


## Best Practices for Using YouTube Videos in Instruction

To ensure that the video that you want and nothing else is displayed when using a YouTube video, it is the expected practice that you **uncheck** the box for “*Show suggested videos when the video finishes.*” This is an option available under the **Show More** link.

It’s best practice to view each video in its entirety in advance. If you have any questions about appropriateness or alignment to standards, ask a colleague or supervisor to review it as well.
