Last year you may remember that we made the switch in our curriculum to the new IB mathematics courses in 11th grade that would put a student on a two year SL or two year HL track. This year we will be phasing in the similar trajectory with our science courses. Students will select not only the area of science they wish to study, but will also have the opportunity to take a two year SL track or a two year HL track beginning with 11th grade in the 2020-2021 school year.

We are encouraging students to select the math and science courses that complement one another and support their areas of interest and future career goals. These will be discussed with students and parents during student led conferences to help students make informed choices as they move from our IB MYP Programme in 9th and 10th grade to our IB Diploma or IB Career-related Programme in 11th and 12th grade.

June 2020 China Summer Study Abroad for Houston ISD Students

Dates & Location: Tentatively June 6-22, 2020, Beijing & Chongqing, China

Activities: Students will study Mandarin Chinese language, experience traditional art forms through learning Chinese calligraphy and paper cutting, participate in cultural activities such as conducting a formal tea ceremony, and visit points of interest and sites of natural beauty in China, including the Great Wall of China near Beijing.

Eligibility: HISD students who will be 9th-12th graders in an HISD high school in SY20-21, who want to learn Chinese language and culture in an intensive setting, and who will be recommended highly by their teachers. You do not have to be enrolled in Chinese class to apply.

Cost: Total cost will be approximately \$1800 which includes international airfare, medical insurance, and Chinese travel visa fee. All food, hotel, transportation and program costs are covered during the two-week program. Student must have a valid passport.

The ASVAB is a multiple choice assessment, administered by the United States Military Entrance Processing Command, used to determine qualification for enlistment in the United States Armed Forces. This test covers eight general subjects, testing your current knowledge and propensity to learn in different subject areas. It contains questions on English, science, mechanics and electronics. Harris County Clerk Needs Civic Minded Students

As a reminder, the Harris County Clerk's office is encouraging students across Harris County to apply to work in the upcoming March 3, 2020 Democratic and Republican Party Primary Elections. We encourage students to apply by our priority deadline of January 31, 2020. Students that meet this deadline are more likely to be placed at a location close to their house as well as have first pick of training classes. We ask that all interested students apply no later than Friday, February 14, 2020.

When students serve on Election Day they receive:

- \$17 an hour (a \$7 an hour raise from last year!)
- Paid training
- · An excused absence from school
- A letter of recommendation from Harris County Clerk Dr. Diane Trautman

Students now have the opportunity to work as an Electronics Support Specialist, responsible for the set-up and maintenance of the elections equipment. Our aim is to have one Electronic Support Specialist at each of the Election Day polling locations.
