total square footage of the school is based on 140 sq. ft. per student. The budget is based on a \$160 per sq. ft. The school will be planned at the lower end of the enrollment range, to take in account the current market trends closer to \$190 per sq. ft. Ms. Harris informed the PAT that addressing the budget at the front end will help mitigate the impact of this market trend.
 - c. Ms. Harris stated the process to determine the area for each space is based on number of students and the function of the space. Typically, HISD's learning centers are 850 square feet. Science learning centers are combinations of classroom and lab, accordingly they are nearly double in size at 1,650 square feet.
 - d. Ms. Harris stated the Educational Specification will include all of the required spaces for the school and alternate spaces will be noted within the document. Doing this will provide the architects with information on expansion and growth opportunities as well as cost saving options.

QUESTIONS/ANSWERS:

- 1. Why did HISD not account for inflation when preparing the budgets? *Inflation was calculated when preparing the budgets, but the Texas construction markets are experiencing all time increasing rates.*
- 2. Why were other schools given more money than Madison High School.? The budget for all schools are based on the projected enrollment and the scope of work that will be completed at the school.
