In 2014, Houston ISD launched the Global Graduate Initiative with the goal of ensuring that each HISD student graduates ready for the world. To this end, HISD has made strides to increase participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009, preparing students to be college and career ready upon graduation.

This College-Bound Report provides a brief synopsis of HISD students' participation in and performance on the 2016–2017 administrations of the PSAT 8/9, PSAT/NMSQT, SAT, ACT, Advanced Placement (AP) exams, and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in advanced/dual credit courses and in college upon high school graduation are also presented. For additional information and expanded data disaggregated by demographics, assessment-specific reports can be found on HISD's Research and Accountability website at http://www.houstonisd.org/Domain/8269.

Key findings include:

- More HISD high school students are taking college readiness and entrance assessments than in previous years. Although rates of participation have remained relatively flat because of the increase in district enrollment, a greater number of students are taking these tests.
- On the PSAT 8/9 and PSAT/NMSQT, average scores increased slightly from 2015 to 2016. While HISD students tend to score slightly higher on average in math, a larger proportion meet the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) College and Career Readiness (CCR) benchmark.
- While the number of students taking the SAT has increased, the percentage tested continues to decrease. Performance of HISD students was lower than that of the state and nation for the Class of 2017.
- On the ACT exam, scale scores increased slightly across all subject areas from 2015 to 2017, and the percentage meeting all benchmarks increased by 1.8 percentage points from 29.9 in 2015 to 31.7 in 2017.
- The number of AP exams taken continues to increase, but the student participation rate and the percentage of exams scored at 3 or higher have remained flat.
- The number of students participating, the number of tests taken, and the number of tests scored 4 or higher have increased on the IB exams in 2016–2017.
- More than half of students in grades 11–12 have completed at least one advanced/dual credit course, indicating that many HISD juniors and seniors are being prepared for collegelevel work. A larger number of HISD students are also enrolling in higher education; however, the percentage of these students is not increasing.

As this is a summary of previously provided data, the district's administrative response to the results of each assessment was provided in the separate reports produced earlier in the year. Executive Summary

Program Description

In 2014, Houston Independent School District (HISD) launched the Global Graduate Initiative. The goal of this initiative is to ensure that each HISD student graduates ready for the world. The profile of an HISD Global Graduate is one of a leader, a skilled communicator, adaptable and productive, a critical thinker, a responsible decision maker, and a college-ready learner. The goal of preparing students to be college and career ready upon graduation is not a new one for the district, which is why HISD has significantly increased participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009 with the implementation and expansion of programs such as SAT School Day and funding both the cost of PSAT exams to sophomores and Advanced Placement (AP) Exams to all students.

This report provides a brief analysis of HISD participation in and performance on the 2016–2017 administrations of the Preliminary SAT for students in grades eight and nine (PSAT 8/9), the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), the SAT, ACT, AP, and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in advanced/dual credit courses and in college upon high school graduation are also presented.

Highlights

- Although rates of participation have remained relatively flat, a greater number of students are taking college readiness and entrance exams.
- On the PSAT 8/9 and PSAT/NMSQT, average scores increased slightly from 2015 to 2016. While HISD students tend to score slightly higher on average in math, a larger proportion meet the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) College and Career Readiness (CCR) benchmark.
- While the number of students taking the SAT has increased, the percentage tested continues to decrease. Performance of HISD students was lower than that of the state and nation for the Class of 2017.
- On the ACT exam, scale scores increased slightly across all subject areas from 2015 to 2017, and the percentage meeting all benchmarks increased by 1.8 percentage points from 29.9 in 2015 to 31.7 in 2017.
- The number of AP exams taken continues to increase, but the student participation rate and the percentage of exams scored at 3 or higher have remained flat.
- Although the rates have decreased, the number of students participating, the number of tests taken, and the number of tests scored 4 or higher have increased on the IB exams in 2017.
- More than half of the students enrolled in grades 11–12 have completed an advanced/dual credit course, indicating that many HISD juniors and seniors are being prepared for college-level work. A larger number of HISD students are also enrolling in higher education; however, the percentage of these students is not increasing.

Introduction

This report provides a brief analysis of Houston Independent School District (HISD) participation in and performance on the 2016–2017 administrations of the PSAT 8/9 assessment, the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), the SAT, ACT, Advanced Placement (AP), and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in advanced/dual credit courses and in college upon high school graduation are also presented.

Below is a brief summary of previously published HISD reports on student performance. Results

PSAT 8/9

The PSAT 8/9 replaced the ReadiStep assessment from the College Board in the 2015–2016 academic year as a low-stakes middle school assessment and serves as the first step on the "College Readiness Pathway" preparing students for the PSAT/NMSQT and for the SAT. PSAT 8/9 has two sections: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) and Mathematics.

How many students participated in PSAT 8/9?





Figure 1. Number of Students Enrolled and Number and Percentage Tested on the PSAT 8/9 by Grade Level, Fall 2015 and Fall 2016

A total of 11,170 eighth-graders (82.4 percent) took the assessment, which reflects a 1.1 percentage point increase from 2015–2016 (81.3 percent) (**Figure 1**). A total of 13,113 ninth-graders (78.7 percent) took the assessment, which is lower than the 13,307 (81.0 percent) ninth-graders who took the PSAT 8/9 in 2015–2016.

How well did students perform on PSAT 8/9?




Figure 2B. Mean PSAT 8/9 Scores by Grade for HISD, Texas, and the Nation, Fall 2015

Scores on the PSAT 8/9 range from 120 to 720 points on each of the two sections for a total score between 240 and 1440. Both eighth- and ninth-graders in HISD scored slightly higher in 2016 compared to 2015 in both ERW and math (**Figures 2A** and **2B**).

The College Board sets College and Career Readiness (CCR) benchmarks for students who took the PSAT 8/9. These are the scores that students should meet or exceed to be considered on track to be college or career ready. The 2016 eighth-grade CCR benchmarks are 390 or better for ERW and 430 or better for math. For ninth-grade students, the 2016 benchmarks are 410 or better for ERW and 450 or better for math. **Figure 3** (p. 4) shows the proportion of students who met the benchmarks. In 2016, twenty-eight percent of eighth- and ninth-graders met the benchmarks in both subjects. A higher percentage of students met the ERW benchmark than the math benchmark.

Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT)

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) is a national examination administered in October of each year by the College Board and consists of two sections: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) and Mathematics. The 2015 version was redesigned to coincide with the redesign of the SAT and addition of PSAT 8/9. Prior versions of the PSAT/NMSQT had three sections, testing Critical Reading, Writing, and Mathematics.

The PSAT/NMSQT serves as preparation for the SAT and is a qualifying examination for numerous scholarship programs sponsored by corporations, colleges and universities, and other organizations, including the National Merit scholarships. Students can qualify for these scholarships depending on the score they earn on the exam in their junior year. HISD provides funding so that all freshmen and sophomores are able to take the PSAT/NMSQT test for free. Additionally, HISD offers the College Board Early Preparation Program to incoming freshmen in order to prepare them for the SAT and SAT Subject Tests.

How many students participated in PSAT/NMSQT?





Figure 4. Number of Students Enrolled and Number and Percentage Tested on the PSAT/NMSQT by Grade Level, Fall 2015 and Fall 2016

Figure 4 shows that 20,818 HISD students took the PSAT/NMSQT in 2016–2017, which is an increase in the number of tests from 2015–2016. However, this figure represents 79.5 percent of students who were enrolled in grades ten and eleven, which is slightly down from 2015–2016 (80.4 percent).

How well did students perform on PSAT/NMSQT?


Figures 5A and **5B** display the mean PSAT/NMSQT Composite and subject scores for HISD, Texas, and the nation for 2016 and 2015. Each subject on the PSAT/NMSQT is scored from 160 to 760, and total scores range from 320 to 1520. Figure 5A shows that the average total score for students who took the exam in 2016 was 873 for tenth-graders and 923 for eleventh-graders, both of which are higher than in 2015. Average scores were lower for HISD students compared to those for the state and nation.




Figure 6. Percentage of Students who Met PSAT/NMSQT College and Career Readiness Benchmarks by Grade Level and Subject, Fall 2015 and Fall 2016

The College Board also assigns College and Career Readiness (CCR) benchmarks for students who take the PSAT/NMSQT. Beginning in the 2015 administration, there are CCR benchmarks for each section, and students are considered on track for college or careers if they meet both section benchmarks. **Figure 6** (p. 6) shows the proportion of students who met CCR benchmarks in 2015 and 2016. Although HISD students scored slightly higher in math on average, a larger proportion of them met the ERW benchmark with performance remaining steady or increasing over the last two years.

SAT

The SAT is a college-entrance exam developed by the College Board. The SAT is designed to measure developed verbal and mathematical reasoning abilities related to successful performance in college. The test was redesigned in March 2016 to only include two sections: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) and Mathematics. The data presented in this section reflect performance of graduating seniors for each year, as self-reported by students to the College Board when they took the exam.

How many students participated in SAT?

Figure 7 (p. 7) shows that 9,640 HISD students in the Class of 2017 took the SAT, **Figure 8** (p. 7) shows that this represents 87 percent of students. While the number of students tested has increased, the percentage of students tested continues to decrease.





Figure 7. Number of Students Tested on the SAT, Classes of 2010–2017


How well did students perform on SAT?


Each subject on the SAT is scored from 200 to 800, and Composite scores on the redesigned exam range from 400 to 1600. **Figure 9** (p. 8) shows average subject scores for HISD students compared to the state and the nation on the redesigned test only. While a few students from the Class of 2017 took the old version of the SAT, the vast majority took the new version. Because comparing the redesigned exam with prior versions is problematic, performance data are only included for the Class of 2017 on the redesigned exam. HISD's Class of 2017 scored the same on average on the ERW and math sections, but their scores were lower than those of the state and nation.

The College Board sets college readiness benchmarks for the SAT: 480 for ERW and 530 for math. A higher percentage of HISD students in the Class of 2017 met the benchmarks in ERW (45 percent) compared to math (27 percent). However, HISD still lags compared to the state and nation (**Figure 10**).

ACT

The ACT is a college admissions exam in which there are four subjects tested: English, Math, Reading, and Science. The ACT is offered six times per year and is typically taken by juniors and seniors. The data presented in this section reflect performance of graduating seniors for each year, as self-reported by students when they took the exam.

How many students participated in ACT?






Figure 11. Number of Students Tested on the ACT, Classes of 2010–2017

The ACT is not as popular among HISD students as the SAT. **Figure 11** (p. 9) indicates that 1,893 students from the Class of 2017 took the ACT, and **Figure 12** (p. 9) shows that this is only 17 percent of the class.

How well did students perform on ACT?





Figure 13. Average ACT Scores by Subject for HISD, Texas and the Nation, Classes of 2014–2017

Each subject on the ACT is scored from 1 to 36, and Composite scores are an average of scores earned on the four subjects. **Figure 13** (p. 10) shows that the average Composite score for the Class of 2017 was 21.9, which was higher than the state or national average. Over the past 4 years, HISD's average scores have increased across all subjects (Figure 13).

The ACT has also identified college readiness benchmarks. A student is considered to be ready to succeed after high school if a student earns or exceeds scores of 18 in English, 22 in Math, 22 in Reading, and 23 in Science. **Figure 14** (p. 11) shows the proportion of students who met the benchmarks by subject from the Classes of 2014 through 2017. HISD's Class of 2017 had a higher percentage (32 percent) that met all four benchmarks compared to the state and nation for the third year in a row. In 2017, the greatest percentage of students met the benchmark for English (65 percent), and the lowest percentage met the benchmark for science (41 percent).

Advanced Placement (AP)

The College Board's Advanced Placement (AP) Program provides participating high school students with the opportunity to take college-level courses and earn college credit, advanced placement, or both. A total of 38 examinations in Arts, AP Capstone (new in 2014–2015), English, History and Social Science, Mathematics and Computer Science, Sciences, and World Languages and Cultures are administered in May. The Advanced Placement (AP) Program represents a critical element in HISD's efforts to inject rigor into high school classrooms. Since 2009, the AP course offerings in HISD have been vastly expanded, with

more campuses offering a wider selection of AP courses that exposes a larger percentage of the high school population to academic rigor.

How many students participated in AP exams?






Figure 15. Number of Students Enrolled and Tested, Grades 9–12, 2015–2017

Figure 15 shows the number of students enrolled in grades 9–12 and the number and percentage of students who took an AP exam.

How well did students perform on AP exams?

Each AP Exam is scored from 1 to 5. Students require a score of 3 or higher to "pass" the AP Exam and potentially earn college credit. **Figure 16** (p. 13) shows the number of AP exams taken, the number of exams with a score of 3 or higher, and the percentage of exams with a score of 3 or higher. While the number of exams taken and with a score of 3 or higher have increased steadily, the percentage of exams with a score of 3 or higher has remained relatively flat.

Figure 17 shows the percentage of AP Exams that received a score of 3 or higher by subject. Students who took AP Exams in AP Capstone and World Languages & Culture were most likely to earn a score of 3 or higher.

Figure 17. AP Exam Participation and Performance by Exam Category, Grades 9–12, 2017



International Baccalaureate (IB)

The IB Diploma Programme is a two-year course of study that prepares students for college. The IB Diploma Programme is recognized and accepted by universities around the world. Similar to the AP program, students with high scores on IB Exams can earn college credit or advanced placement at a college or university. Students participating in the IB Diploma Programme are required to take six exams in the following subjects: Literature, Language, Social Science, Experimental Science, Mathematics, and Art. Students may also choose to take individual IB courses and IB exams instead of participating in the full diploma program.

How many students participated in IB exams?

Two HISD high schools participated in the IB Programme through 2015–2016: Bellaire and Lamar High Schools. In 2016–2017, Heights High School also participated in the IB Programme. The total number of students who took IB exams increased to 748 students and the number of exams taken increased to 2,133 in 2016–2017 (**Figure 18**).

How well did students perform on IB exams?





Figure 19. Percentage of IB Exams Scored 4 or higher, 2014–2015 through 2016–2017

Each IB exam is scored from 1 to 7. A score of 4 or higher is required to "pass" the IB exam and potentially earn college credit. **Figure 19** shows that the percentage of IB exams that received a score of 4 or higher has decreased from 2014–2015 through 2016–2017 while the number of exams scored 4 or higher increased over the prior year.

Advanced Course/Dual Credit Completion

In addition to the use of assessments, college readiness can also be determined through enrollment in and completion of advanced and dual credit courses. Advanced courses include AP and IB courses along with other courses designated by the Texas Education Agency. A dual credit course is a college course taken by a high school student where the student earns both college and high school credit, which saves the student money and time toward college degrees before finishing high school. Students must meet certain eligibility requirements in order to participate in dual credit. Students who enroll and perform well in advanced/dual credit courses are not only college-ready but also are college-proven. In 2015–2016, more

than half (56.2 percent) of students enrolled in HISD in grades 11 and 12 had completed at least one advanced/dual credit course in any subject, which is 1.2 percentage points higher than the state (**Figure 20**).






Postsecondary Enrollment




Figure 22. Percentage of Graduates who Enrolled in College Within One Year of Graduation, Classes of 2009–2016

The number of HISD graduates who enroll in college within one year of graduating from high school has increased by 8 percent from 5,338 to 5,778 between the Classes of 2009 and 2016 (**Figure 21**). Fifty-seven percent of the Class of 2016 enrolled in college within one year of graduating from high school, which is lower than the equivalent percentage from the Class of 2009 (63 percent) (**Figure 22**, p. 16).

Conclusion

In 2014, Houston ISD launched its Global Graduate Initiative. The district's and initiative's goal is to ensure that each HISD student graduates ready for the world. The profile of an HISD Global Graduate is one of a leader, a skilled communicator, adaptable and productive, a critical thinker, a responsible decision maker, and a college-ready learner. While this is a relatively new initiative, the goal of preparing students to be college and career ready upon graduation is not a new one for the district, which is why HISD has significantly increased participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009 with the implementation and expansion of programs such as SAT School Day and funding both the cost of PSAT exams for freshmen and sophomores and AP Exams for all students.

These assessments measure a variety of skills and competencies, the mastery of which has proven to correlate with student success in both college and career. These assessments also help to track student preparation and progress. The PSAT 8/9 exam helps outline areas in which students might require additional support and areas in which students have demonstrated proficiency. Such feedback can help students focus their efforts and develop critical skills. It will continue to aid students early on and prepare them for critical exams such as PSAT/NMSQT and SAT.

Definitions of college readiness are quickly encompassing more than just a score on one assessment. In fact, to be considered both college and career ready, students may demonstrate performance on the State

of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness End-of-Course assessments (STAAR EOC), Texas Success Initiative (TSI), SAT, or ACT. Another way to prove college readiness is to take AP, IB, and dual credit courses which provide students with the opportunity to earn both high school and college credit upon course completion. More than half of HISD students enrolled in eleventh and twelfth grade completed one of these courses in 2015–2016.


As the key findings of this report indicate, more HISD students are taking college readiness and entrance assessments, but the participation rates remain relatively flat. Performance on the PSAT 8/9, PSAT/NMSQT, and ACT exams has improved while overall performance on AP exams is mixed and performance on IB exams has gone down as measured by "passing" rates. In addition to a larger number of students taking college readiness assessments, more HISD students are also enrolling in and graduating from college or university. While this is a positive trend, the college enrollment rates upon high school graduation have decreased over time. The data presented in this report indicate that more can be done to increase the number of HISD students equipped to succeed in postsecondary education.




