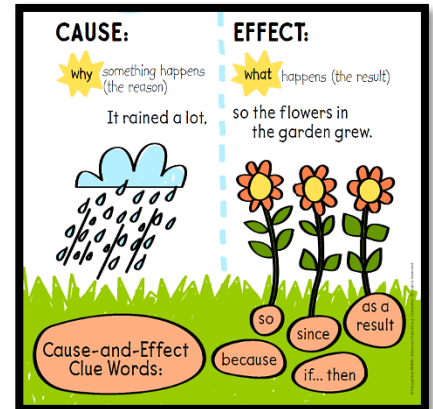
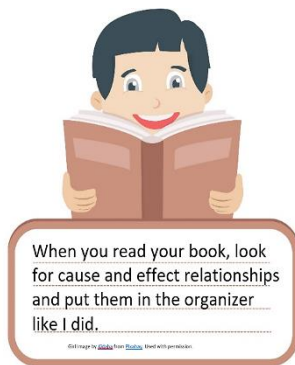

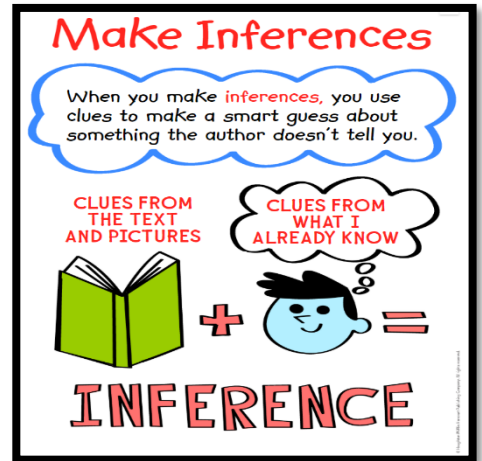

Butterflies are great insects to have in a garden. A pretty flower is even prettier when a butterfly lands on it! Also, butterflies help plants grow. As they visit flowers to drink nectar, they move pollen from flower to flower. Pollen is a yellow dust that comes from flowers. Plants use pollen to make more seeds that grow into plants.
