# **Principal's Corner**



What are IB Exams and How are the Scored?

The IB Diploma Program (IBDP) examinations are beginning! If students are enrolled in IBDP courses, they will be taking the paper exams for those courses over the next month. Most courses have 2-3 paper exams, all of which are mandatory to attend if the student is testing in that subject. Juniors cannot test in more than 2 IBDP subjects.

The exams form the basis of the assessment for most IBDP courses. The exams take many forms, including essays, structured problems, short-response questions, data-response questions, text-response questions, case-study questions, and (rarely) multiple-choice questions.

Assessment for most IB Diploma subjects is made up of several components (e.g. multiple <u>paper exams</u> taken during May, <u>externally assessed work</u> completed during the course, <u>internally assessed work</u> completed during the course, and/or creative <u>portfolios</u>). Each of these is scored and combined to produce a subject grade (1-7). A score of 4 is generally considered "passing". Though every university has different policies, college credit can be earned at many universities for IB courses in which a student earns a 4 or higher. Senior IB Diploma Candidates will be awarded the IB Diploma if they earn 24 total points from their 6 different Diploma subjects and fulfil all other program requirements.

Graduation is an optional activity. If you choose to participate, proper attire **must** be worn. Proper attire is:

- 1. The mortarboard (cap) should sit FLAT on the head, not tilted at an angle. All hairstyles should allow the mortarboard to sit correctly on the head. A decorated mortarboard (cap) is not allowed and will be confiscated upon entry.
- Gentlemen must wear a collared shirt, with a tie, dark slacks and dress shoes. Dark shoes are best.
- 3. Young ladies should wear dresses, skirts, or dress slacks. Please avoid high heels. They can be a hazard on the ramps as ladies walk across the stage. Also, there is a lot of walking so comfortable shoes are preferred.
- 4. <u>Jeans, shorts, flip-flops, and tennis shoes of any kind</u> are not acceptable. If you wear these items, you will not be permitted to participate in graduation exercises.
- No electronics of any kind will be permitted in the stage area. Seniors will be screened for them before entry.

Security will confiscate these items. This is a solemn and dignified event, and we ask that all families be respectful and attentive as each student graduates.

All graduates must leave cameras, purses, cell phones and other personal items outside or with family members. Graduates may bring only their cap and gown into the stadium with them. Caps and gowns must be carried through the security checkpoint and may not be worn as they enter the facility. All Graduates <u>must</u> stay for the entire ceremony.
