The ACT results for Houston Independent School District (HISD) 2021–2022 have been released by ACT, Inc. and are provided in this memo. The ACT consists of four subject area tests and a composite score. The four subject area tests include: English, mathematics, reading, and science. In addition to subject scores, ACT has created College Readiness Benchmarks (CR), revised in 2013, that represent the minimum scores needed on an ACT subject-area test to indicate a 50 percent chance of obtaining a B or higher or about a 75 percent chance of obtaining a C or higher in the corresponding credit-bearing college courses. Scores on the ACT subject tests range from 1–36. This assessment is optional at HISD, which accounts for the lower participation rate.

Key findings include:

- In 2021–2022 755 students from HISD took the ACT an overall decline since 2018 (1,899).
- The average ACT composite score of 23.8 for the district reflects a gradual increase since 2018 (22.1). The district's average ACT scores in each subject area have increased since 2018.
- Forty-two percent of HISD testers in 2021–2022 met all four college readiness benchmarks, reflecting an increase of three percentage points from the prior year. District percentages of students who met all four college readiness benchmarks have shown an increase from 2018 to 2022.
- ACT performance varied greatly among campuses. The average composite scores ranged from 14.4 to 28.3, and the percentage of students who met all four college-ready benchmarks ranged from 0 to 75.7 percent.
