Minutes

Principal Niggli started the meeting at 4:30 pm. He summarized the building condition after the winter storm. The TED hall suffered broken pipes and room 1102 flooded. There were smaller leaks in the athletics wing near the boys' locker room. The main water line at 34th street leading into the school broke as well and needed an intensive repair. Surveys are being taken to determine families in need. Wraparound services will assist in helping once the results are in.

Senior updates included plans being developed for a Saturday School to assist students with credit recovery. Graduation is scheduled for June 13th at 11 am at Delmar. There are no plans for a prom. A senior card parade will take place.

Curriculum updates: Niggli reported that planning for implementation of 3DE by Junior Achievement involvement in the new Business Management pathway is coming along. Planning meetings are every two weeks. There have been teacher information sessions and building logistic shave been worked out. 3DE teachers will be on the second floor next year. A second hourly lecturer has been added for the remainder of the year to focus on the growing English Learner population at Waltrip, which has gone up 6% in the past two years.

Niggli shared that COVID Rapid testing for students now available with parent consent. The form was emailed to parents. Waltrip has a vacancy for a health science teacher. The hiring freeze was lifted for the 2021-22 school year.
