### **What is Name That Book?**

Name That Book is an HISD competition sponsored by the Department of Library Services. Two teams are formed made up of students in grades K-2 and 3-5. Each team works together to read and study a list of 25 books. At the district competition in March, teams are given quotes or clues and work together to name the book that the quote came from. This year, the competitions will have to be virtual, taking place over Teams. If you love to read, have a good memory for detail, and can dedicate time to reading and rereading the books on the list, you may enjoy Name That Book!

### **How do I try out for Name That Book?**

Begin by **reading the 10 highlighted tryout books on the book list**. The list includes all 25 titles, but we will start by choosing 10 to use for the initial qualifying test. We choose 6-8 students to join Name That Book. **I do not recommend buying books unless you really want them!** Both the Houston Public Libraries and the Bellaire Library have a Name That Book section, and you should be able to find most of the books there or as a digital e-book, though there may be a wait list. Once students have returned the tryout form, they will be allowed to check out one book at a time from the Lovett library, as often as needed to prepare for tryouts, as soon as they are in stock. All of the picture books also have read-aloud videos on Youtube. Listening is just as good, if not better, for some students!

**3-5 try-outs will take place on Monday, November 18 from 3:00-3:45.** I will read quotes aloud and students will record their answer on an answer sheet. Results will be emailed to parents by the end of the day on Wednesday, October 30, and a paper letter will be sent home as well. **You must complete the form on the back and return it to Mrs. Warner by Friday, November 15 to be able to try out.**

### **What will the time commitment be?**

Students selected for the team will have one meeting each week from 3:00-3:45 beginning on Monday, December 2. **Please know that there will also be a significant amount of reading time at home.** Students will be expected to read some books multiple times.
