MILBY HIGH SCHOOL

Budget: \$68.8 million

Scope of Work: New school preserving architecturally significant building structure for 1,800 to 2,000 students

Square Footage: 227,120 in renovations, 40,693 in new construction

Target Completion Date: 2nd Quarter 2017

Contractor: Tellepsen Builders, LP

Architect: Kirksey Architecture

- Construction in progress; approximately 70 percent complete.
- Project is tracking on budget and on schedule.
- Construction is expected to be completed in 2nd quarter 2017, preparing for a summer move-in.

The campus will feature new administrative offices, an auditorium with a black box theater, a large commons area and outdoor courtyard. Three-story academic wings are being erected to the north and south of the main building — each including learning spaces for science and engineering labs, welding, a print shop, and culinary arts program, which includes a student-run café. The school also will also feature new performing and visual arts and athletic spaces, which will be located at the back of the campus.
