Draw a picture of yourself. Write at least 10 strengths all around the image



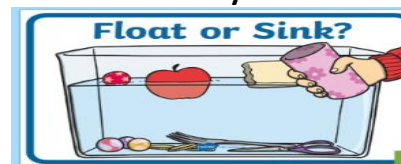
