HANDBOOK HIGHLIGHTS RESIDENCY

Students must reside in the Bush attendance zone in order to attend school at Bush. Because Bush is a large school and must accommodate its own zoned students, no regular education transfers are granted. Special Education transfers are granted when the ARD committee recommends a program that is not offered at the child's home school.

If a student moves out of the Bush zone during the school year, the student must enroll in his/her "new" zoned school. Students may <u>not</u> remain at Bush after moving out of the zone.
