Accreditation Status

The Texas Education Agency announced accreditation statuses for all Texas school districts and charter schools on January 31, 2020, and Houston ISD earned full accreditation status. The accreditation system examines both the financial and academic health of districts and charter schools. It also examines performance in other areas such as data reporting, special program effectiveness, and compliance with statutory and regulatory requirements. Under the accreditation system, ratings of Accredited, Accredited-Warned, Accredited-Probation or Not Accredited-Revoked are issued. The status of a district or charter can be listed as pending if an investigation is under way. The TEA website has more information on the TEA accreditation system.

Due to the impact of COVID-19, accreditation statuses were not issued for 2020-2021.
