In 2014, Houston ISD launched the Global Graduate Initiative with the goal of ensuring that each HISD student graduates ready for the world. To this end, HISD has made strides to increase participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009, preparing students to be college and career ready upon graduation.

This College-Bound Report provides a brief synopsis of HISD students' participation in and performance on the 2015–2016 administrations of the PSAT 8/9, PSAT/NMSQT, SAT, ACT, Advanced Placement (AP) Exams, and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in dual credit courses and college are also presented. For additional information and expanded data disaggregated by demographics, assessment-specific reports can be found on HISD's Research and Accountability website at <http://www.houstonisd.org>.

Key findings include:

- More HISD high school students are taking college readiness and entrance assessments than in previous years. Although rates of participation have remained relatively flat, because of the increase in district enrollment, a greater number of students are taking these tests.
- Performance on these exams has remained relatively stable. Average scores have not changed much from those in 2013–2014, except in the case of ACT, where students' average composite scores for the Class of 2016 surpassed the state and national averages.
- Enrollment in dual credit courses remains popular among HISD students. More than half of students in grades 11 and 12 have completed at least one dual credit course, indicating that HISD juniors and seniors are prepared for college-level work.

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# College-Bound Assessment Report 2015–2016

## Executive Summary

In 2014, Houston Independent School District (HISD) launched the Global Graduate Initiative. The goal of this initiative is to ensure that each HISD student graduates ready for the world. The profile of an HISD Global Graduate is one of a leader, a skilled communicator, adaptable & productive, a critical thinker, a responsible decision maker, and a college-ready learner. The goal of preparing students to be college and career ready upon graduation is not a new one for the district. That's why HISD has significantly increased participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009 with the implementation and expansion of programs such as SAT School Day and funding both the cost of PSAT exams to sophomores and Advanced Placement (AP) Exams to all students.

This report provides a brief analysis of HISD participation in and performance of college-bound students on the 2015–2016 administrations of the Preliminary SAT for students in grades eight and nine (PSAT 8/9), the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), the SAT, ACT, AP, and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in dual credit courses and in college are also presented.

**More HISD high school students are taking college readiness and entrance assessments than did so two years ago.** While participation rates in PSAT/NMSQT, SAT, ACT, and AP have remained relatively flat over three years, because of the increase in the number of students enrolled in the district, more students are taking these assessments.

**Performance on these exams has remained relatively stable.** Mean scores in 2015–2016 have not varied much from those in 2013–2014, except in the case of ACT where there has been a slight improvement in scores. Proportions of students meeting College and Career Readiness (CCR) standards among students who took the SAT, ACT, and AP have remained flat or decreased compared to last year.

**Enrollment in dual credit courses remains popular among HISD students.** More than half of the students enrolled in grades 11–12 have completed a dual credit course; indicating that HISD juniors and seniors are prepared for college-level work. As a result, **more HISD students are enrolling in higher education than before, and earning postsecondary credentials.**

## Introduction and Purpose

This report provides a brief analysis of Houston Independent School District (HISD) participation in and performance of college-bound students on the 2015–2016 administrations of the PSAT 8/9 assessment, the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), the SAT, ACT, Advanced Placement (AP), and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in dual credit courses and in college are also presented.

Presented below is a brief summary of previously-published HISD reports on student performance. ## Results

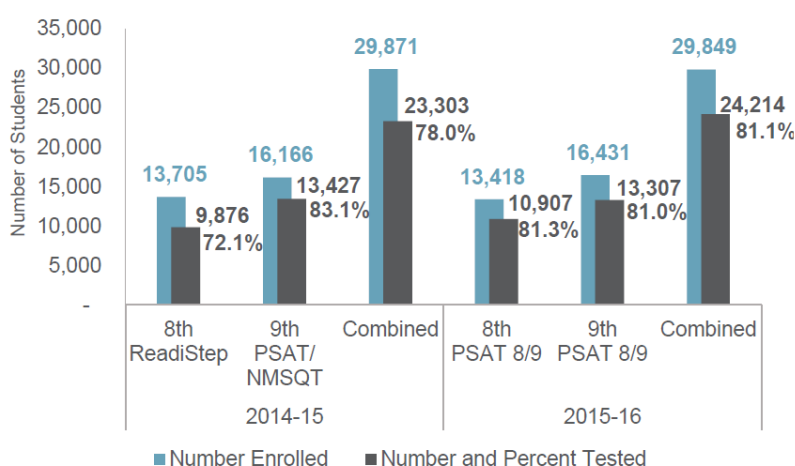
### PSAT 8/9

The PSAT 8/9 replaced the ReadStep assessment from the College Board in the 2015–2016 academic year as a low-stakes middle school assessment which serves as the first step on the “College Readiness Pathway” preparing students for the PSAT/NMSQT and for the SAT. PSAT 8/9 has two sections: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW) and Mathematics.

#### How many students participated in PSAT 8/9?

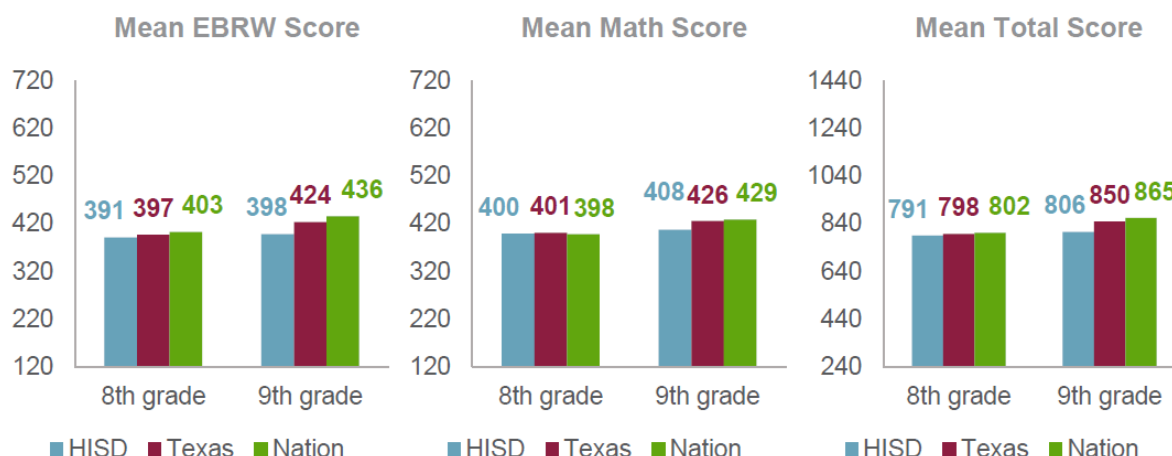
**Figure 1. Number of students enrolled and number and percentage tested by grade level, 2014–2015 and 2015–2016.**

A total of 10,907 eighth-graders (81%) took the assessment, which reflects a nine percentage-point **increase** from the proportion of eighth-graders who took ReadStep in 2014–2015 (72%) (**Figure 1**). On the other hand, 13,307 ninth-graders (81%) took the assessment, down from the 83 percent of ninth-graders who took the PSAT/NMSQT in 2014–2015.

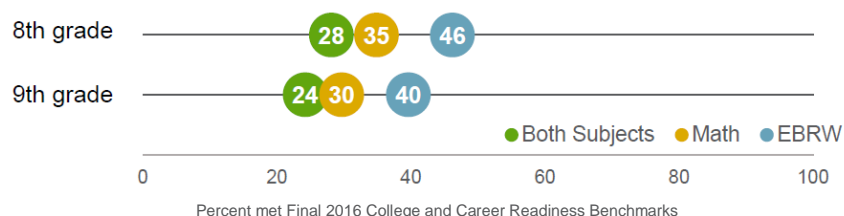
#### How well did students perform on PSAT 8/9?

Scores on the PSAT 8/9 range from 120 to 720 points on each of the two sections, for a total score between 240 and 1440. In 2015–2016, HISD ninth-graders scored slightly higher than eighth-graders on both the EBRW and Mathematics sections. Comparisons with prior year data are not possible, as this was a new test in 2015.

The College Board assigned two sets of College and Career Readiness (CCR) Benchmarks for students who took the PSAT 8/9, preliminary benchmarks for fall 2015 and final benchmarks for spring 2016 that were up to 70 points higher. This is the score that students should meet or exceed to be considered on track to be college or career ready. The final 2016 eighth-grade CCR Benchmarks are 390 or better for EBRW and 430 or better for Mathematics. For ninth-grade students, the final 2016 Benchmarks are 410 or better for EBRW and 450 or better for Mathematics. **Figure 3** shows the proportion of students who met the final Benchmarks. Nearly one out of four students who took the assessment in 2015–2016 met the final CCR Benchmark for both subjects. Students were more likely to meet the CCR Benchmark for EBRW than for Mathematics, which was the reverse of the trend in previous years.

### Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT)

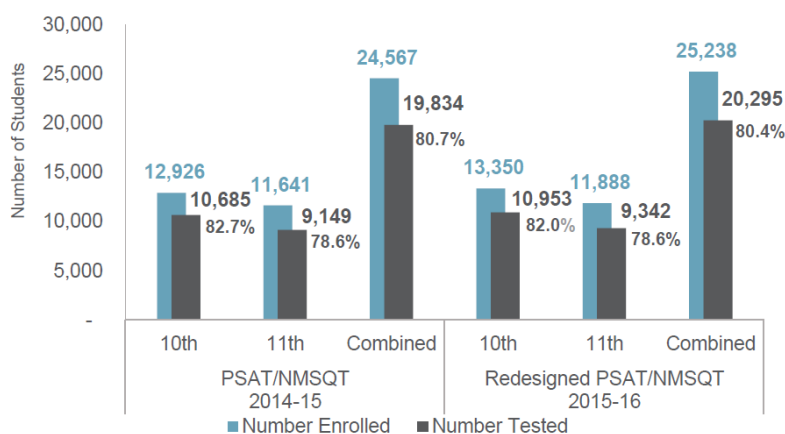
The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) is a national examination administered in October of each year by the College Board. The PSAT/NMSQT serves as preparation for the SAT, similarly testing Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW) and Mathematics. The 2015 version was redesigned to coincide with the redesign of the SAT and addition of PSAT 8/9. Prior versions of the PSAT/NMSQT had three sections, testing Critical Reading, Writing, and Mathematics.

An important benefit of the PSAT/NMSQT is that it serves as a qualifying examination for numerous scholarship programs that are sponsored by corporations, colleges and universities, and other organizations, including the National Merit scholarships. Students are able to qualify for these scholarships depending on the score they earn when they take the exam in their junior year, however, students are encouraged to take the PSAT even as freshmen and sophomores. HISD provides funding so that all freshmen and sophomores are able to take the PSAT/NMSQT test for free. Additionally, HISD offers the College Board Early Preparation Program to incoming freshmen in order to prepare them for the SAT and SAT Subject Tests. Students also received personalized feedback on their command of the skills needed to graduate from high school and succeed in college courses.

### How many students participated in PSAT/NMSQT?

**Figure 4** shows that 20,295 HISD students took the PSAT/NMSQT in 2015–2016—this figure represents 80 percent of students who were enrolled in grades ten and eleven. Both the number of students enrolled and the number of students who took the exam **increased** over 2014–2015, thereby maintaining steady participation rates.

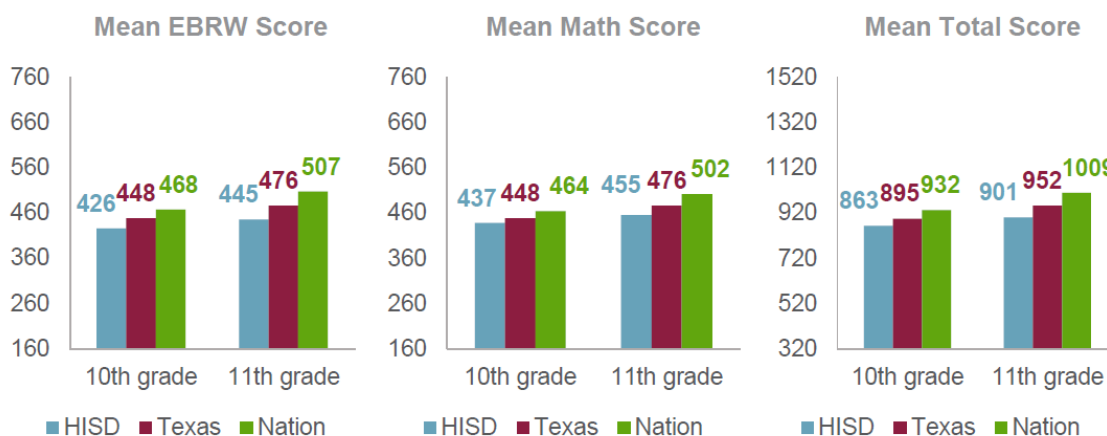


**One quarter of HISD students who took the PSAT/NMSQT in 2015–2016 met the Final 2016 College Readiness Benchmark.**

### How well did students perform on PSAT/NMSQT?

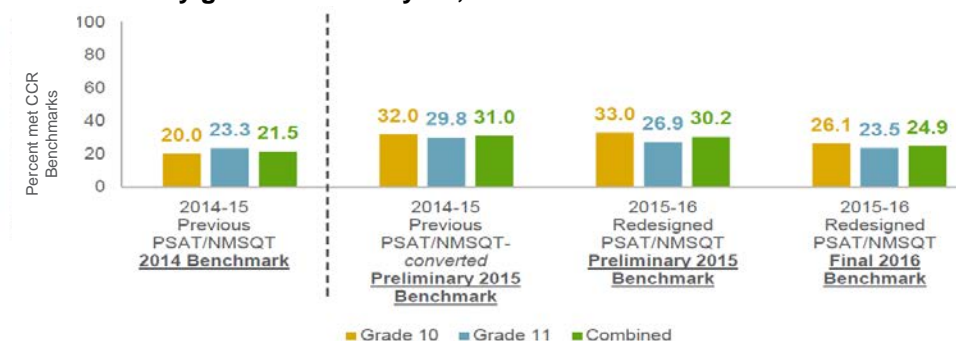
**Figure 5. Mean PSAT/NMSQT Scores for HISD, Texas, and Nation by grade level, 2015–2016.**

**Figure 5 (p. 5)** displays the mean PSAT/NMSQT Composite and subject scores for HISD, Texas, and the nation. Each subject on the PSAT/NMSQT is scored from 160 to 760 and total scores range from 320 to 1520. Figure 5 shows that the average total score for students who took the exam in 2015–2016 was 863 for 10<sup>th</sup>-graders and 901 for 11<sup>th</sup>-graders. Unlike the PSAT 8/9 data, HISD students tend to score higher on the Mathematics section. Average district scores were lower than those for the state and nation, however participation rates are markedly higher in HISD than the rest of Texas (73% grade 10, 68% grade 11) or the United States (51% grade 10, 50% grade 11).

The College Board also assigns College and Career Readiness (CCR) Benchmarks for students who take the PSAT/NMSQT. Prior to the 2015 PSAT/NMSQT administration, CCR Benchmarks were based on composite scores (Critical Reading, Writing, and Mathematics combined). For the 2015 administration, however, there are CCR Benchmarks for each section, and students are considered on track for college or careers if they meet *both* section benchmarks. **Figure 6** shows the proportion of students who met CCR Benchmarks for (1) the 2014–2015 administration according to 2014 benchmarks; (2) the 2014–2015 administration converted to the 2015 scale (using concordance tables provided by the College Board) under preliminary 2015 benchmarks; (3) the 2015–2016 administration under preliminary 2015 benchmarks (Grade 10: EBRW  $\geq$  360, Math  $\geq$  470; Grade 11: EBRW  $\geq$  390, Math  $\geq$  500); and (4) the 2015–2016 administration under final 2016 benchmarks (Grade 10: EBRW  $\geq$  430, Math  $\geq$  480; Grade 11: EBRW  $\geq$  460, Math  $\geq$  510). Comparisons between 2014–2015 and 2015–2016 data should be interpreted with caution due to the significant redesign of the PSAT/NMSQT in 2015–2016.

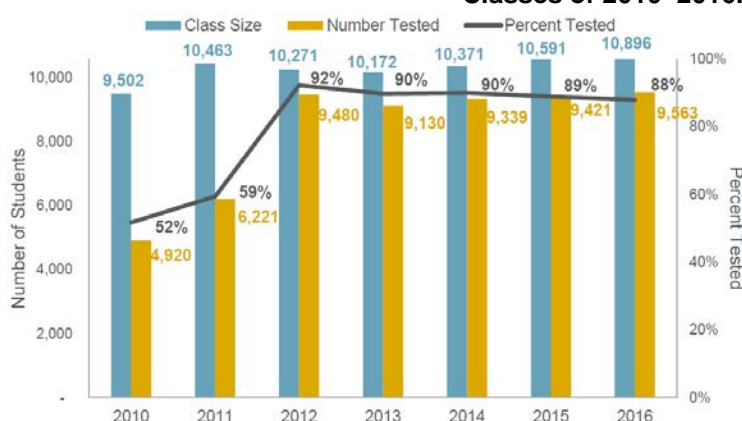
## SAT

The SAT is a college-entrance exam developed by the College Board. The SAT is designed to measure developed verbal and mathematical reasoning abilities related to successful performance in college. The test was redesigned for 2005 and included a Writing component. The assessment changed again in March 2016, this report covers the last administrations of the SAT in the 2005–2016 format. The test is offered seven times per year and is typically taken by juniors and seniors. The data presented in this section reflect performance of graduating seniors for each year, as self-reported by students to the College Board when they took the exam.

### How many students participated in SAT?

**Figure 7** shows that more than 9,500 HISD students in the Class of 2016 took the SAT—this represents 88 percent of seniors and is the largest number of students to take the test in at least the last seven years. In Spring of 2011, HISD implemented a school-day administration of the SAT for all juniors. As a result of increasing enrollment and easier access to the test, the number of students who took the SAT has increased since the Class of 2012, thereby maintaining steady participation rates.

**88% of the Class of 2016 participated in the SAT.**

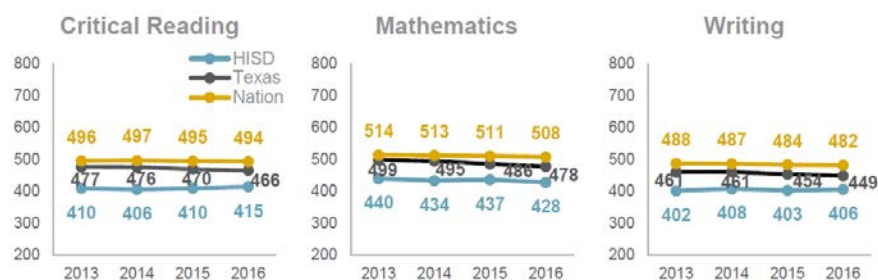

### How well did students perform on SAT?

Each subject on the SAT is scored from 200 to 800 and Composite scores range from 600 to 2400. **Figure 8** shows average subject scores for HISD students compared to Texas and the nation. Consistent with PSAT data, HISD students tend to score higher on the Math portion of the assessment. Average Critical Reading, and Writing scores for the Class of 2016 increased slightly compared to the Class of 2013, while mathematics scores decreased (this reflects a state- and nationwide trend in mathematics).

**Figure 8. Mean SAT scores by subject and composite, Classes of 2013–2016.**



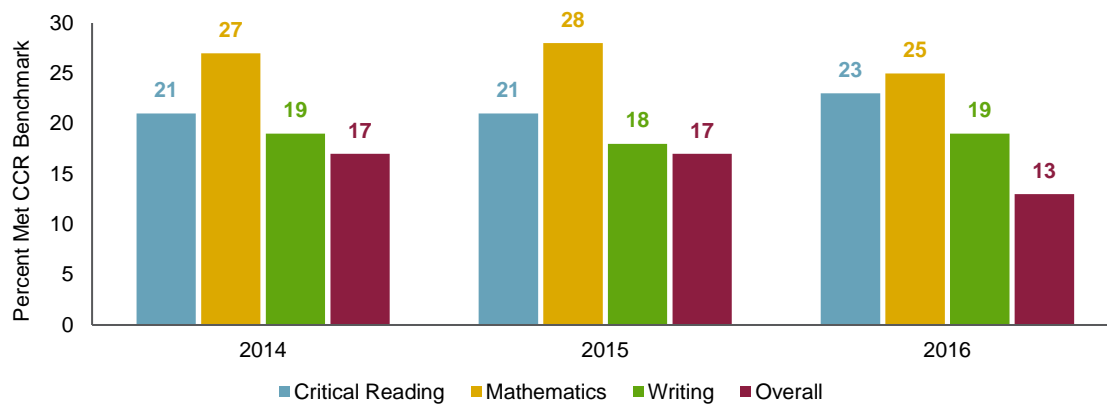

The College Board sets college and career readiness (CCR) benchmarks for the SAT. The CCR Benchmark is a score of 500 or better on each section and a composite of at least 1550. 13 percent of HISD students in the Class of 2016 met the CCR benchmarks, a decrease of 4 percentage points from the Class of 2015. Students were more likely to meet the CCR Benchmark for Math (25%) than for Critical Reading (23%) or Writing (19%). However, this was the highest percentage of students to meet the Critical Reading benchmark since the school day SAT program began for the Class of 2012.

### 13 percent of the Class of 2016 met the SAT CCR Benchmark.

**Figure 9. Percentage of students who met CCR Benchmarks on SAT, Class of 2014–2016.**

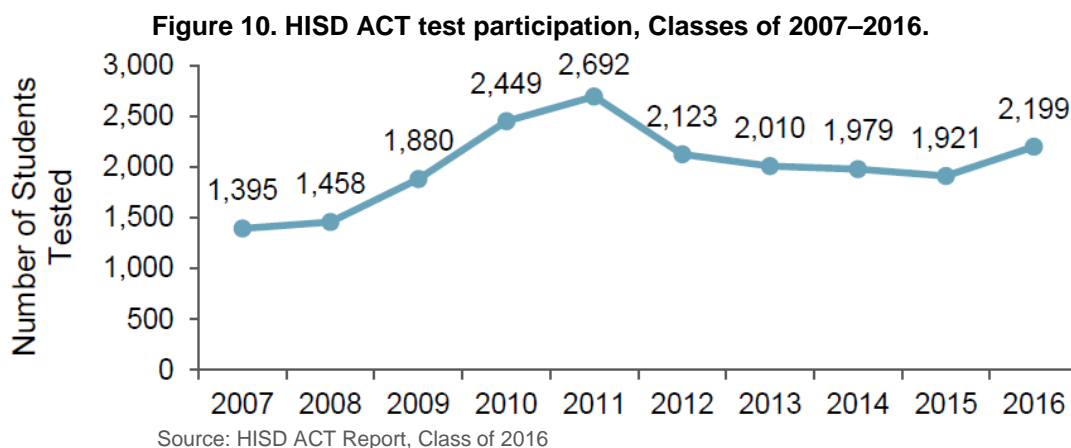


## ACT

The ACT is a college admissions exam in which there are four subjects tested: English, Math, Reading, and Science. The ACT is offered six times per year and is typically taken by juniors and seniors. The data presented in this section reflect performance of graduating seniors for each year, as self-reported by students when they took the exam.

### How many students participated in ACT?

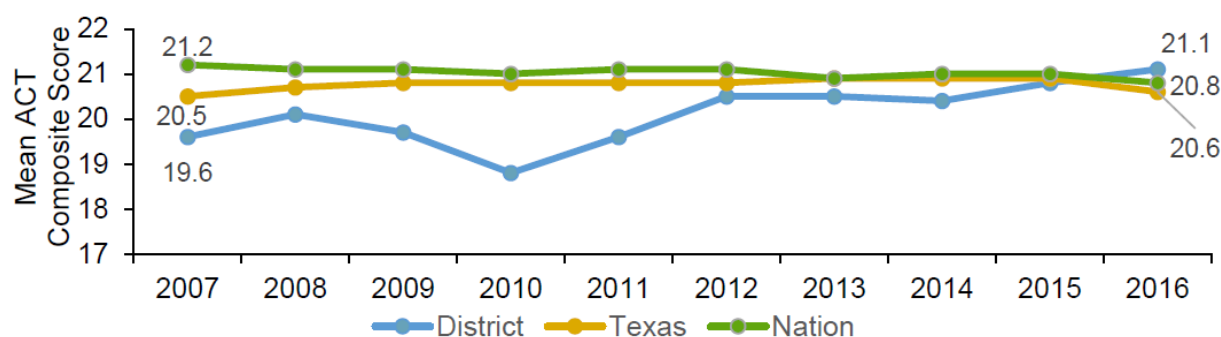
The ACT is not as popular among HISD students as the SAT. **Figure 10** indicates that 2,199 students from the Class of 2016 took the ACT, accounting for only 20 percent of the class. This participation rate is two percentage points higher than that of the Class of 2015 (18%), but far below the SAT participation rate of 88 percent.



### How well did students perform on ACT?

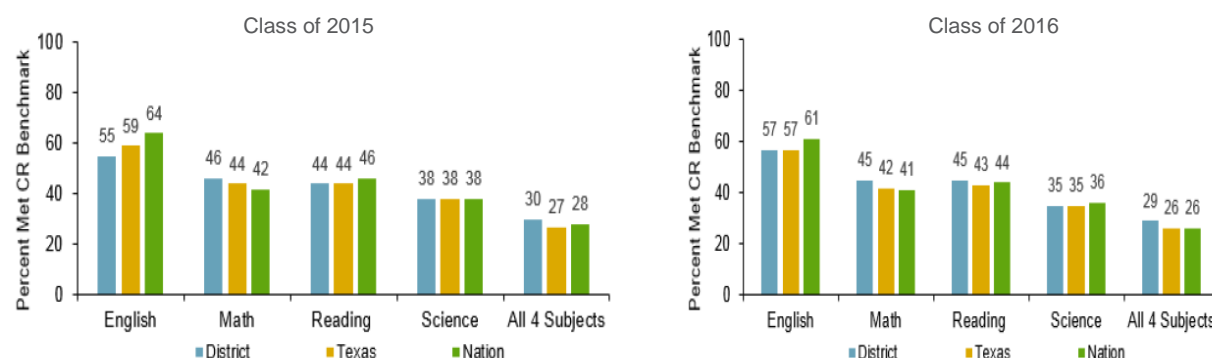
**Figure 11. Average ACT composite scores of graduates, HISD, Texas and Nation: 2007–2016.**

Each subject on the ACT is scored from 1 to 36 and Composite scores are an average of scores earned on the four subjects. **Figure 11** shows that the average Composite score for the Class of 2016 was 21.1, which was higher than the State or National average. Average Math and Reading scores were highest and English scores were lowest. Average scores across all subjects for the Class of 2016 have increased compared to the Class of 2013 in all subjects except Mathematics, which has remained relatively flat.

The ACT has also identified College Readiness Benchmarks indicating college and career readiness. A student is considered to be ready to succeed after high school if a student earns or exceeds scores of 18 in English, 22 in Math, 22 in Reading, and 23 in Science. **Figure 12** (p. 9) shows the proportion of students who met College Readiness Benchmarks on all four subjects and each subject from the Classes of 2015 and 2016. 29 percent of students in the Class of 2016 met the Composite Benchmark, which exceeded the

rates for the state and nation. In both years, the greatest percentage of students met the Benchmark for English and lowest percentage met the Benchmark for Science.

### Advanced Placement (AP)

The College Board's Advanced Placement (AP) Program provides participating high school students with the opportunity to take college-level courses and earn college credit, advanced placement, or both. A possible 36 examinations in Arts, AP Capstone (new in 2014–2015), English, History & Social Science, STEM, and World Languages & Cultures are administered in May. The Advanced Placement (AP) Program represents a critical element in HISD's efforts to inject rigor into high school classrooms. Since 2009, the AP course offerings in HISD have been vastly expanded, with more campuses offering a wider selection of AP courses that exposes a larger percentage of the high school population to academic rigor.

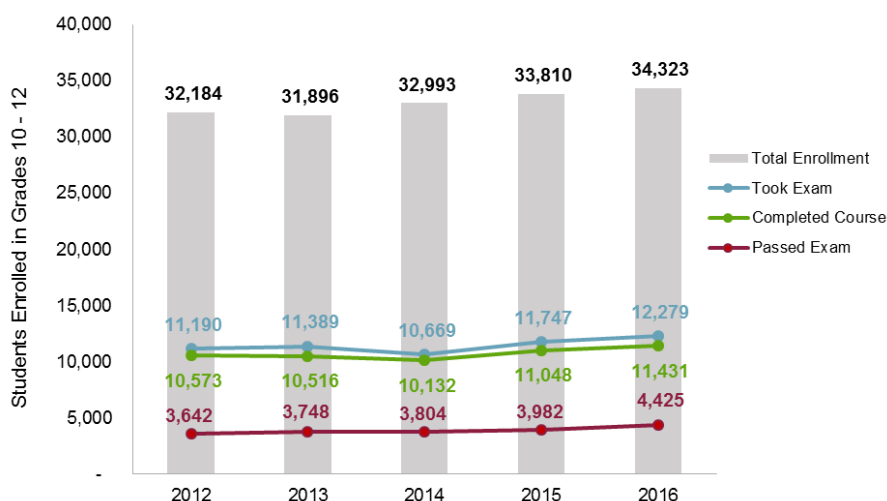
### How many students participated in AP Exams?

**Figure 13 (p. 10)** shows the number of students enrolled in grades 10–12, the number of students who completed at least one AP course, the number of high school students who took at least one AP Exam, and the number of high school students who passed (i.e., scored 3 or better) at least one AP Exam. The number of HISD students who took AP Exams has **increased** from 2012 to 2016. About 36 percent of students in grades 10–12 took an AP Exam in 2016—a rate slightly higher than that in the previous two years. It is important to note that AP Exams are taken most commonly by students enrolled in grades 10–12, though some HISD 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> graders also participate.

**One out of every three AP Exams taken by HISD high school students received a passing score in 2015–2016.**

#### How well did students perform on AP Exams?

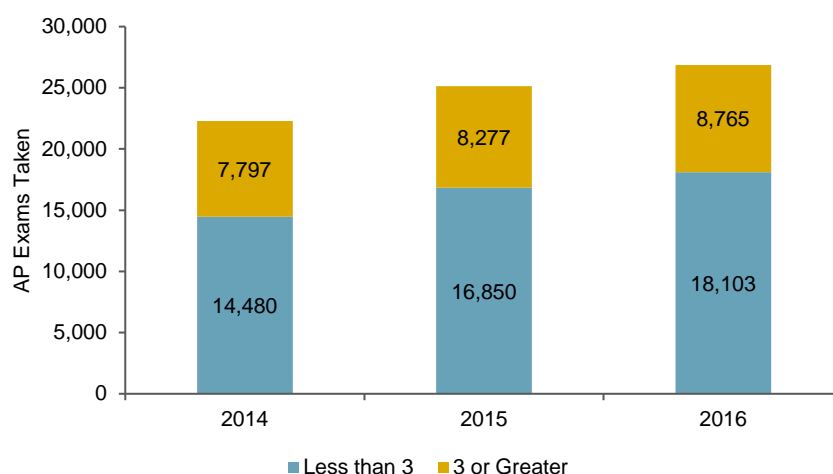
Each AP Exam is scored from 1 to 5. Students require a score of 3 or higher to “pass” the AP Exam and potentially earn college credit. **Figure 14** shows the percent of AP Exams that received a score of 3 or higher by subject. One out of every three AP Exams received a score of 3 or higher in 2015–2016—this is similar to the previous year (**Figure 15, p. 11**). Students who took AP Exams in Arts, Math & Computer Science, AP Capstone, and World Languages & Culture were most likely to earn a score of 3 or higher.

**Figure 15. AP Exams Taken by HISD Students in Grades 9–12 by score, 2014–2016.**

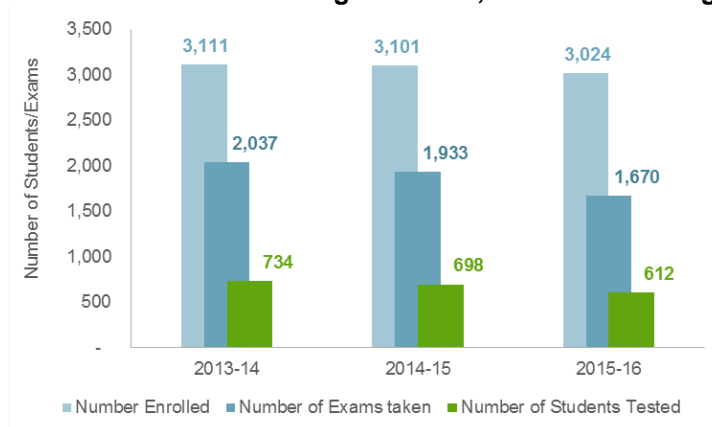

### International Baccalaureate (IB)

The IB Diploma Programme is a two-year course of study that prepares students for college. The IB Diploma Programme is recognized and accepted by universities around the world. Similar to the AP program, students with high scores on IB Exams can earn college credit or advanced placement at a college or university. Students participating in the IB Diploma Programme are required to take six exams in the following subjects: Literature, Language, Social Science, Experimental Science, Mathematics, and Art. Students may also choose to take individual IB courses and IB exams instead of participating in the full diploma program.

#### How many students participated in IB Exams?

Two HISD high schools participated in the IB Programme between 2013–2014 and 2015–2016: Bellaire and Lamar High Schools. The total number of students who took IB exams decreased from 734 students in 2013–2014 to 612 in 2015–2016 (**Figure 16**). Of the two participating schools, Lamar High School has more students who took an IB exam (in 2015–2016, Lamar had 556 testers and Bellaire had 56). A total of 20 percent of juniors and seniors at the two high schools took IB exams in 2015–2016.

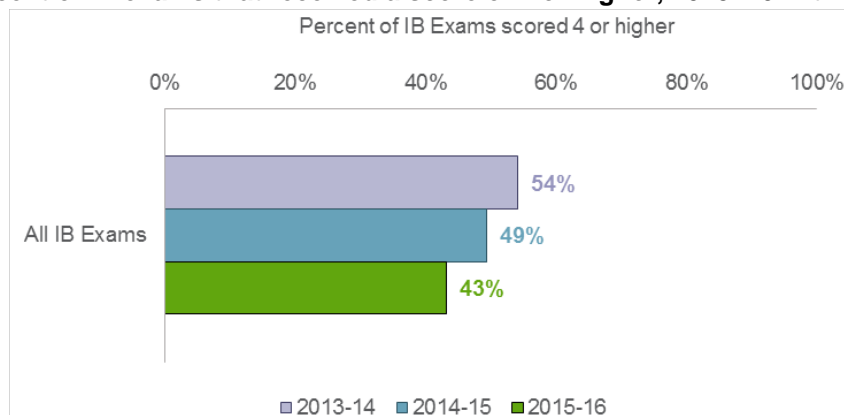

### How well did students perform on IB exams?

Each IB exam is scored from 1 to 7. Students require a score of 4 or higher to “pass” the IB exam and potentially earn college credit. **Figure 17** shows the percentage of IB exams that received a score of 4 or higher for the years 2013–2014 through 2015–2016. 43 percent of IB exams received a score of 4 or higher in 2015–2016, an 11 percentage-point decline from 2013–2014 (54%). Bellaire High School had 88 percent of tests taken score 4 or higher on IB exams compared to 39 percent at Lamar.

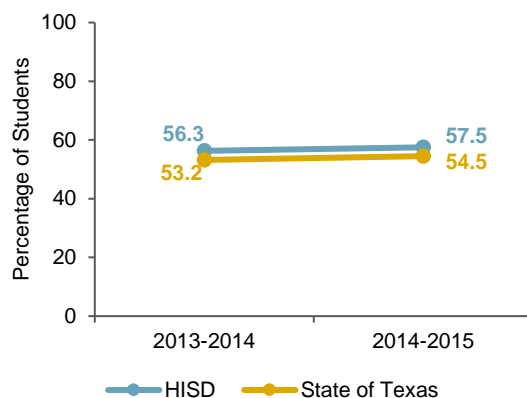

### Dual Credit Enrollment

In addition to the use of assessments, college readiness can also be determined through enrollment in and completion of dual credit courses. A dual credit course is a college course taken by a high school student where the student earns both college and high school credit, which saves the student money and time toward college degrees before finishing high school. Students must meet certain eligibility requirements in order to participate. Students who enroll and perform well in dual credit courses are not only college-ready but also are college-proven. In 2014–2015, more than half (57.5%) of students enrolled in HISD in grades 11 and 12 had completed at least one dual credit course in any subject, which is three percentage points higher than the state (**Figure 18**, Texas Education Agency Texas Academic Performance Report, 2016).

**Figure 18. Percentage of students in grades 11 and 12 who completed at least 1 Dual Credit course, HISD and the State.**

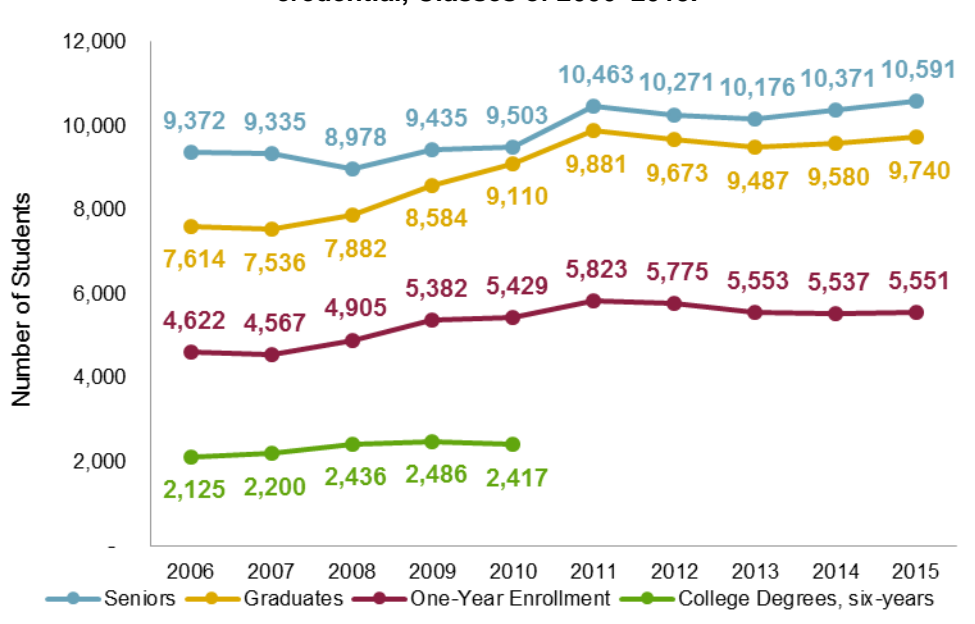

### Postsecondary Enrollment

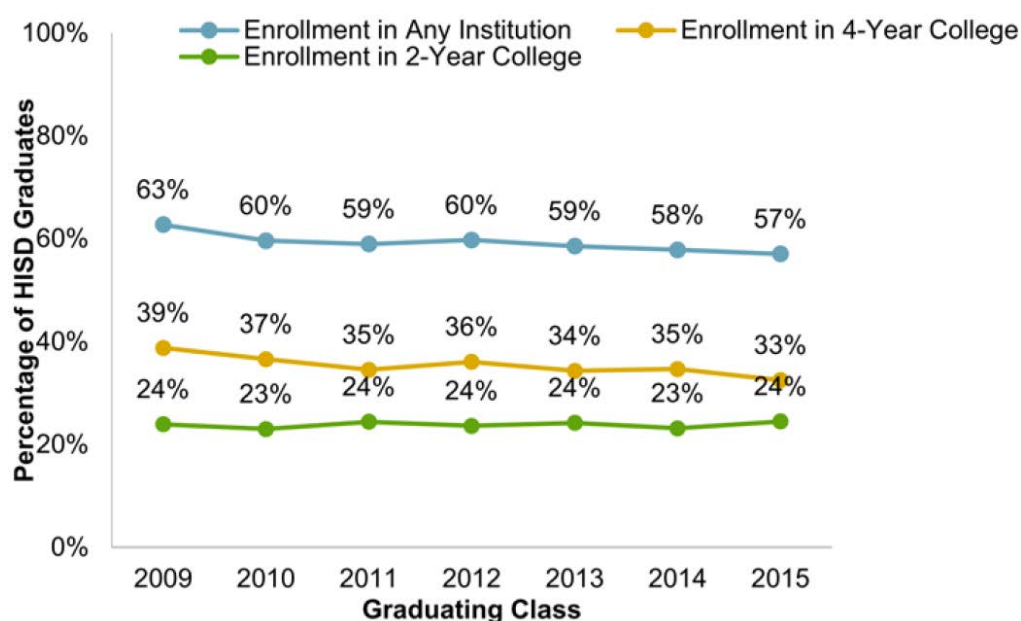
The number of HISD graduates who enroll in college within one year of graduating from high school has increased by 20 percent from 4,622 to 5,551 between the Classes of 2006 and 2015 (**Figure 19**). 57 percent of the Class of 2015 enrolled in college within one year of graduating from high school (**Figure 20**). Among those who enrolled in college, 45 percent of the Class of 2010 had earned a postsecondary credential (i.e., certificate, associate or baccalaureate degree) within six years.

## Conclusion

In 2014, Houston ISD launched its Global Graduate Initiative. The district's and initiative's goal is to ensure that each HISD student graduates ready for the world. The profile of an HISD Global Graduate is one of a leader, a skilled communicator, adaptable and productive, a critical thinker, a responsible decision maker, and a college-ready learner. While this is a new initiative, the goal of preparing students to be college and career ready upon graduation is not a new one for the district. That's why HISD has significantly increased participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009 with the implementation and expansion of programs such as SAT School Day and funding both the cost of PSAT exams for freshmen and sophomores and AP Exams for all students.

These assessments measure a variety of skills and competencies, the mastery of which have proven to correlate with student success in both college and career. For example, research from ACT found that students who meet ACT College Readiness Benchmarks are less likely to require remediation than those who do not meet the Benchmarks; students who meet Benchmarks are also more likely to enroll in college immediately after graduation, return for a second year, and perform well in college coursework (ACT, 2010). Furthermore, the College Board discovered that students who meet or exceed readiness standards on both SAT and AP tend to enroll in college, especially four-year universities, at a higher rate than those who did not meet CCR Benchmarks (Wyatt et al, 2011). These assessments also help to track student preparation and progress. The PSAT 8/9 exam helps outline areas in which students might require additional support and areas in which students have demonstrated proficiency. Such feedback can help students focus their efforts and develop critical skills. It will continue to aid students early on and prepare them for critical exams such as PSAT/NMSQT and SAT.

Definitions of college readiness are quickly encompassing more than just a score on one assessment. In fact, to be considered both college and career ready, students may demonstrate performance on the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness End-of-Course assessments (STAAR EOC), Texas Success Initiative (TSI), SAT, or ACT. Another way to prove college readiness is to take Dual Credit courses which provide students with both high school and college credit upon course completion—more than half of HISD students enrolled in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade completed a dual credit course in 2014–2015.

As the key findings of this report indicate, more HISD students are taking college readiness and entrance assessments. While there has been an increase in participation, performance on these assessments has remained mostly flat. In addition to increased participation in college readiness assessments, more HISD students are also enrolling in and graduating from college or university. While enrollment rates have remained relatively flat, due to the increase in the number of HISD students and seniors, coupled with the increase in graduation rates, more HISD students are pursuing higher education. As readiness rates increase, the number of HISD students with a college credential will also increase as more students find themselves equipped to succeed in postsecondary education.

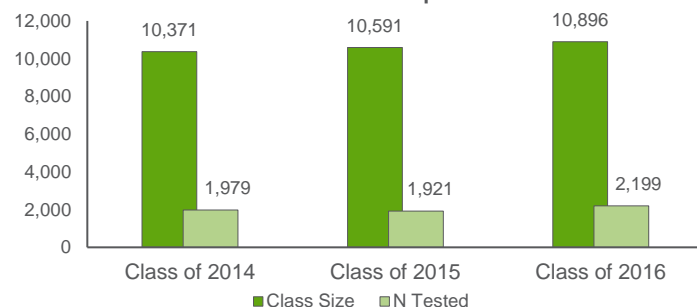

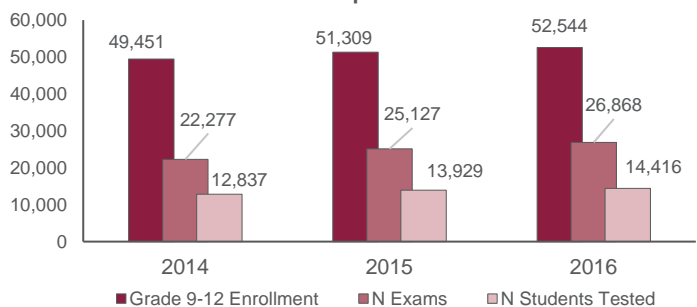

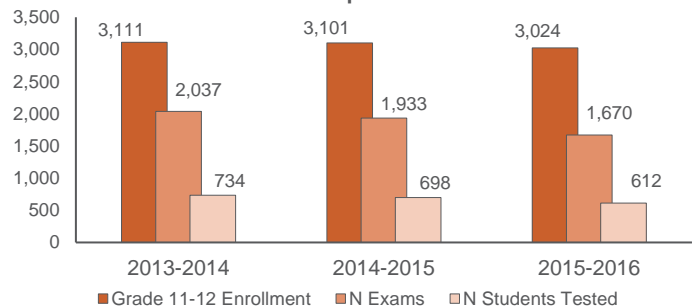

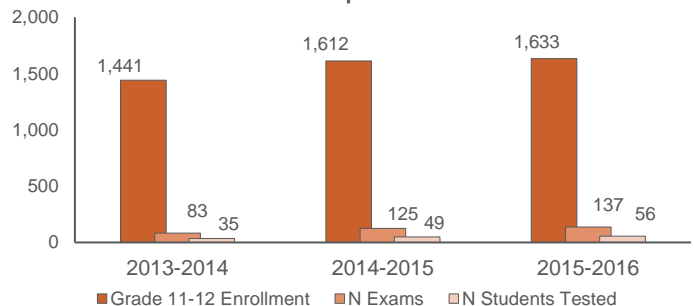

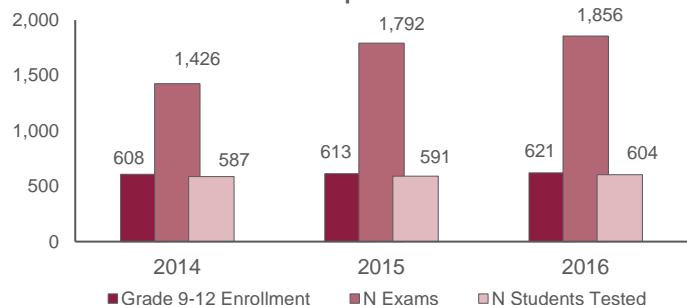
