Principal's Corner



The last seven days have been tough for this community, and I want nothing more than to know that our children are working through this really challenging time in a healthy way. I addressed the student body yesterday through LCT and shared two things they could do to help – 1) Be where you are supposed to be; 2) If you see something, say something.

All members of administration are visible and on duty throughout the campus, and we are being vigilant with supervision. All week, we have had administrators monitoring the main entrance and main hallway, and we will place someone there full time to great guests. Today has been a very smooth day, and I think it is helping students gain a sense of normalcy.

I want you to know that we are working with a number of agencies, departments and organizations to ensure our students feel safe and indeed are safe when at school. Let me walk you through the things we are working on to make that happen.

Lamar PTO – PTO will be working alongside CIS to organize an event for parents right after Thanksgiving to give guidance to parents on supporting their children through loss.

HISD Counseling Services – HISD initiated the Crisis Team protocol to ensure we are available to support students with additional grief counseling.

HISD Facility and Construction Services -

- A complete review of our PA system is under way, and repairs are being made to any areas of the building that are not generating a clear sound.
- Contractors were on site today to survey the campus for a card access system to allow us to have better control of entries into the building.

Houston Police Department and HISD Police Department – Extra officers have been on campus this week, and we have been placed on close-patrol so that other officers are in close proximity. We have received incredible support from both police agencies to ensure students feel safe. Additionally, HPD detectives are continuing to work toward solving the case and have been in touch with us regularly to collect information.

Mayor Turner's Gang Task Force – We met with members of the gang task force yesterday, who were on campus for several hours to talk with students and identify any potential areas of concern.

Student Council and IB Ambassadors – Today, we met with student leaders to discuss a way for students to get involved in the conversation. Student leaders are inviting the student body to join them for pizza and a panel discussion tomorrow. The Lamar Conference for Change will allow students to identify ways they can effect change. County Commissioner Rodney Ellis and Crimestoppers will be on campus tomorrow to participate in this panel discussion.

Once logged in to PSC, open the gradebook and select "Triggers" from the menu on the left. The system will send you an email or a text message the minute your child is marked absent from class. This is a different notification from the one you receive in the evening when your child is absent. PSC offers a real time notification. Dress Code

This is a reminder for students and parents. As the weather gets chillier, we see an increase in jackets that do not meet dress code.
