Principal's Corner



We are keeping a close eye on the current COVID cases and are in the process of contact tracing. Here are the most current guidelines related to close contact:

Fully Vaccinated (15 days or more since your second vaccination of Pfizer or Moderna; OR 15 days or more since your vaccination of JJ):

- If you have been in close contact (15 minutes or more within 6 feet, with or without a mask) with a person who has tested positive **and are not displaying symptoms** - you do not need to quarantine. The recommendation is to get tested on days 3 to 5 after last contact to make sure you are not an asymptomatic carrier.
- If you have been in close contact (15 minutes or more within 6 feet, with or without a mask) with a person who has tested positive **and are displaying symptoms** - you should isolate and get tested.

Not Fully Vaccinated

- If you have been in close contact (15 minutes or more within 6 feet, with or without a mask) with a person who has tested positive **and are not displaying symptoms** - you should begin a 14 day quarantine. The recommendation is to get tested on days 7 to 10 after last contact. You can end the quarantine on day 10 with a negative COVID test.
- If you have been in close contact (15 minutes or more within 6 feet, with or without a mask) with a person who has tested positive **and are displaying symptoms** - you should isolate and get tested.

If your student or another member of your household is displaying symptoms common to COVID, please have your family tested, and contact our school nurse, Brittaney.Davidson@houstonisd.org.


