# **UIL Competition**

If you are interested in competing against students from other schools in the areas of spelling, oral reading, listening, or creative writing in upcoming UIL competitions in the spring semester, then come take our qualifying tests!

<u>Spelling</u>: Interested  $2^{nd} - 5^{th}$  grade students will take a written qualifying test on **Monday**, October 23, 2017 during the school day.

<u>Listening</u>: Interested 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will take a listening qualifying test on Tuesday, October 24, 2017 during the school day. Students will listen to a script read aloud to them and then answer written questions based on the script they just heard.

Oral Reading: This competition is for students who enjoy reading aloud for an audience and aspire to capture a person's emotions using their voice, body language, intonation, etc. Auditions for oral reading will be held on Wednesday, October 25, 2017 during the school day. 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade students interested in auditioning must be prepared with 2 copies of a self-selected <u>poem</u> (no longer than 2 minutes): 1 copy for the student to read aloud from and 1 copy for the judges.

<u>Creative Writing</u>: Creative writing samples will be collected in the classroom during Language Arts classes in the coming weeks.

Notification will be sent only to students who qualify based on test and audition results.
