New Courses for 2019-2020

We will be offering guitar and handbells next year for Fine Arts credit. If you are interested in switching one of your requested courses to take one of these new courses, please make sure you use verification 2 to make that change.

What are courses designated with a code 99?

When for whatever reason a student is not awarded credit for a course they are enrolled in, the course must be completed before credit will be awarded. So why would a student not be awarded credit?

- The student did not pass the class, in which case the class must be retaken.
- The student passed the class but failed to attend enough of the class periods to gain credit - absent more than 10% of the class periods but less than 25% of the classes. The student may attend credit appeal to gain credit.
 - The student passed the class but failed to attend enough of the class periods to gain credit - absent more than 25% of the class periods. The student must complete the course on Apex (Grad Lab) to gain credit for the course.

These are added to the bottom of the schedule and listed as a course with a code 99. Until all 99s are cleared, a student will be unable to graduate. Your student may have received information about summer school, or about credit appeal if the student was absent for no more than 25% of the class periods and currently has an NG on the report card or transcript.

Students with 99s that don't qualify for credit appeal (because the student was absent for more than 25% of the class periods), or because the student did not receive a passing grade, must complete the course and be awarded credit before the end of summer school. Students who do not make adequate gain on recovering credit through credit appeal or summer school, may be re-seated in the face-to-face class in the fall semester. Students who are re-seated will likely be in danger of not graduating on time.

If your student receives information about summer school or credit appeal, it is critical they attend and work diligently toward recovering/restoring credit for the course(s).

*Students will enter via the floor access doors, on the AMERGY Bank Entrance side. Guests will proceed up the ramp on the AMERGY Bank Entrance.

*At the end of the ceremony, students will exit via the Ford Entrance.

Graduation is an optional activity. If you choose to participate, proper attire **must** be worn. Proper attire is:

- The mortarboard (cap) should sit FLAT on the head, not tilted at an angle. All
 hairstyles should allow the mortarboard to sit correctly on the head. A
 decorated mortarboard (cap) is not allowed and will be confiscated upon
 entry.
- Gentlemen must wear a collared shirt, with a tie, dark slacks and dress shoes.Dark shoes are best.
- Young ladies should wear dresses, skirts, or dress slacks. Please avoid high heels. They can be a hazard on the ramps as ladies walk across the stage.
- Jeans, shorts, flip-flops, and tennis shoes of any kind are not acceptable.
 If you wear these items, you will not be permitted to participate in graduation exercises.
- No electronics of any kind will be permitted in the stage area. Seniors will be screened for them before entry.

Family and friends will be admitted for seating at 7:30 AM in NRG Stadium. Early arrival is advised to ensure best seating. No one may block off seats for guests arriving later. There are no tickets needed for graduation. Handicap seating is available; please check with a representative upon entering for assistance. Metal detectors will be used for everyone's safety.

No balloons, banners, air horns or items that distract from the ceremony will be allowed. Security will confiscate these items. This is a solemn and dignified event, and we ask that all families be respectful and attentive as each student graduates. All graduates must leave cameras, purses, cell phones and other personal items outside or with family members. Graduates may bring only their cap and gown into the stadium with them. Caps and gowns must be carried through the security checkpoint and may not be worn as they enter the facility. All Graduates must stay for the entire ceremony.
