Principal's Corner



I would be remiss not to tell you again how grateful I am to serve the Lamar community. I have a tremendous faculty and staff that is dedicated to working alongside me to meet our mission of serving children. I am reminded each day of how lucky I am to work with such an incredible group of people.

As we move forward into this spring semester, we will begin Student Led Conferences and will start planning student schedules for next school year.

It is the vision of Lamar High School to challenge our students with rigorous coursework as well as to prepare them for life after high school. Under the current college and career readiness goals and the IB programs at Lamar, students in the 11th and 12th grade will fully participate in either the IB Diploma Program (DP) or in the IB Career-related Program (CP).

In both programs students must complete and fulfill all assessment requirements for IB Diploma-level courses. For the DP, the minimum is six such courses, and for the CP, it is two. Additionally, the core class of Theory of Knowledge spans over junior and senior year for DP candidates, while Personal and Professional Skills (coded GTIS on schedules) acts as the core for CP candidates.

Whether or not a student is zoned does not impact that decision and course placement. Students will work with the Academic Deans to develop the most rigorous course of study for their individual abilities and interests.

FAFSA/TAFSA Early Deadline for Seniors

With the passing of House Bill 3, Texas has put in place graduation requirements for students that will include completion of FAFSA, TAFSA, or the signing of an opting out form. We are working to implement these requirements this year to prepare to adequately support all Lamar Texans. By completing the FAFSA or TAFSA students may be eligible for Federal and State aid for college that does not need to be paid back. With this aid it is statistically proven more students will enroll and complete a certification program, 2, or 4 year post-secondary schooling. Here at Lamar we are committed to every Texan having a plan after they leave Lamar and part of the plan we believe is financially being able to afford post-secondary options. If you need any help or assistance with the FAFSA or TAFSA Lamar College Corner is available to help walk you through filling these forms out or answer any questions you may have.

Finals Exemption Explanation

Student may gain eligibility for finals exemptions if they meet the following two conditions:

- Student may have no more than 3 absences in any one class.
- Student must have an E or S in conduct and no discipline referrals.

Once a student is determined eligible for exemption(s) they will receive certificate(s) of exemption. They may submit to the teacher for any class with an 85 or better semester average.

Harris County Clerk Needs Civic Minded Students

As a reminder, the Harris County Clerk's office is encouraging students across Harris County to apply to work in the upcoming March 3, 2020 Democratic and Republican Party Primary Elections. We encourage students to apply by our priority deadline of January 31, 2020. Students that meet this deadline are more likely to be placed at a location close to their house as well as have first pick of training classes. We ask that all interested students apply no later than Friday, February 14, 2020.

When students serve on Election Day they receive:

- \$17 an hour (a \$7 an hour raise from last year!)
- Paid training
- An excused absence from school
- A letter of recommendation from Harris County Clerk Dr. Diane Trautman

Students now have the opportunity to work as an Electronics Support Specialist, responsible for the set-up and maintenance of the elections equipment. Our aim is to have one Electronic Support Specialist at each of the Election Day polling locations.

I've attached a FAQ sheet as well as the permission form your students need to complete should they be interested in working. The application form is also available online here. In addition, should there be any speaking opportunities in your classrooms, a member of our Outreach staff will be available to provide information.
