Yates High School




OVERVIEW

Yates High School, constructed in 1958 in Houston's Third Ward, provides a comprehensive college preparatory curriculum that features magnet programs in Communications, Maritime, and Health Sciences.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- 210,000-square-foot building.
- History of Yates High School will be displayed throughout the new campus.
- Design will feature the Yates High School Wall of Fame for athletics and academic history and achievement.
- Main multi-height entry lobby with dual entries from north and south.
- Community spaces for continued connection with surrounding community.
- One-story, high-volume performance wing with auditorium, gymnasium, Fine Arts, JROTC, and athletics.
- Three-story academic wing will feature academic neighborhoods with core learning centers, Career and Technology learning centers, and small-group breakout areas.
- Magnet School of Communications will feature new radio and television stations.
- Five academic neighborhoods with Career and Technology programs, including: Transportation (Logistics/Maritime); Arts (A/V Production and A/V Architecture & Construction Technician); Graphic Design and Production; and Health Sciences.
- Exterior of building is a material contrast between solid concrete as a base and metal accent elements throughout the facade, and large glazing elements anchored in strategic locations.
