

Attached is the College-Bound Assessment Report for 2008–2009. This report provides an analysis of Houston Independent School District (HISD) performance for college-bound students on the 2008–2009 administrations of the Preliminary SAT (PSAT), the SAT Reasoning Test (SAT), the ACT Assessment (ACT), Advanced Placement (AP) exams, and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Results are presented by high school, region, and for the district as a whole. State and national data are also presented for comparison purposes.

- Of the 21,979 HISD juniors and sophomores eligible to take the PSAT, a total of 17,886 students participated in the fall 2008 PSAT/NMSQT. These included 10,245 sophomores and 7,641 juniors. The participation rate for all juniors and sophomores combined increased from 80.0 percent in 2007 to 81.4 percent in 2008, in the sixth year of the district initiative.
- The number of Houston Independent School District (HISD) graduating seniors in 2009 with SAT Reasoning results was 4,600, a decrease of 80 students taking the test from the 4,680 students in 2008. In 2009, the average total score for the three subtests was 1387, down from 1408 in 2008.
- The number of Houston Independent School District (HISD) graduating seniors in 2009 with ACT test results was 1,880, an increase of 422 students taking the test from the 1,458 students in 2008. In 2009, the average composite score for HISD students decreased from 20.1 in 2008 to 19.7.
- The number of HISD students participating in AP exams at the high school level in 2009 was 6,069, an increase from 2008, when 5,447 students took AP exams. The total number of exams taken by HISD students increased to 11,594 in 2009, from 10,210 in 2008, up by 14 percent. The percent of exams scored at a 3 or higher was 42 percent, a decrease of nearly 2 percentage points from 2008.

- The total number of IB exams taken by HISD students increased from 1,286 in 2008 to 1,431 in 2009. The percent of HISD exams scored at 4 or above was 77 percent, which was one percentage point higher than the state and two percentage points higher than the nation in 2009.

COLLEGE–BOUND ASSESSMENT REPORT

2008–2009

This report provides an analysis of Houston Independent School District (HISD) performance for college-bound students on the Preliminary SAT (PSAT), SAT Reasoning Test (SAT), ACT Assessment (ACT), and Advanced Placement exams (AP). In addition, the performance results of students who participated in the International Baccalaureate (IB) testing program are provided. Results by ethnicity and gender are presented for each assessment with the exception of IB, which does not provide results by ethnicity and gender. The results for Texas and the nation are presented for comparison purposes. Campus-level data are included at the end of this report.

Preliminary SAT (PSAT)

Introduction

Purpose

The Preliminary SAT (PSAT) is a national examination administered in October of each year by the College Board. The PSAT has three parts: critical reading, mathematics, and writing skills.

The PSAT serves as preparation for the SAT Reasoning Test. One of the benefits that students receive is a report assessing their performance on the PSAT with suggestions to improve their skills. Another important benefit is that the PSAT serves as a qualifying examination for numerous scholarship programs that are sponsored by corporations, colleges and universities, and other organizations, including the National Merit scholarships. The National Merit Scholarship Program began in 1955. Of the top 50,000 scorers nationwide, approximately 16,000 students qualify yearly as semifinalists for the National Merit Scholarship.

In addition to the National Merit Scholarship finalists, other specific recognition is bestowed to high-scoring Hispanic students through the National Hispanic Scholar Program, and to high scoring African American students through the National Scholarship Service and Fund for Negro Students which provides a National Achievement Scholarship to qualified students.

The College Search Service, which is operated by the Educational Testing Service, represents another important benefit for students who take the PSAT. For the 2008 administration, 76.7 percent of HISD students taking the PSAT registered to participate in this search service, by which colleges and universities obtain names and addresses of tested students who meet specific parameters set forth by the colleges, such as geographic location, areas of major interest, and test score range. The colleges then directly contact the students with recruitment information and materials. As a result, the PSAT has come to serve as a vehicle for bringing prospective students to the attention of colleges and universities.

In the fall of 2003, HISD implemented the PSAT Initiative. Through the HISD Foundation, funds were secured to enable the district to fund this proactive initiative by offering the PSAT to all tenth-grade students attending HISD schools in the fall of 2003. This initiative is designed to provide schools with information about sophomores' academic strengths and interests and to aid the district in identifying students with the aptitude for Advance Placement (AP) courses. This initiative also assists the district in preparing students for college entrance exams and enables students to realize the possibilities of continuing their academic careers after high school.

The College Board (2006, Report No. 2006-1) reports that the PSAT can be utilized to identify students who may be successful in AP courses. Previously, teacher recommendations, self-nomination,

previous courses completed, grades in course work, and scores on achievement tests have been successfully used to identify those students that can complete and excel in AP courses. However, this system does not identify all students who could benefit from taking AP courses. The PSAT provides another method of identifying students that can profit academically from enrollment in AP courses. The College Board suggests that teachers and counselors may use expectancy tables, based on PSAT subject area scores and with standards specific to 29 different AP examinations, as an additional predictor of the likelihood of success on AP exams. Schools may elect to use the expectancy tables and AP Potential, which is provided to all schools that administer the PSAT.

Description

The PSAT consists of 48 critical reading, 38 mathematics, and 39 writing items. The reading section of the examination includes sentence completion and critical reading. The sentence completion questions measure the ability to recognize logical relationships between parts of a sentence. The critical reading questions include reading selections from social sciences, natural sciences, and the humanities. The mathematics questions are presented in two formats: multiple-choice and student-produced responses. The mathematics section requires a basic knowledge of four categories: numbers and operations, algebra and functions, geometry and measurement, and data analysis, statistics, and probability. The use of calculators is encouraged. The writing skills section consists of multiple-choice questions that are designed to measure the ability to express ideas effectively in standard written English, to recognize faults in usage and structure, and to use language with sensitivity to meaning.

Scoring

Three scaled scores are generated for each student: a critical reading score, a mathematics score, and a writing score. Each score ranges from 20 to 80; these numbers are analogous to the scaled scores of 200 to 800 generated by the SAT Reasoning Test. Nationally, the average critical reading, mathematics, and writing scores are nearing the midpoint (50) of the 20 to 80 scale.

Administration

The PSAT is a two-hour-and-ten-minute test. The critical reading questions are presented in two 25-minute sections. The mathematics questions are also presented in two 25-minute sections for a total of 100 minutes. For the writing skills section, a total of 30 minutes is allotted for completion. High schools administered the PSAT on their campuses on October 15, 2008.

Participants

A total of 17,886 HISD sophomores and juniors participated in the fall 2008 PSAT/NMSQT. The percent of sophomores and juniors who participated increased from 80.0 percent in 2007 to 81.4 in 2008. The number of sophomores taking the PSAT/NMSQT increased by 882 students from the previous year, and the number of juniors tested increased by 152 students. For the 2008–2009 school year, 35 schools participated in the PSAT.

Results

Districtwide Performance

Analysis of districtwide performance focused on the results of sophomores, juniors, and the combined performance of these two groups. Results from the fall of 2007 and 2008 PSAT are presented in **Table 1**. The averages of student critical reading, mathematics, and writing scores were calculated and analyzed to describe student performance.

- A total of 17,886 students participated in the fall 2008 PSAT. Participants included 10,245 sophomores and 7,641 juniors.
- The mean scores of sophomores on the PSAT in 2008 were 36.3 in reading, 39.5 in mathematics, and 37.4 in writing. HISD sophomores improved their average performance from 2007 to 2008 on the mathematics and writing sections of the PSAT.
- The mean scores of juniors on the PSAT in 2008 were 39.8 in reading, 42.6 in mathematics, and 41.0 in writing. HISD juniors' average performance increased from 2007 to 2008 on the mathematics and writing sections of the PSAT, while their mean score on reading section decreased.
- The mean scores of sophomores and juniors combined in the fall of 2008 were 37.8 in reading, 40.8 in mathematics, and 38.9 in writing. HISD sophomores and juniors combined improved their average performance from 2007 to 2008 on the mathematics and writing sections, and their mean scores on the reading section declined over the same time period.

Race/Ethnicity and Gender

A demographic comparison of fall 2007 and 2008 PSAT participation and mean scores for sophomores and juniors is presented. The mean scores on the PSAT for the following subgroups: African American, Asian American, Hispanic, and White are presented in **Table 2**.

- Sophomores in all student groups reported a decrease in mean reading scores on the PSAT from 2007 to 2008. On the PSAT mathematics section, all students groups except for Asian Americans experienced an increase in mean scores from 2007 to 2008. Sophomore students in the Asian

American and Hispanic student groups improved their mean scores on the writing section of the PSAT in 2008, with Hispanic sophomores reporting the greatest increase, from 35.1 in 2007 to 36.1 in 2008.

- In the junior class, all student groups reported an increase in mean scores on the mathematics section of the PSAT from 2007 to 2008, and all student groups reported an increase in mean scores from 2007 to 2008 on the writing section of the PSAT, except for African American juniors. On the reading section of PSAT, Asian American and White juniors reported an increase in mean scores from 2007 to 2008.

The fall 2008 PSAT mean scores for the reading, mathematics, and writing sections were also examined to determine the achievement gap between Hispanic and African American student groups and their White counterparts. The districtwide differences in mean scores were calculated for sophomores, juniors, and those grades combined. These results are presented in **Table 3**.

- In the fall of 2008, the largest achievement gaps between White sophomores and their minority counterparts on all sections of the PSAT were between White and African American students, with a gap of -13.5 in reading, -12.9 in mathematics, and -11.7 in writing.
- The PSAT results for sophomores for the fall of 2008 indicate that the achievement gap increased between White student performance and African American student performance in reading and mathematics and decreased in writing from 2007. The achievement gap decreased between White student performance and Hispanic student performance in mathematics and writing and remained the same in reading from 2007 to 2008.
- In the fall of 2008, the largest achievement gaps between White juniors and their minority counterparts on all sections of the PSAT were between White and African American students, with a gap of -15.4 in reading, -14.8 in mathematics, and -13.6 in writing.

- The PSAT results for juniors for the fall of 2008 indicate that the achievement gap between White student performance and minority student performance increased from fall 2007 for all PSAT subjects, except for writing, where Hispanic student performance closed the gap with White student performance by 0.4 points.

A gender comparison of fall 2007 and 2008 PSAT mean scores for sophomores, juniors, and combined is presented in **Table 4**.

- For both the sophomore and junior classes, females out performed males on the reading and writing sections of the fall 2008 PSAT, while males out performed females on the mathematics section.
- Sophomore and junior female and male students experienced a decrease in mean scores on the reading section of the PSAT from 2007 to 2008. Junior female and male students and sophomore male students experienced an increase on the writing section, and all groups experienced an increase on the mathematics section of the PSAT from 2007 to 2008, except for female juniors whose performance remained the same.

HISD, Texas, and Nation

A comparison of HISD sophomores and juniors to their counterparts in Texas and the nation is presented in **Table 5**.

- In 2008, the reading mean score for HISD sophomores was below the nation by 5.3 points and 4.0 points below Texas. HISD juniors trailed the nation in reading by 6.9 points and Texas by 4.2 points on the reading section of the PSAT. Both HISD sophomores and juniors increased the gaps between their reading performance and their state and national counterparts in 2008.
- On the mathematics section of the PSAT, HISD sophomores scored 4.5 points below their counterparts in the nation and 4.0 points below their counterparts in Texas. The mathematics mean score for HISD juniors was below the nation by 6.2 points and below Texas by 4.4 points. Both HISD sophomores and juniors increased the gaps between their mathematics performance and the performance of both their state and national counterparts in 2008.
- HISD sophomores trailed the nation by 3.6 points and the state both by 3.0 points on the writing section of the PSAT. The writing mean score for HISD juniors was below the nation by 4.8 points and 3.4 points below Texas. The PSAT writing performance gaps between the district and both state and national scores decreased for sophomores from 2007 to 2008 and the gap with the nation decreased for juniors over the same period.

SAT Reasoning Test (SAT)

Introduction

Purpose

The SAT Reasoning Test (SAT) is a college-entrance exam developed by the College Board. The SAT provides a standard by which the skills of students applying for colleges and universities can be compared nationally. Standardized tests are designed to allow college admissions officers to judge all students by a common measuring stick. Standardized test scores compensate for the uncertainty surrounding high school grades, school-to-school differences, grade inflation, and teaching quality, for example. In addition, admissions officers use these scores as a way to predict academic performance in the first year of college. Educational organizations recognize scores on the SAT as useful indicators of college readiness and valid predictors of college success.

Description

The SAT is designed to measure developed verbal and mathematical reasoning abilities related to successful performance in college. The SAT was redesigned for 2005, and the first administration of the new test was given on March 12, 2005. Changes included the addition of third-year college-preparatory mathematics, more critical reading selections, and a writing section. The SAT is a three-hour and forty-five-minute exam. There are seven sections: three mathematics, two critical reading, and two writing, including a twenty-five minute essay.

Administration

The test is administered seven times per year nationwide. Most students take the SAT at national administrations during their junior and senior years in high school. Colleges use SAT scores to make admission decisions, recruit students, place students in appropriate courses, and predict student performance at the college-level; however, they are intended to supplement student records.

Scoring

In order to get an SAT raw score, a fraction of the multiple-choice questions answered incorrectly is subtracted from the number answered correctly. If that resulting score is a fraction, it is rounded to the nearest whole number -- $\frac{1}{2}$ or more is rounded up; less than $\frac{1}{2}$ is rounded down. The raw score is then changed into a scaled score by a statistical process called equating. Equating adjusts for slight differences in difficulty between test editions and ensures that a score on one edition of a test reflects the same ability as a score on another edition and that the score does not depend on how well others did on the same edition. Scores for the critical reading, math, and writing sections of the SAT range from 200 to 800. A combined score is calculated by adding the section scores together. A 2400 is the highest possible combined score. The critical reading and math sections of the new SAT correspond to the verbal and math sections of the previous version of the SAT.

Participants

The number of HISD graduating seniors in 2009 with SAT results was 4,600, a decrease of 80 students taking the test from the 4,680 students in 2008.

Districtwide Performance

Districtwide results were summed and calculated to determine the number of students tested, the mean verbal score, the mean mathematics score, the mean writing score, and the combined score for the SAT. **Table 6** presents districtwide results for the classes of 1999 through 2009.

- The number of HISD graduating seniors in 2009 with SAT results was 4,600, a decrease of 80 students taking the test than the 4,680 students in 2008.
- The average critical reading score decreased eight points from 2008 to 458. The average score on the math subtest declined by one point in 2009 to 476, and the average writing test score decreased twelve points in 2009 to 453.
- In 2009, the average total score for the three subtests was 1387, down from 1408 in 2008.

Race/Ethnicity and Gender

A demographic comparison of SAT participation and mean scores for the HISD class of 2009 are presented in **Table 7**. The mean scores on the SAT for the following subgroups: American Indian, Asian American, African American, Hispanic, White, and other are examined. The College Board provides data for “Puerto Rican,” “Mexican or Mexican American,” and “Other Hispanic, Latino, or Latin American” student groups, and these data are combined for district results for the Hispanic student group. In addition, SAT scores of students who did not indicate their race/ethnicity are provided.

- The number of students tested increased from 2008 to 2009 for students in the American Indian, Asian American, and Hispanic student groups. Hispanic students increased their participation by 117 from 2008 to 2009.
- The critical reading SAT scores increased from 2008 to 2009 for American Indian, White, and students who did not indicate their ethnicity. Math SAT scores also increased in 2009 for American Indian, White, Hispanic, and students who did not indicate their ethnicity. American Indian and White students' scores improved from 2008 to 2009 on the writing section of the SAT.
- Average scores on all three sections of the 2009 SAT test increased for students in the American Indian and White student groups. Average scores for students in the African American and "Other" student groups decreased on all sections of the SAT from 2008 to 2009.

The SAT scores for the critical reading and mathematics sections were also examined to determine the difference between the performances of student groups. Expressly, the achievement gap between minority student groups, Hispanic and African American students, and their White counterparts was examined. The districtwide differences in average scores were calculated for 2008 and 2009. These results are presented in **Table 8**.

- The achievement gaps increased for SAT reading and writing from 2008 to 2009 between White students and both their African American and Hispanic counterparts. On the SAT math test, the

achievement gap increased from 2008 to 2009 between White and African American students and decreased by two points between White and Hispanic students.

- The largest achievement gaps between White students and their minority counterparts on all sections of the 2009 SAT were between White and African American students, with gaps of -153 points in reading and writing and -151 points in math.

The SAT scores for the critical reading and mathematics sections were also examined to determine the difference in the performance of students based on gender. These results are presented in **Table 9**.

- The number of female students tested on the SAT decreased from 2,631 in 2008 to 2,583 in 2009. The number of male students tested decreased from 2,046 in 2008 to 2,017 in 2009.
- Both female and male students experienced a decrease in their average scores on all sections of the SAT from 2008 to 2009. Female students' mean scores decreased by only one point in math and by nine points in writing, while male students' mean scores decreased by two points in math and 15 points in writing.
- Female students outperformed their male counterparts on both the critical reading and writing sections of the SAT in 2009, while male students outscored female students on the math section of the SAT in 2009.

HISD, Texas, and Nation

A comparison of HISD students on the SAT to their counterparts in Texas and in the nation for the graduating classes of 2008 and 2009 is presented in **Table 10**.

- The critical reading mean score for HISD decreased by eight points, while Texas' mean score decreased by two points, and the nation's reading score decreased by one point from 2008 to 2009.

Mathematics scores decreased by one point for HISD, while the state improved by one point, and the nation's scores remained the same from 2008 to 2009. Mean writing scores decreased by twelve points for HISD and five points for the state, while the nation's mean writing score decreased by one point from 2008 to 2009.

- In 2009, HISD trailed Texas by 28 points and the nation by 43 points on the critical reading section of the SAT. On the mathematics sections of the SAT, HISD was 30 points below Texas and 39 points below the nation's score. On the writing section of the SAT, the average score for HISD students was 22 points below Texas and 40 points below the nation in 2009.
- For 2009, HISD increased the achievement gap with the state and the nation on all three sections of the SAT.

ACT Assessment (ACT)

Introduction

Purpose

The founders of the ACT established the American College Testing Program in 1959. The program, which evolved from the Iowa Tests of Educational Development at the University of Iowa, was used to help students make better decisions regarding their postsecondary education and to provide more information to colleges. Colleges use the data to help them plan their curricula and place students in the appropriate courses of study. In late 1996, they changed their name from the American College Testing Program to ACT. The ACT is a national college-admission exam. It assesses both the general educational level of high school students and their readiness for college-level work.

Description

The ACT consists of four tests: English, mathematics, reading, and science reasoning. The tests are curriculum-based and universally accepted by U.S. colleges and universities. The test takes two hours and 55 minutes. There are 75 questions on the English test, 60 questions on the mathematics, 40 questions on the reading, and 40 questions on the science test.

Administration

The ACT is administered five times per year nationally in October, December, February, April, and June. In selected states, the ACT is also offered in late September. Most students take the ACT during the winter or spring of their junior year, saving the fall of their senior year for retesting, if necessary.

Scoring

The ACT assessment takes raw scores and converts them to scale scores that have the same meaning for all forms of the tests. The scale scores range from 1 to 36 for each of the four tests and for the composite. The composite is the average of the four test scores, rounded to the nearest whole number. A 36 is the highest possible composite score.

Participants

The number of Houston Independent School District (HISD) graduating seniors in 2009 with ACT test results was 1,880, an increase of 422 students taking the test from the 1,458 students in 2008. The participation rate of HISD students on the ACT is generally lower than the participation rate of students on the SAT.

Results

Districtwide Performance

Districtwide figures were summed and calculated to determine the number of students tested and the mean English, mathematics, reading, science reasoning, and composite scores. Results for the graduating classes of 1999 through 2009 on the ACT are presented in **Table 11**.

- The number of graduating seniors in 2009 with ACT results was 1,880, an increase of 422 from the 1,458 students taking the test in 2008.
- The class of 2009 experienced a decrease in mean scores for all of the sections of the ACT assessment compared to the class of 2008. The composite score for HISD students decreased from 20.1 in 2008 to 19.7 in 2009.
- The highest mean score on any subtest of the ACT for graduating seniors in 2009 was reported on the math test, with a score of 20.3.
- Over the last eleven years, the composite ACT score has ranged from a low of 18.5 in 2002 to a high of 20.1 in 2008.

Race/Ethnicity and Gender

A demographic comparison of the ACT participation and mean scores for the class of 2009 is presented. The mean scores on the ACT for the following subgroups: African American, Asian American, Mexican American, and White are presented in **Table 12**.

- African American students showed a decrease in performance from 2008 on all sections of the ACT and in their mean composite score in 2009 on the ACT, and Hispanic students' scores also decreased or remained constant on all sections of the ACT over the same period.

- White students' mean scores for 2009 increased or remained constant from 2008 on all sections of the ACT, and scores for students in the Asian American student group increased for all sections of the ACT except for science from 2008 to 2009.

- Mean scores for both female and male students decreased on all sections of the ACT from 2008 to 2009, except for males' performance in reading, which remained the same. Decreases for female students ranged from 0.3 to 0.4 points on all sections of the ACT, and decreases for males ranged from 0.1 to 0.2 points.
- In 2009, female students outperformed their male counterparts on the English section of the ACT, while male students outperformed their female counterparts on the mathematics, reading, and science sections of the ACT, as well as on the mean composite score in 2009.

HISD, Texas, and Nation

A comparison of HISD students on the ACT to their counterparts in Texas and the nation for the graduating classes of 2008 and 2009 is presented in **Table 14**.

- The average ACT scores for both Texas and the nation held constant or increased on all subjects tested and on the composite score from 2008 to 2009. Average scores for HISD decreased over the same time period for all subjects and the composite score; thus, performance gaps between the district and both the state and nation on the ACT increased from 2008 to 2009.

- The largest performance differences for 2009 were on the science and reading sections, with HISD trailing the nation by a difference of 1.6 points, and on the reading section, with HISD trailing the nation by a difference of 1.6 points.
- In 2009, HISD trailed Texas by a 1.1-point difference in mean composite score and the nation by a difference of 1.4 points in mean composite score, increasing the performance gap from 2008.

Advanced Placement (AP)

Introduction

Purpose

The Advanced Placement (AP) Program was established in 1955 as a cooperative educational endeavor between secondary schools and colleges and universities. Since its inception in 1955, the program has provided high school students with the opportunity to take college-level courses and earn college credit. The courses are equivalent to a first-year college course and are taught by highly qualified teachers. Most American colleges and universities accept AP courses with qualifying exam grades towards college credit, advanced placement, or both. In addition, nearly 300 universities outside the United States use AP courses and exam grades in the admissions process (The College Board, 2003).

Description

There are a total of 37 AP exams offered in 22 subject areas. AP exams are created by a committee of experienced AP secondary school teachers and university professors who specialize in each of the subjects for which an exam is offered. The format of AP exams includes a multiple-choice section and a free-response (essay or problem-solving) section. The exceptions to this format are the AP exams for Studio Art, which is a portfolio assessment, Music Theory, which includes a sight-singing task, and the modern language exam, which includes a speaking component.

Administration

The Educational Testing Services (ETS) mails out the AP exams along with other exam-related materials to participating schools in April or early May. The AP exams are administered each year in May over a two-week period. Once testing is completed, all AP exams are returned to ETS.

Scoring

The AP grade scale ranges from 1 to 5. A score of 1 indicates “no recommendation,” a score of 2 “possibly qualified,” a score of 3 “qualified,” a score of 4 “well qualified,” and a score of 5 indicates “extremely well qualified.” The multiple-choice section of the exam is scored by computer. The free-response section is scored by trained readers during a week-long scoring session held in June. These readers who are made up of AP teachers and university professors follow detailed scoring guidelines. Each AP exam has a formula for combining the scores of the multiple-choice and free-response sections of the exam into a composite score. A score of 3 qualifies a student to earn advanced placement or college credit.

Participants

The number of HISD high school students who participated in AP exams increased from 5,447 in 2008 to 6,069 in 2009. The 6,069 HISD students who took AP exams in 2009 took a total of 11,594 exams, an increase of 1,384 exams from 2008. The percent of exams scored at a 3 or higher was 42 percent, a decrease of nearly 2 percentage points from 2008. District data for 2008 were drawn from the corrected electronic file provided by the College Board and only included exams taken by HISD high school students; while 2009 data were drawn from the original printed report from the College Board.

Results

Districtwide Performance

Districtwide results were summed and calculated to determine the number of AP exams, and the percent scoring 3 or above. **Table 15** presents districtwide results for the years 1999 through 2009.

- The number of AP exams that HISD students have taken has increased from 2,278 in 1999 to 11,594 in 2009.
- The number of students taking the AP exam has increased from 1,240 in 1999 to 6,069 in 2009.
- The percent of scores at 3 or above has ranged from a low of 42% in 2009 to a high of 63% in 1999.

Race/Ethnicity and Gender

A demographic comparison of the AP participation and the percent of scores at 3 or above for 2008 and 2009 are presented. The scores on AP exams for the following subgroups: American Indian, Asian American, African American, Hispanic, White, and other are presented in **Table 16**. Data presented are for high school testers only and do not include exams taken by middle school students.

- From 2008 to 2009, the number of AP exams taken increased for each subgroup in HISD except for students who did indicate their race or ethnicity. Over the same time period, the percent of exams scored at 3 or above increased for American Indian and Asian American students.
- The highest number of AP exams taken was by Hispanic students who took a total of 4,877 exams, followed by White students who took 2,335 exams.
- Asian American and White students had the highest percentage of exams scored at 3 or above with 70 percent and 63 percent, respectively. By comparison, 29 percent of exams taken by Hispanic students were scored at 3 or above, while 18 percent of exams taken by African American students were scored at 3 or above.

- The number AP exams taken by female and male students increased from 2008 to 2009. In 2009, there were 1,302 more exams taken by female students than male students.
- The percent of female students' exams scored 3 or above decreased from 42 percent in 2008 to 41 percent in 2009. Male students experienced a decrease in exams scored at a 3 or higher from 47 percent in 2008 to 45 percent in 2009.
- Male students outperformed their female counterparts on the percent of exams scored at a 3 or above on AP exams. The difference decreased from a gap of five percentage points in 2008 to one percentage point in 2009.

- The number of AP exams taken increased from 2008 to 2009 for HISD by 14 percent, for Texas by 6 percent, and for the nation by 7 percent.
- The percent of HISD student exams scored at 3 or above was 42 percent compared to 48 percent in Texas and 59 percent in the nation in 2009.

International Baccalaureate (IB)

Introduction

Purpose

The International Baccalaureate Organization is a nonprofit international educational organization established in 1968. This organization offers the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme for students aged 16-19. The IB Diploma Programme is a two-year course of study that prepares students for college. The IB Diploma Programme is recognized and accepted by universities around the world. Similar to the AP program, students with high scores on IB exams can earn college credit or advanced placement at a college or university.

Description

Students participating in the IB Diploma Programme are required to take six exams which are in the following subject groups: literature, language, social science, experimental science, mathematics, and art. The students may choose to replace the art exam by a second social science, experimental science, or a third language. Students test in three of their subjects at the higher level and three of their subjects at the subsidiary level. IB exams are developed by an international board of chief examiners, with input from IB teachers from around the world (IBO, 2004). Students may also choose to take individual IB courses and the exams.

In addition, students must fulfill three additional requirements. They must take a critical thinking class known as “Theory of Knowledge,” complete an original 4,000 word research project known as “Extended Essay,” and participate in a minimum of 150 hours of community service, artistic, and physical activities known as “Creativity, Action, and Service.”

Administration

IB exams are administered to students at their high school in two sessions. The first session takes place in November, and the second session takes place in May. IB exams are administered over a period of two weeks.

Scoring

An international body of 3,500 trained IB examiners composed of university professors and master secondary school teachers score the IB exams. An examining board oversees the scoring of the examiners to ensure that scoring is consistent across subjects and across the world. Final scores are given in each subject at the IB Curriculum and Assessment Center in Wales. Each exam is graded on a scale of 1 to 7. Students who earn a score of 4 or higher on an IB exam will be awarded an IB certificate in that subject area. Students must complete the requirements stated previously and achieve a cumulative score of 24 to be awarded the IB Diploma. Results are released each year in July.

Participants

Two HISD high schools participated in the IB program in 2008–2009. These schools are Bellaire and Lamar high schools. The total number of students who participated in the IB exams decreased slightly from 432 in 2008 to 419 students in 2009. Of the two participating schools, Lamar High School had more students who took an IB exam.

Results

Districtwide Performance

Districtwide results were summed and calculated to determine the number of IB exams taken and the percent scoring 4 or above. **Table 19** presents results for the participating schools, Bellaire and Lamar, for 2008 and 2009.

- The number of exams taken at Bellaire High School in 2009 matched the 151 exams taken in 2008. The percent of exams scored at 4 or above increased from 88 percent in 2008 to 89 percent in 2009.
- The number of exams taken at Lamar High School increased from 1,135 in 2008 to 1,280 in 2009. The percent of exams scored at 4 or above increased from 75 percent in 2008 to 76 percent in 2009.

- The percent of HISD exams scored at 4 or above was 77 percent, the same as in 2008, and which was one percentage point higher than the state and two percentage points higher than the nation in 2009.
- The number of IB exams taken in HISD increased from 1,286 in 2008 to 1,431 in 2009, and both the state and the nation each experienced an increase over the same time period.
