1. Safety -

IB – PYP Category 1 update – progressing nicely – we are in the process of developing full 6 units of inquiry in each grade level and in enrichment classes. Exhibition preparation is going well – students are excited about their projects. Exhibition will be held May 23. Students will visit the exhibition on May 22 during the school day. Math integration in the IB PYP will continue the rest of this year so we will be ready for next year. August 9-10 is the upcoming PYP Category 1 training.

G/T expo is also on the 23, location will be the Café/PE center. G/T students are required to participate.

STAAR results – 5<sup>th</sup> grade reading is 74% passing, math is 90% passing. Student progress is showing much improvement from last year. 2<sup>nd</sup> administration coming in May.

3. Budget – attendance – 97.3 last year, current is 97.2. PUA based on 933 students. Budget deficit for next year is \$157,149. Personal decisions will be based on this deficit and determination will be based on performance. This will result in cuts. HISD RIF is in place.
