Jan. 22, the robotics team, the Lamar DiscoBots, competed in a robotics tournament located in Montgomery, TX, and received the Excellence Award from VEX Robotics, the highest achievement offered at the competition

Consisting of students Ellery McDaniel, Doruk Dalyanoğlu, Soumil Goyal, Taimur Ilahi, Isaac Harris, Nathan Reese, Japa Parikh, Chiamaka Ibekwe, and Eesa Vettical, the DiscoBots team members were awarded the highest scores in programming skills, the third highest in driver skills, ranked fourth overall in the qualifying matches, and even turned in the second best design notebook.

With this tournament, 2587B has earned their state qualification. They will now be competing at the state-level trying to achieve a spot for the VEX World Championship.



Important Spring Testing Updates

10th grade English 2 STAAR EOC Field Test – February 15th

All Houston ISD High Schools have been selected to participate in the Spring 2022 STAAR EOC Field Test. Our 10th grade students, currently taking English 2, will take the STAAR EOC English 2 Field Test on February 15th starting at 8:30 AM. This field test is required for all students currently taking English 2, but it is not part of their graduation requirement. Testing will be completed through the Texas Online testing platform on the students’ HISD issued laptop. Since we do not have extra technology devices to loan to students, it is important that all students have their laptop and charger with them. If your child’s laptop or charger is missing or broken, it is critical that they go to the Lamar IT Office (N215) for assistance as soon as possible. New laptop chargers can be purchased through the Lamar Business Office or using the SchoolPay link at <https://www.schoolpay.com/pay/for/Laptop-Charger---HP-45W--AC-Adapter--550/SCcrNI> . Please note that all students will be responsible for returning a laptop, charger and case at the end of the school year.

11th grade School Day SAT – March 2nd

All 11th grade students have been registered to take the SAT, free of charge, on Wednesday, March 2nd. Testing will start promptly at 8:30 AM. For more information about the SAT, please visit the [College Board website](#). To help prepare, students are encouraged to complete practice on [Khan Academy's Official SAT Practice website](#). When students connect their College Board account with Khan Academy, a free personalized SAT test preparation plan is developed just for them. Students who use Khan Academy’s SAT practice average a 115 point increase on their SAT score, as well

as qualify for scholarships from the College Board. We will have calculators available for all 11th graders to use on this test.

December 2021 STAAR EOC Student Results

If your child took a STAAR EOC exam in December 2021, their test results are now available at www.texasassessment.gov. If you do not know your child's Unique Access Code, please click on [Look Up Unique Access Code](#). You will need to enter your child's social security number to locate their code. Their Unique Access Code remains the same from 3rd through 12th grade.

IB Oral Assessment Updates for 11th and 12th Grade Parents:

- All 11th and 12th grade **IB English students** will participate in an oral assessment.
 - All students in an **IB language** (Mandarin, French, Arabic, Spanish) class that includes SL2 or HL2 in the course name (for example Spanish SL2) will participate in an oral assessment.
 - These oral assessments are required IB assessments.
 - Students participate in a recorded conversation with their teacher about topics discussed in class.
 - Students will receive teacher guidance and class time to prepare for their oral assessments.
 - Oral assessments begin in February. Students will receive their scheduled oral assessment time and day from their teacher.
 - Your support at home is greatly appreciated. Please encourage your child to arrive on time and prepared for each oral assessment.

Spring Final Exam Exemptions

Currently the District's Guidelines allow us to exempt a student from one or more final exams if the following conditions are met:

- No more than 3 absences in any class; and
- Grade of 85% or better in the class you wish to be exempt from; and
- S or E in conduct with no discipline referrals

Seniors – Eligible to be exempt from all final exams

Juniors and Sophomores – Eligible to be exempt from up to two final exams

Freshman – Eligible to be exempt for one class final exam

****Critical Note**** We are requesting a modification to the guidelines allowing us to modify the attendance requirements for final exam exemption. We have not yet received that guidance. Stand by for more information.
