Spring Final Exemptions

Who Qualifies? Students may be exempt from final exams if they meet the conditions identified below. Freshmen may be exempt from one exam, sophomores and juniors may be exempt from two exams, and seniors may be exempt from all exams;

- The student may not have more than 3 absences in any one class; and
- The student must have an E or S in conduct, with no discipline referrals; and
- The student must have an 85 average or better for any class in which they wish to be exempt from the final exam.

When do I select? Students who qualify will receive a message from Deans and Assistant Principals sent to their school email. The email will include a link in which students can submit which finals they wish to be exempt from. Seniors need to have submitted requests by 5/21. Juniors, Sophomores, and Freshmen need to have submitted requests by 5/26.

How do I know if my exemption was approved? A message will be sent to students on Teams confirming their selected exemptions. If a student doesn't qualify for a class, they will be notified in the message. Messages will be sent during the students dead week.

How will attendance and graded impact my eligibility after I am notified? If a student's absences exceed 3 after the notification the exemptions will be removed. If a grade in a class selected for exemption drops below 85, the exemption will be removed

- Are more likely to stay away from drugs and alcohol
- Do better in school
- Get along better with family and friends
- Feel better about themselves

To be involved, Littles should:

- Be capable of benefitting from a relationship with a Big
- Attend school regularly
- Want a Big and understand the role of a Big
- Plan on attending the participating school for at least one full year
- Have a parent/guardian willing to be a partner with us by maintaining contact and helping keep us informed of changes within the family/match
- Have access to internet and Zoom for virtual meetings

All students 9th through 11th grade are required to switch out their laptops before June 4,2021. 
