- 2. **Budget** based on our projection and enrollment, we are 9 students shy of the projection.

3. SIP 2021-2022

- a. Goals tied to achievement on the STAAR test, we are currently rated a C and our goal for this year is to be a B. 3rd grade students will increase by 8% from 49% to 47% in reading. 3rd grade students will increase 8% in math. Sped students will increase 10% at the approaches level. Attendance will increase from 94% to 96%. Will maintain a low discipline rate. Will reach 100% of IEP goals. We will be platinum certified by FACE and will increase parental involvement by 2% in all 4 categories. We will be at 100% for immunizations and health screenings.
- b. School Initiatives
 - i. I-3 Differentiated Instruction small group instruction tiered assignments
 - ii. Sheltered Instruction strategies like turn and talk meant to help English learners be successful in the classroom
 - iii. Professional Learning Communities (focused) Meet with teachers each week and focus on either IAT, SPED, Admin, of Vertical planning
