  - Scheduling:

- Graphic Design and Interactive Media: courses capped at 35 students max. Practicum course should be scheduled towards end of day to allow opportunity for partnering with industry.
- Entrepreneurship: courses capped at 35 students max. Current <u>interested</u> 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> grade students in Principles of Business Marketing, and Finance course should transition to Foundations of User Experience course. The current 63 students (grades 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>) in Entrepreneurship should transition to Foundations of User Experience. Current 28 students (10<sup>th</sup> -11<sup>th</sup> grade) in Entrepreneurship II should transition to Foundations of User Experience.
- Networking: courses capped at 35 students max. The FPOS courses will be phased-in over three years. Students in grade 9 who have already earned credit for Principles of Information Technology in middle school should be placed into Internetworking Technology I course. Rising sophomores interested in the Networking FPOS should be enrolled into both Principles of Information Technology and Internetworking courses.
