## Wharton PK-8 Dual Language Academy to celebrate new building with grand opening ceremony

WHAT:

Wharton PK-8 Dual Language Academy is hosting a grand opening ceremony to celebrate their new school, which opened in January. Built as part of the 2012 Bond Program, the new \$39.2 million building features new learning spaces and labs, a new gym, library, dining commons, a courtyard that preserves heritage trees, and a grand, three-story glass entryway. The project also included a major renovation to the school's historic, original building, which houses the lower grade levels and a community and art room.
