We will be submitting the enrollment projection of 450 students for the 2022-2023 school year. Root Cause: COVID 19 related Early Pick Up: Same students, Principal McKinney has begun speaking to parents.
Information Items	21-22 School Improvement Plan Progress Ms. McKinney projected the Plan4Learning platform and reviewed the progress for the Measurable Objectives and Strategies for the November progress check. Considerable growth has been made in the strategies under Board goals 1-3. There is still a need for improvement with increasing the growth percentages in Board goals 4 and 5. Transformation Schools Cohort Highland Heights has been selected to become a part of the Superintendent's new

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Transformation Schools Cohort along with 23 additional schools. This program will replace the Achieve 180 program that our school participates in now. All Transformation Cohort Schools either had multiple consecutive D, F, or IR ratings or received an F-rating in 2019. This program is promising due to it having components that were not included in the design of Achieve 180. More specifically, the Achieve 180 program does not include a campus specific needs assessment and does not allow the district to support each school differently. The district now believes that supporting a campus' individual needs is the most critical component of the school improvement work.
