GT TESTING

If you are interested in having your child tested for the Gifted and Talented Neighborhood program at Bush for **Grades 1-4** for the **2019-2020 school year**, please download an application at <http://www.houstonisd.org/Page/59885> and turn it in to the front office. Applications for the Bush Gifted and Talented Program are due by **December 7, 2018**. All kindergarteners and all fifth graders not already identified will be universally assessed later in the fall semester. More information will be forthcoming about the universal assessment of kindergarten and fifth grade students. Please do not turn in an application for a currently enrolled kindergartener or 5th grader.

If you are applying to a Vanguard Magnet school (Askew, T.H. Rogers, etc.), do not submit an application to Bush. Instead, Vanguard Magnet applicants that are not G/T identified in HISD must request testing with Jessica Ayala in the front office. The deadline for Vanguard Magnet applicants to request G/T testing at Bush is **December 8, 2018**.
