Zoned PK Registration

For the 2019-2020 school year, all PK students must meet the federal guidelines to qualify for PK. There will be NO PK tuition students for the 2019-2020 school year. The PK application packet is currently available for pick up in the office.

If your PK-age (4 on or before September 1) child is a sibling of a currently-enrolled Bush student, then drop off your completed PK application to the front office during the following window:

March 19 - 22 (7:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m.)

If your PK-age (4 on or before September 1) child is zoned to Bush, but **NOT** a sibling of a currently-enrolled Bush student, then drop off your completed PK application to the front office during the following window:

April 2 - 5 (8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. – 2:00 p.m.)

Completed PK application/registration packet must be turned in to the Bush front office **ANY TIME** during the drop-window. Since it is a lottery process, it is **NOT** first come, first served.
