that because of the current teaching style, students are learning at a higher level and are able to show
growth on different types of assessments. Principal reed collected the questions that were posed from
the committee and submitted them to HISD via the bitly/ QR code that was located within the slide show.

strengthen the literacy skills of our students within the school district. Assistant Principal Dr. Hickerson
