Houston ISD is committed to preparing students to be college- and career-ready upon graduation and has made strides to increase participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009.

This College-Bound Report provides a brief synopsis of HISD students' participation in and performance on the 2020–2021 administrations of the PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, PSAT/NMSQT, SAT, Advanced Placement (AP), and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in advanced/dual credit courses and in college upon high school graduation are also presented. For additional information and expanded data disaggregated by demographics, assessment-specific reports can be found on HISD's Research and Accountability website at http://www.houstonisd.org/Domain/8269.

Key findings include:

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, participation on the PSAT, SAT, ACT, and AP exams decreased drastically in the 2020–2021 school year. Therefore, performance comparisons to prior years should be done with caution.
- In 2020–2021, 12,823 students took an AP exam, which was higher than the number in 2019–2020 but still lower than the number of students who took an AP exam in 2017–2018 and 2018–2019. In 2020–2021, 36 percent of the AP exams taken were scored at a 3 or higher, which is lower than the percentage of AP exams scored at a 3 or higher in 2017–2018 and 2018–2019.
- Since 2018–2019, enrollment in the IB program has remained steady. During the COVID-19 pandemic in 2019–2020 and 2020–2021, the district chose the non-testing option, in which grades were given based on the IB-assigned internal assessment that was externally evaluated, predicted grades, and historic data.
- In 2019–2020, 48.0 percent of HISD students enrolled in grades 9–12 completed an advanced/dual credit course, indicating that many HISD high school students are being prepared for college-level work. The rate exceeded the state's rate of 46.3 percent of students.
- HISD continues to see an increasing number of graduates, but in 2020, less than half of the graduates enrolled in college within one year of graduation.

As this is a summary of previously provided data, the district's administrative response to the results of each assessment was provided in the separate reports produced earlier in the year. College-Bound Assessment Report 2020–2021

Executive Summary

Program Description

The Houston Independent School District (HISD) is committed to providing equitable opportunities and resources at every school and preparing students for college upon graduation. Since 2009, HISD has increased participation in college readiness and entrance assessments with the implementation and expansion of programs such as SAT School Day and funding both the cost of PSAT exams to students in grades 8–10 and Advanced Placement (AP) Exams to all students.

This report provides a brief analysis of HISD students' participation in and performance on the 2020–2021 administrations of the PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, and the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) for students in grades 8–11, SAT, AP, and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in advanced/dual credit courses and in college upon high school graduation are also presented.

Highlights

- Although multiple test administrations for the PSAT 8/9 and PSAT 10 were offered during the 2020–2021 school year, participation in the PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, and PSAT/NMSQT dropped by about half from 2019–2020 to 2020–2021. Overall, students from the district scored lower than students from the state and total group.
- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the district's SAT School Day in Spring 2020 was canceled, which likely lowered the participation rate for students in the Class of 2021 to 61 percent.
- HISD participation on the ACT has been low historically, and for the Class of 2021, only 487 students (4 percent of the Class) took the ACT.
- In 2020–2021, 12,823 students took an AP exam, which was higher than the number in 2019–2020 but still lower than the number of students who took an AP exam in 2017–2018 and 2018–2019. In 2020–2021, 36 percent of the AP exams taken were scored at a 3 or higher, which is lower than the percentage of AP exams scored at a 3 or higher in 2017–2018 and 2018–2019.
- Since 2018–2019, enrollment in the IB program has remained steady. During the COVID-19 pandemic
 in 2019–2020 and 2020–2021, the district chose the non-testing option, in which grades were given
 based on the IB-assigned internal assessment that was externally evaluated, predicted grades, and
 historic data.
- In 2019–2020, 48.0 percent of HISD students enrolled in grades 9–12 completed an advanced/dual credit course, indicating that many HISD high school students are being prepared for college-level work. The rate exceeded the state's rate of 46.3 percent of students.

Introduction

Results

PSAT

The PSAT 8/9 is a low-stakes middle school assessment and serves as the first step on the "College Readiness Pathway" preparing 8th and 9th grade students for the PSAT/NMSQT and for the SAT. PSAT 8/9 has two sections: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) and Mathematics.

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) is a national examination administered in October of each year by the College Board and consists of two sections: ERW and Mathematics. The 2015 version was redesigned to coincide with the redesign of the SAT and addition of PSAT 8/9. Prior versions of the PSAT/NMSQT had three sections, testing Critical Reading, Writing, and Mathematics.


The PSAT/NMSQT serves as preparation for the SAT and is a qualifying examination for numerous scholarship programs sponsored by corporations, colleges and universities, and other organizations, including the National Merit scholarships. Students can qualify for these scholarships depending on the score they earn on the exam in their junior year. HISD provides funding so that all students in grades 8–11 can take the PSAT 8/9, the PSAT 10, and the PSAT/NMSQT for free. Additionally, HISD offers Khan Academy to students in order to prepare them for the SAT and SAT Subject Tests. In the 2020–2021 school year, the PSAT 10 was administered to all 10th grade students while in previous years, 10th graders took the PSAT/NMSQT.

How many students participated in the PSAT?

From 2019 to 2020, the number and percentage of students taking the PSAT decreased in all grade levels (**Figures 1–2**, p. 3). During the 2020–2021 school year, 33 percent of eighth graders, 30 percent of ninth graders, 32 percent of tenth graders, and 49 percent of eleventh graders took the PSAT.

Figure 2. PSAT Participation Rate by Grade






How well did students perform on the PSAT?

Scores on the PSAT 8/9 range from 120 to 720 points on each of the two sections for a total score between 240 and 1440. Overall, students in both grades 8 and 9 from the district scored lower compared to students from the state and total group. Students from the district and state scored higher in math than in ERW while students from the total group scored higher in ERW (**Figures 3A–3C**, pp. 3–4).

Figures 3A-3C. Mean PSAT 8/9 Scores of District, State, and Total Group, 2020








Figures 4A–4C display the mean PSAT 10 and PSAT/NMSQT composite and subject scores for the district, state, and total group for fall 2020. Each subject on the PSAT 10 and the PSAT/NMSQT is scored from 160 to 760, and total scores range from 320 to 1520.

Figures 4A-4C. Mean PSAT 10 PSAT/NMSQT Scores of District, State, and Total Group, 2020






The College Board sets College and Career Readiness (CCR) benchmarks for students who took the PSAT. These are the scores that students should meet or exceed to be considered on track to be college or career ready. **Figures 5A–5C** show the proportion of students that met the PSAT 8/9 benchmarks. A lower percentage of students from the district met both PSAT 8/9 benchmarks compared to students from the state and total group. A higher percentage of students met the PSAT 8/9 ERW benchmark compared to the mathematics benchmark from the district, state, and total group.

Figures 5A-5C. Percentage of District, State, and Total Group Meeting PSAT 8/9 CCR Benchmarks, 2020










Figures 5D–5F show the proportion of students who met the PSAT 10 and PSAT/NMSQT benchmarks. A lower percentage of students from the district met both benchmarks compared to students from the state and total group. A higher percentage of students met the ERW benchmark compared to the mathematics benchmark from the district, state, and total group.

SAT

The SAT is a college-entrance exam developed by the College Board that measures developed verbal and mathematical reasoning abilities related to successful performance in college. The test was redesigned in March 2016 to only include two sections: ERW and Mathematics. The data presented in this section reflect performance of graduating seniors for each year, as self-reported by students to the College Board when they took the exam.

How many students participated in the SAT?




Figure 6. HISD SAT Exam Participation, Classes of 2010–2021

Figure 6 shows that the number and percentage of seniors in HISD taking the SAT. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the district's SAT School Day in Spring 2020 was canceled, which likely lowered the participation rate to 61 percent for students in the Class of 2021.






How well did students perform on the SAT?


Figures 7A–7C. Mean SAT Scores of District, State, and Total Group, Classes of 2018–2021

Each subject on the SAT is scored from 200 to 800, and composite scores on the redesigned exam range from 400 to 1600. **Figures 7A–7C** (p. 8) show average subject scores for HISD students compared to the state and the total group, which includes international testers. Because the participation rate was much lower for the Class of 2021, caution should be taken when comparing performance results to results from previous years.




7C. SAT Mean Mathematics Score

The College Board sets college readiness benchmarks for the SAT to predict students' chance of success in college. Because the participation rate was much lower for the Class of 2021, caution should be taken when comparing performance results to results from previous years (**Figures 8A–8C**, p. 9).

ACT

The ACT is a college admissions exam that tests four subjects: English, Math, Reading, and Science. The ACT is offered six times per year and is typically taken by juniors and seniors. The data presented in this

section reflect performance of graduating seniors for each year, as self-reported by students when they took the exam.

How many students participated in the ACT?

Figure 9 indicates that only 487 students from the Class of 2021 took the ACT, which is four percent of the class. Participation on the ACT has declined since 2016.



How well did students perform on the ACT?




Figures 10A–10E. Average ACT Scores of District, State, and National Students, Classes of 2018–2021

Each subject on the ACT is scored from 1 to 36, and composite scores are an average of scores earned on the four subjects. **Figures 10A–10E** (p. 11) show that HISD's overall scores continue to increase and outpace those of the state and nation although the participation rate from the Class of 2021 was exceptionally low.

The ACT has also identified college readiness benchmarks. A student who earns or exceeds scores of 18 in English, 22 in Math, 22 in Reading, and 23 in Science is considered to be ready to succeed in college courses after high school. **Figures 11A–11E** show the proportion of students who met the benchmarks by subject from the Classes of 2018 through 2021.

Advanced Placement (AP)

The College Board's AP Program provides participating high school students with the opportunity to take college-level courses and earn college credit, advanced placement, or both. A total of 38 examinations in Arts, Capstone (new in 2014–2015), English, History and Social Science, Mathematics and Computer Science, Sciences, and World Languages and Cultures are administered in May. The AP Program represents a critical element in HISD's efforts to inject rigor into high school classrooms. Since 2009, the

AP course offerings in HISD have been vastly expanded, with more campuses offering a wider selection of AP courses that exposes a larger percentage of the high school population to academic rigor.

How many students participated in AP exams?

Figure 12 shows the number of students enrolled in grades 9–12 and the number and percentage of students who took at least one AP exam. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, AP exam participation was lower in 2019–2020 and 2020–2021.

Figure 12. Number of Students Enrolled and Tested, Grades 9-12, 2017-2018 through 2020-2021



How well did students perform on AP exams?

Each AP exam is scored from 1 to 5. Students require a score of 3 or higher to "pass" the AP exam and potentially earn college credit. **Figure 13** shows the number of AP exams taken, the number of exams with a score of 3 or higher, and the percentage of exams with a score of 3 or higher.

Table 1 shows the percentage of AP Exams that received a score of 3 or higher by subject. Students who took AP Exams in AP Capstone, World Languages & Culture, and Arts were most likely to earn a score of 3 or higher.


International Baccalaureate (IB)

The IB Diploma Programme is a two-year course of study that prepares students for college and is recognized and accepted by universities around the world. Similar to the AP program, students with high scores on IB Exams can earn college credit or advanced placement at a college or university. Students participating in the IB Diploma Programme are required to take six exams in the following subjects: Literature, Language, Social Science, Experimental Science, Mathematics, and Art. Students may also choose to take individual IB courses and IB exams instead of participating in the full diploma program.

How many students participated in IB exams?

Two HISD high schools participated in the IB Programme through 2015–2016: Bellaire and Lamar High Schools. In 2016–2017, Heights High School also participated in the IB Programme, and in 2018–2019, Chavez High School joined. **Figure 14** shows the number of exams taken and the number of students tested over the past four years. In 2019–2020 and 2020–2021, the district chose the non-testing option, in which grades were given based on coursework, predicted grades, and historic data.

How well did students perform on IB exams?

Each IB exam is scored from 1 to 7. A score of 4 or higher is required to "pass" the IB exam and potentially earn college credit. **Figure 15** shows that the percentage of IB exams that received a score of 4 or higher. In 2019–2020 and 2020–2021, the district chose the non-testing option, in which grades were given based on the IB-assigned internal assessment that was externally evaluated, predicted grades, and historic data.

Advanced Course/Dual Credit Completion

In addition to the use of assessments, college readiness can also be determined through enrollment in and completion of advanced and dual credit courses. Advanced courses include AP and IB courses along with other courses designated by the Texas Education Agency. A dual credit course is a college course taken by a high school student where the student earns both college and high school credit, which saves the student money and time toward college degrees before finishing high school. Students must meet certain eligibility requirements in order to participate in dual credit. Students who enroll and perform well in advanced/dual credit courses are not only college-ready but also are college-proven. In 2019–2020 (most current state data available), 48.0 percent of HISD students in grades 9–12 had completed at least one advanced/dual credit course in any subject, which exceeded the state (**Figure 16**, p. 16).

Postsecondary Enrollment




Figure 17. Number of Seniors, Graduates, College Enrollees in the Fall and Within One Year of Graduation, and Degree-Earners, Classes of 2013–2020




Figure 18. Percentage of Graduates Enrolled in College in the Fall, Within One Year After Graduation, and Earning a College Degree Within Six Years After High School Graduation, Classes of 2013–2020

The number of HISD graduates who enrolled in college within one year of graduating from high school increased to 6,246 in 2019 but dropped in 2020 (**Figure 17**). The percentage of students enrolling in college within one year of graduation has declined since 2013 (**Figure 18**, p. 17).

Conclusion

Houston ISD is committed to preparing students to be college- and career-ready upon graduation. A number of initiatives, such as the Global Graduate Initiative in 2014, has helped garner momentum around equipping high school students. In addition, HISD has significantly increased participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009 with the implementation and expansion of programs such as SAT School Day and funding both the cost of PSAT exams for students in grades 8–11 and AP Exams for all students.

These assessments measure a variety of skills and competencies, the mastery of which has proven to correlate with student success in both college and career. These assessments also help to track student preparation and progress. The PSAT 8/9 and PSAT 10 exams help outline areas in which students might require additional support and areas in which students have demonstrated proficiency. Such feedback can help students focus their efforts and develop critical skills. It will continue to aid students early on and prepare them for critical exams such as PSAT/NMSQT and SAT.

Definitions of college readiness are quickly encompassing more than just a score on one assessment. In fact, to be considered both college and career ready, students may demonstrate performance on the Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSI-A), SAT, or ACT. Another way to prove college readiness is to take AP, IB, and dual credit courses which provide students with the opportunity to earn both high school and college credit upon course completion. Forty-eight percent of HISD students enrolled in grades 9–12 completed one of these courses in 2019–2020.

As the key findings of this report indicate, HISD students are taking college readiness and entrance assessments, but the participation rates remain relatively flat. In addition to COVID-19, some colleges have removed standardized tests as an admission criterion in the last few years, which may have also impacted

participation rates. Performance on the AP and IB exams has improved while overall performance on the SAT exam has decreased. Performance on the PSAT varied by grade level. 
In addition to a large number of students taking college readiness assessments, more HISD students are also graduating. While this is a positive trend, the college enrollment rates upon high school graduation have decreased over time. The data presented in this report indicate that more can be done to increase the number of HISD students equipped to succeed in postsecondary education.


