New Business

- Primary focus is on failing students.
- We will all be working together to get our students to feel a sense of urgency and make a final push to pass.
- 72 Students failing one or more classes.
- New Guidance rosters will be provided to teachers tomorrow, May 14th. The idea is to help students bring up failing grades.

- Students that are virtual will receive a call requesting them to return to campus in order to bring their grades up.
- Goal is to lower the number of student taking summer school to recover credits.
- TELPAS Testing is taking place this week, May 10-14th.
- Remind students about campus rules as the virtual students return to campus. We must help them adapt to returning to campus.
- May 28th is a day for asynchronous learning. Create assignments for the students to work on that day. Create a plan so the students prioritize the assignments they need to bring their grade up.
- Should we do senior finals a week early to allow more time for credit recovery? (May 24th-27th)
- If the senior fails a semester, they will need to complete their credit recovery on APEX within the 2 week period.
- **After a vote, senior final exams are May 24th-27th.**
- Final Exams and keys must be provided to the front office for filing.
- Gradebook locks June 14th.
- We will be looking for new grants to provide services and equipment to our students.
- Final Exam exemptions. Students that are passing with an 85 or better can be exempt from final exams. 9th graders can be exempt from 1 exam. 10th and 11th can be exempt from 2.
- Students must let Ms. Sullivan or Mr. Horne know which final exam they want to exempt.
- Dress code update.
