ÍTEM A.1 (REVISIÓN DE LA AGENDA)

¿Qué porcentaje de nuestros estudiantes NO están inscritos en cursos de AP, IB, crédito doble, matrícula doble, CTE/IBC, etc.? ***ACTUALIZADO 2/7/23***

El veinte por ciento de los estudiantes no están inscritos en ninguno de estos cursos o programas.

¿Qué porcentaje de nuestros estudiantes están inscritos en más de uno estos cursos o programas? ***ACTUALIZADO 2/7/23***

El 37% de los estudiantes están inscritos en más de un curso o programa.

¿Qué sistemas tenemos para evaluar la efectividad de los programas de Educación Vocacional y Técnica (CTE) (los estudiantes realmente están obteniendo sus certificaciones industriales (IBC) y tienen un empleo remunerado en su campo después de la preparatoria), y cómo están evaluando esos sistemas?

Es inherentemente difícil rastrear el empleo después de la preparatoria debido a barreras que impiden recibir los datos de empleo de fuentes estatales y federales. Incluso con esos datos, es difícil evaluar si el trabajo está en el ámbito laboral para el cual el estudiante se preparó. Por ejemplo, no se puede saber a partir de los datos del gobierno si un estudiante que obtuvo una certificación de HVAC y está trabajando para Exxon Mobile está utilizando en ese trabajo la certificación laboral que obtuvo. Para compensar parcialmente esta falta de información, utilizamos encuestas de egreso para saber dónde los estudiantes piensan que trabajarán y qué harán después de la graduación. Si bien esto no genera datos completos, puede generar suficiente información como para evaluar qué tan efectivos son los programas IBC para lograr un empleo remunerado relacionado.

Lo que tenemos el poder de hacer ahora es medir la eficacia con la cual los estudiantes lograr obtener las certificaciones. Hemos visto que necesitamos hacer este análisis por escuela, porque muchas de las barreras que impiden a los estudiantes completar sus IBC se encuentran en la escuela. Para mitigar estas barreras, el departamento de preparación CTE celebra reuniones periódicas con el liderazgo de la escuela y cuenta con especialistas del distrito que trabajan con el personal escolar. Colaboran con los maestros para que el material se enseñe con fidelidad a fin de maximizar el éxito de los estudiantes que obtienen sus IBC. También colaboran con consejeros y líderes de Nivel II para asegurar que se ofrezcan los cursos

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adecuados y que la escuela inscriba a los estudiantes en esos cursos. Como paso final, monitorean constantemente el número de cupones IBC ordenados, completados y registrados para garantizar que los estudiantes cumplan ese importante paso. Las reuniones anuales de revisión se llevan a cabo con el liderazgo en cada escuela para analizar datos del mercado laboral, la matrícula, la finalización de los cursos y los resultados de los estudiantes de IBC.

¿Están evaluando a los estudiantes que podrían calificar para fondos adicionales por resultados de Preparación Universitaria, Vocacional y Militar (CCMR)? ¿Hay estudiantes que están cerca de cumplir con los criterios y solo necesitan un impulso? Por favor, expliquen.

Los fondos adicionales por resultados de CCMR se pueden obtener de dos maneras:

- 1) El estudiante obtiene estatus de preparado para la universidad por sus puntuaciones en los exámenes estandarizados (SAT, ACT, TSIA2) y se inscribe en la universidad el siguiente semestre de otoño; o
- 2) El estudiante obtiene certificación IBC y se inscribe en la universidad el siguiente semestre de otoño.

Hemos hallado que alrededor del 80% de los estudiantes que se inscribieron en la universidad y estaban cerca pero no cumplieron ninguna de las dos opciones, estaban más cerca en la de preparación para la universidad. Por tanto, estamos preparando a estos estudiantes estratégicamente a fin de que logren una puntuación de SAT o TSIA2 que indique que están listos para la universidad, dependiendo de las circunstancias particulares de cada estudiante. Para esto utilizamos herramientas como Khan Academy.

Aumentar la bonificación por resultados de CCMR entre los estudiantes de la opción IBC implica alentar a los que obtienen el IBC y tal vez no se ven como "material universitario" a explorar oportunidades en colegios comunitarios para acrecentar las credenciales que ya obtuvieron en la preparatoria. Actualmente hay en las escuelas ocho asesores de preparación vocacional que se especializan en este trabajo. Además, procuramos que los estudiantes completen su IBC. El maestro de CTE que administra los exámenes brinda instrucción y toma decisiones con respecto al conocimiento y el desarrollo de las habilidades que necesitan los estudiantes para el éxito. Para las plataformas que tenemos donde se puede identificar puntualmente el dominio de objetivos, proveemos a los maestros recursos adicionales disponibles y pagamos un examen adicional para brindar al estudiante la oportunidad de obtener el IBC.

¿Cómo están evaluando la correlación entre las demandas del mercado laboral, lo que los estudiantes y las familias quieren y qué certificaciones industriales (IBC) ofrecemos??

El equipo de Preparación Vocacional monitorea constantemente los datos de la Comisión de la Fuerza Laboral de Texas y el Consejo del Área de Houston-Galveston. Además, mantiene una comunicación continua con su Consejo Asesor Empresarial, así como con otros socios comerciales para estar al corriente de lo que los empleadores buscan y lograr que nuestros programas brinden a los estudiantes los conocimientos y habilidades valoradas en la industria.

En el lado del estudiante y la familia, antes de hacer cambios a los programas de Educación Vocacional y Técnica ofrecidos en una escuela, la escuela realiza una encuesta de la comunidad para conocer los intereses de los estudiantes, las familias y las empresas locales. Después de la encuesta, el personal de Preparación Vocacional se reúne con los líderes de la escuela para determinar dónde hay superposición

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entre los intereses de la comunidad y los datos de empleos regionales.

Anualmente, el personal de Preparación Vocacional se reúne con la administración de la escuela para discutir las tasas de inscripción y finalización del programa, y si es mejor continuar con el programa, ajustarlo o hacer una transición a otro. Por último, si la escuela de la zona de residencia de un estudiante no ofrece un programa que le interese al estudiante, puede solicitar admisión a otros programas con transferencia Magnet o CTE en la Oficina de Opciones Escolares.

¿Qué barreras impiden aumentar la participación de los estudiantes, la tasa de finalización de los cursos y el acceso a la Educación Vocacional y Técnica (CTE) y las certificaciones industriales (IBC)?

Enfrentamos muchas de las mismas barreras y retos que otras áreas académicas en cuanto a la pérdida de aprendizaje y la retención de maestros. Encontrar maestros certificados y calificados capaces de enseñar ciertos cursos es un obstáculo frecuente en varias opciones de CTE. Algunas de nuestras mayores barreras obedecen a la logística y la programación con las escuelas. Cuando los estudiantes se atrasan en las clases académicas básicas, la finalización de los programas de estudio es más difícil. Continuamos trabajando con los líderes de las escuelas y asesorándolos para ayudar con la programación maestra de los cursos y la secuencia de los programas. A menudo, la entidad certificadora en sí plantea requisitos que son más exigentes para el distrito que los que exigían anteriormente. Colaboramos con Servicios Legales y otros distritos asociados para encontrar soluciones, y hemos aumentado las oportunidades experienciales para que los estudiantes conecten con diferentes socios de la industria. Los estudiantes han participado en múltiples actividades que les permiten poner a prueba un trabajo específico y proporcionan aprendizaje práctico sobre múltiples oficios. Estamos involucrando a los estudiantes de secundaria ofreciendo eventos que los exponen a carreras no tradicionales como el "Día de las jóvenes en la industria" que tendrá lugar durante el mes de CTE en febrero.

ÍTEM A.1 (REUNIÓN DE LA MESA DIRECTIVA)

¿Cuál es la visión y el plan a largo plazo para *Grow Your Own*?

Una iniciativa del compromiso del plan estratégico para contar con talento de primera clase son los programas *Grow Your Own*. El alcance de esta iniciativa es dotar a los futuros maestros con habilidades, conocimientos y certificación para que sean docentes líderes. Nuestro propio Programa de Certificación Alternativa de HISD es parte de la iniciativa, y hemos aumentado significativamente la participación en el programa en el ciclo escolar 2022-2023, agregando un grupo de mitad de año y aprovechando los fondos de ESSER para que el programa sea gratuito para los participantes, y continuará siendo gratuito en el año fiscal 2023-2024. La Oficina de Talento continuamente busca, colabora y planifica con varios socios de instituciones de la educación superior (IHE), en particular la Universidad de Houston, la Universidad de Houston-Downtown y la Universidad de Houston-Clear Lake.

El propósito ha sido identificar áreas de asociación que permitan a HISD establecer programas coordinados, priorizados, apoyados financieramente y sostenibles para futuros maestros, con énfasis especial en las poblaciones objetivo, que son los graduados de HISD y los asistentes de enseñanza de HISD. Con el apoyo de Houston Endowment, prevemos la inscripción próxima de una o más asociaciones, como programas de aprendizaje del Departamento de Trabajo. Si bien estas distintas

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gestiones continúan simultáneamente, en enero comenzamos el trabajo para crear un plan integral del programa *Grow Your Own* en un período de seis meses. Compartiremos más detalles sobre la visión y el plan a largo plazo cuando ese trabajo esté terminado.

¿Todas las escuelas están usando T-TESS?

Sí. Adoptamos la rúbrica del Sistema de Evaluación y Apoyo de los Maestros de Texas (T-TESS) como marco de instrucción para el distrito y colaboramos con el Centro de Servicios Educativos de la Región IV para capacitar al 100% de los evaluadores de las escuelas. Después de los comentarios iniciales de un comité de diseño docente y un comité técnico, elaboramos un sistema de evaluación docente T-TESS que incluye varias medidas de desempeño: 40% de práctica de instrucción, 40% de crecimiento estudiantil y 20% de retroalimentación de los estudiantes. En estas decisiones de diseño, consideramos nuestras prioridades para proporcionar a los maestros información justa, precisa y útil, a la vez que creamos la base para un programa exitoso de asignación de incentivos para maestros. Colaboramos en actividades de calibración continuas en todas las escuelas, involucrando a los líderes escolares en el análisis de las tendencias de la práctica de instrucción y las calificaciones de observación. Dado nuestro interés en la gestión de cambio eficiente, anunciamos que las primeras calificaciones sumativas de los maestros en el marco de T-TESS serán en la primavera de 2024, lo que dará tiempo para analizar las experiencias del primer año y ajustarlas según sea necesario.

Sírvase describir el apoyo personalizado para maestros recién contratados. Por favor, describa el apoyo para directores en torno a la gestión y supervisión del talento.

El apoyo personalizado para los maestros recién contratados se incluye en la respuesta del superintendente como uno de los apoyos específicos para estos maestros en las escuelas identificadas para la medida de progreso de restricción. Primero, durante los próximos cinco meses, el Programa de Certificación Alternativa de HISD y los equipos de Desarrollo Profesional de Maestros, cada uno de los cuales brinda apoyo directo e indirecto a los maestros recién contratados, proporcionarán más horas de apoyo a los maestros de las escuelas identificadas. En segundo lugar, brindaremos más apoyo personalizado por email y por teléfono a los maestros recién reclutados en estas escuelas antes y después de administrar nuestro nuevo proceso de Intención de Retorno en febrero y marzo. La gestión y supervisión estratégica del talento es una de las nueve iniciativas del compromiso del plan estratégico para contar con talento de primera clase. El propósito de esta iniciativa es proveer apoyo proactivo y estratégico a los directores de escuela y otros encargados de contratación. La oficina de talento cuenta con un departamento de gestión de talento compuesto por gerentes, cada uno de ellos con un número de casos de directores de escuela o supervisores de la oficina central a quienes apoyan como enlace para todo lo relacionado con la gestión de talento y personal. En noviembre y diciembre, los directores de escuela fueron asignados a su nuevo (o continuo) gerente de talento, y hemos recibido comentarios muy positivos sobre el apoyo diario que están brindando. Más adelante, un ejemplo de apoyo coordinado estará relacionado con una nueva encuesta del personal de todo el distrito. A medida que el distrito introduce una nueva encuesta de la cultura educativa de los maestros (y otro personal escolar) esta primavera, los gerentes de talento apoyarán a los directores en la revisión y planificación en función de los comentarios de esa encuesta.

ÍTEM A.2

Por favor, explique la Función 91 y la Función 97.

La Función 91 es el pago de recuperación; la descripción es el nombre que la TEA le da a esta función. La Función 97 es nuestros pagos de la Zona de Reinversión de Impuestos (TIRZ). Estos son acuerdos contractuales por los cuales los impuestos que recaudamos en estas zonas se remiten a la Ciudad de Houston para financiar una parte del plan general de la ciudad para las zonas. La Ciudad de Houston a cambio envía una parte a HISD para el apoyo de las instalaciones de enseñanza.

¿Dónde está este informe?

HERC está editando el borrador final a medida que se finalizan los informes más recientes. El informe final se compartirá con los representantes en la reunión de la Mesa Directiva del 9 de febrero.

ÍTEM H.1

¿Cómo se determinó que estas escuelas eran las más necesitadas? ¿Qué criterio aplicaron?

La necesidad de reemplazo del techo fue determinada por la Evaluación de las Condiciones de las Instalaciones junto con el techador maestro de HISD, quien determinó que la necesidad en las escuelas especificadas era crítica en ese momento.

¿Por qué Atlas está dos veces en la lista? ¿Y dos cantidades separadas?

Se prepararon tres (3) paquetes para obtener los mejores precios en ofertas de techo y, por lo tanto, cada paquete de licitación es un paquete independiente; Atlas Roofing presentó la mejor propuesta de costos para dos de los tres paquetes. Cada proveedor puede presentar ofertas para tantos paquetes como desee. Cada paquete de licitación tiene un alcance específico para las escuelas y el costo puede variar según el alcance del proyecto.

ÍTEM H.3

¿Qué otras escuelas se pueden beneficiar de esta idea? ¿Qué circunstancias previsibles podrían causar que el costo aumente de \$500k a más de \$1M?

Este proyecto fue planificado y financiado por la escuela. Cualquier beneficio académico requeriría una respuesta de la administración de la escuela.

El presupuesto para este proyecto aumentó debido a la disponibilidad de fondos adicionales proporcionados a la escuela por fuentes externas.

¿De qué función se asignan estos fondos? ¿Cómo se seleccionó esta escuela?

Esto se financiaría con cargo a la adquisición y construcción de instalaciones, Función 81. Los fondos se derivaron de una subvención de asignaciones de HUD de la oficina de la congresista Sheila Jackson Lee. El proyecto se inició en la Preparatoria Booker T. Washington en 2016. Los estudiantes de Booker T. Washington presentaron el proyecto a la comunidad y la oficina de la congresista se interesó y quiso ayudar en el llamado “Proyecto Visión Booker T. Washington”.

ÍTEM I.1

¿En qué escuelas se ha encontrado asbestos? ¿Cuál es exactamente el propósito de una gestión de proyectos? ¿Por qué no se puede sencillamente retirar el asbestos?

Este proyecto preventivo permite al distrito contratar a una empresa consultora externa para pruebas de muestreo y gestión de proyectos en caso de que se detecte asbestos en un edificio del distrito.

¿Qué escuelas tienen programa culinario? ¿Por qué no hay publicidad para este programa?

Actualmente seis escuelas ofrecen el programa de estudio de Artes Culinarias. Todos los programas de Educación Vocacional y Técnica se encuentran en el sitio web del departamento, junto con Opciones Escolares y la herramienta "School Finder" del distrito. Además, las escuelas organizan sus propios eventos para promover sus programas a los estudiantes y padres.

ÍTEM I.4

¿La matrícula de Texas Connections Academy disminuyó? Pensé que tenían una lista de espera. ¿En cuánto disminuyó?

La matrícula de Texas Connections del ciclo 2022-2023 es 8,967 mientras que en el ciclo 2021-2022 era 10,127, según las cifras del primer semestre. Ahora que las escuelas han regresado al aprendizaje presencial, la demanda de un entorno virtual ha disminuido significativamente.

Parece que muchas de nuestras fuentes de ingresos están disminuyendo. ¿Hemos pensado en otras fuentes de ingresos? Por favor, dé ejemplos de lo que otros distritos de la región y de Texas están haciendo al respecto.

Los ingresos generales están aumentando para el Fondo General, el Servicio de la Deuda y los Servicios de Nutrición. En el Fondo General, los ingresos por impuestos a la propiedad están disminuyendo mayormente debido a la tasa impositiva más baja adoptada en octubre de 2022, determinada mediante un proceso de la TEA aprobado por los votantes, a pesar de que los valores certificados de las propiedades fueron más altos en comparación con los valores estimados certificados.

En los distritos escolares, hay dos maneras principales de generar nuevos ingresos retenibles (netos de recuperación estatal):

1) aumentar la matrícula y la asistencia diaria promedio y lograr que los estudiantes sean identificados adecuadamente en categorías especiales, por ejemplo, económicamente desfavorecidos

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2) llevar a elecciones la tasa impositiva aprobada por los votantes (VATR) para que los contribuyentes aprueben un aumento de la tasa impositiva de mantenimiento y operaciones del distrito

En el Fondo de Servicio de la Deuda, los impuestos a la propiedad están aumentando debido a los mayores valores certificados de las propiedades en comparación con los valores estimados certificados.

En el Fondo de Servicios de Nutrición, el principal impulsor es un aumento temporal en las tasas federales de reembolso para comidas escolares.

REFERENCIA AL MANUAL DE GOBERNANZA DE LONE STAR PARA VISIÓN Y OBJETIVOS 4 (CPMS):

¿El estado de cada medida de progreso de restricción se puede actualizar varias veces durante el año escolar? ¿Cómo se ajustará el calendario de monitoreo?

Sí, cada una tendrá datos que se pueden compartir varias veces. El calendario de monitoreo se está actualizando y se incluirá en la agenda de la reunión de la Mesa Directiva de marzo si estos CPM son considerados predictivos de la restricción misma por los representantes en febrero.

¿Cuáles son los objetivos anuales para las medidas de progreso de restricción propuestas?

Una vez que los representantes den a la administración la aprobación para seguir adelante con los CPM recomendados, se establecerán objetivos anuales y se presentará un informe durante la primera ronda.

¿Cómo lograrán estas medidas de progreso de restricción (CPM) motivar a la organización a centrarse en la visión?

Estos objetivos más altos presentan un reto a la organización, ya que requieren de medidas significativas, continuación de las asociaciones actuales, un cambio en la asignación de recursos para las medidas de asistencia y la colaboración de las escuelas y la administración para la identificación del espacio.

¿Cómo lograrán estas medidas de progreso de restricción (CPM) motivar a la organización a defender los valores de la comunidad?

Están alineados y son predictivos de la restricción que fue redactada por los representantes para coincidir con los valores de la comunidad que identificaron antes de adoptar las restricciones. Por lo tanto, al ser predictivos, a su vez también motivan a la organización a defender los valores de la comunidad.

¿Cómo son predictivos de la Restricción 2?

Cada una de estas tres áreas es predictiva en el sentido de que son indicadores de programas efectivos de servicios integrados. Al centrarnos en estos indicadores, podemos ofrecer un programa efectivo.

¿Son influenciables por el superintendente?

Sí, porque requieren trabajo de la administración para lograr el éxito.

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¿Qué participación y comunicación con la comunidad se llevó a cabo para lograr una involucración comunitaria amplia en estas medidas de progreso de restricción por parte de los estudiantes, el personal y los miembros de la comunidad?

En colaboración con HERC, Servicios Integrados de HISD realizó múltiples encuestas a familias y estudiantes para identificar las necesidades de la comunidad en esta área. Estas medidas de progreso de restricción están alineadas con los recursos que se necesitan para apoyar a los estudiantes. Además, se hizo un análisis de datos ya que nos centramos en los impactos negativos del ausentismo crónico y la deserción escolar, por lo que se agregó el CPM adicional a fin de abordar la mitigación de estos impactos.

Una inquietud sobre las actuales medidas de progreso de restricción (CPM) es que están midiendo los resultados de los adultos y no la efectividad en términos de impacto estudiantil. Esto conlleva el potencial de promover un enfoque en el cumplimiento de cuotas en lugar de identificar y apoyar eficazmente las necesidades de los estudiantes. La propuesta revisada de CPM 2.1 cambia exitosamente el enfoque a los estudiantes; sin embargo, los CPM 2.2 y 2.3 están escritos de manera que se mantiene el enfoque en los resultados de los adultos. ¿Podrían redactarse centrándola más en el estudiante?

Las CPM 2.2 y 2.3 están escritas para enfatizar los elementos fundamentales de los sistemas integrados efectivos. Las investigaciones sugieren que para poder apoyar 2.1, debe haber una disponibilidad clara y constante de recursos para satisfacer la necesidad más inmediata de los estudiantes. Con base en los datos de la plataforma del distrito y la Encuesta de Evaluación de Necesidades del Consorcio de Investigación Educativa de Houston, las necesidades básicas (inseguridad alimentaria, ropa, productos de higiene, etc.) y las necesidades físicas y socioemocionales siguen siendo las mayores necesidades identificadas en nuestro distrito.

Especificamente para la medida de progreso de restricción (CPM) 2.2, ¿el aumento del número de escuelas con un espacio de recursos básicos garantiza automáticamente que todos los estudiantes identificados como necesitados de esos recursos los reciban "inmediatamente" desde el momento en que se identifica la necesidad en PURPLE?

Las investigaciones demuestran que la esencia de los sistemas de servicios integrados es eliminar barreras para que las familias aumenten el potencial de preparación académica de los estudiantes. La capacidad de satisfacer las necesidades básicas de los estudiantes a menudo se considera una acción crucial de apoyo integral efectivo en los sistemas escolares. Si bien este no es un proceso "automático", establecer un espacio en la escuela con artículos de primera necesidad acelera la capacidad de satisfacer las necesidades identificadas de nuestros estudiantes. Esto también crea un punto de apoyo constante tanto para el estudiante como para la familia, por lo que es una conexión más directa estar en la escuela, especialmente para los estudiantes que faltan a clase debido a que no tienen acceso a algunos de esos recursos.

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Especificamente para 2.3, ¿cómo garantizará esta medida de progreso de restricción (CPM) que el porcentaje de estudiantes identificados como necesitados de servicios esté conectado con los servicios que necesitan? ¿El aumento del número de proveedores aumenta automáticamente la conexión de los estudiantes con esos servicios de manera oportuna? ¿Cómo se eligió el número objetivo? ¿Cómo garantiza esto la eficacia de los proveedores de servicios para satisfacer las necesidades identificadas de los estudiantes?

Mientras continuamos viendo la alta demanda de apoyo para la salud mental y reconociendo las barreras (como la capacidad, ubicación y tipo de servicios de nuestros socios, entre otros), queremos aumentar continuamente el número de socios en esa área. No obstante, aumentar el número de socios no aumenta automáticamente la conexión de los estudiantes con esos servicios porque el tipo de servicios puede variar, aunque sí aumenta la oportunidad de tener más ofertas para atender a tantos estudiantes como sea posible. Algunos proveedores pueden ser financiados por subvenciones que requieren que el estudiante tenga seguro, un número del seguro social u otros requisitos limitantes. El objetivo se eligió en función de cálculos del número promedio de socios que han podido ser incorporados en un ciclo escolar determinado. Hay investigaciones que indican que los servicios integrados efectivos en un entorno escolar deben incluir una gama de servicios, entre ellos los servicios para la salud mental, lo cual requiere la colaboración con socios y organizaciones que puedan ofrecer esos servicios de manera coordinada, integral y accesible.

Si bien la restricción establece específicamente "servicios integrados", ¿los servicios de apoyo proporcionados por otros departamentos, como los Servicios de Apoyo al Estudiante, se incluyen también en los datos medidos por CPM 2.1?

Sí. En esta restricción, el término "sistemas integrados" es más amplia e incluye los Servicios de Apoyo Estudiantil, como consejeros, trabajadores sociales y salud física y mental. El departamento de Servicios Integrados es parte de este sistema, ya que son los conectores, pero los servicios y apoyos abarcan una colaboración más amplia que incluye apoyo a la administración escolar. Durante los últimos dos años, nos hemos centrado en asegurar la disponibilidad de apoyo holístico y diseñar formas de crear un ecosistema sostenible para apoyar las necesidades de los estudiantes, y continuaremos agregando más capas para garantizar la continuidad de la atención y el apoyo. Contar con las herramientas adecuadas para llegar a este objetivo será fundamental para el éxito de la ejecución de sistemas de apoyo efectivos.

¿Qué porcentaje de estudiantes de Nivel III pasaron del Nivel III en el otoño de 2021 al Nivel II en la primavera de 2022?

Esta es una nueva métrica que monitorearemos ahora, y el sistema no estaba configurado para informar esta medida específica en años académicos anteriores.

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Preguntas y Respuestas

¿Por qué estas medidas de progreso de restricción (CPM) finalizan en junio de 2024? Si bien los CPM pueden tener un plazo de uno a cinco años, la restricción no está limitada en el tiempo y, por lo tanto, estos CPM pueden finalizar en 2024, aunque no es obligación. No hay requisito de que la fecha límite para las restricciones sea la misma que para las metas.

La fecha de finalización de las restricciones ciertamente puede extenderse a la fecha que la Mesa Directiva considere más apropiada para medir el progreso de este trabajo. A medida que el trabajo evolucione, monitorearemos, revisaremos y ajustaremos cuando sea necesario. Basándonos en las conversaciones sostenidas durante la redacción de la medida de progreso, queremos asegurarnos de que las medidas de progreso sigan impulsando el cambio de comportamiento de los adultos en junio de 2024 cuando cumplamos con los objetivos de nuestros próximos pasos.

La revisión de 2.1 parece ser una medida impactante que no solo promoverá mejores resultados para los estudiantes que están ausentes crónicamente, porque no pueden aprender si no están en la escuela, sino que tiene el beneficio adicional de aumentar la ADA. Para esta medida de progreso de restricción (CPM), ¿por qué se eligió este objetivo y por qué el superintendente cree que solo necesitamos monitorear este CPM durante un año?

Los sistemas de servicios integrados basados en la escuela tienen el potencial de aumentar la asistencia de los estudiantes al abordar las barreras no educativas que pueden impedir que los estudiantes asistan a la escuela regularmente. Al proporcionar una gama de servicios y apoyos para abordar estas barreras, los sistemas de servicios integrados efectivos pueden crear un entorno de aprendizaje más positivo y productivo para los estudiantes así como conexiones positivas con adultos afectuosos, lo cual aumenta el sentido de pertenencia y la participación de los estudiantes en las escuelas, y a su vez puede conducir a una mejor asistencia. También reconocemos que aumentar la asistencia de los estudiantes es un tema complejo, y los sistemas de servicios integrados por sí solos podrían no tener la capacidad para resolver todos los factores que afectan la asistencia. Sin embargo, cuando se implementan de manera efectiva y con los recursos adecuados, pueden ser una estrategia efectiva para abordar algunas de las barreras no educativas para la asistencia y contribuir a mejorar la asistencia de los estudiantes.

Los objetivos actuales y las medidas de progreso de las restricciones vencerán en 2024; esta fecha coincide con el resto de los plazos de la Mesa Directiva. El superintendente cree que nuestros estudiantes, que a menudo enfrentan muchos desafíos socioemocionales, requieren un enfoque intencional para atender algunas de las necesidades identificadas más inmediatas. Los datos del primer año proporcionarán una línea de base hacia el monitoreo continuo del progreso y, si es necesario, se pueden hacer ajustes.

En la CPM 2.2 revisada, tal como se propone y en cuanto a las escuelas restantes que superan el objetivo de doscientos, ¿para cuántas de estas escuelas los datos demuestran que existe la necesidad de un espacio de recursos para necesidades básicas?

De acuerdo con lo que sugieren las prácticas óptimas y las investigaciones, contar con un sistema de servicios integrados efectivo en un entorno escolar debe incluir la capacidad de satisfacer las necesidades básicas lo antes posible. Considerando que tenemos 250 escuelas de Título I, al apuntar a doscientas

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escuelas nos aseguramos de que al menos el 80% de ellas estén posicionadas para satisfacer las necesidades básicas identificadas de nuestros estudiantes.

En la 2.3 revisada, ¿es setenta el número máximo que se necesita?

Setenta sería el mínimo necesario, considerando que la demanda de servicios para la salud mental continúa las tendencias de los últimos 2,5 años.
