

# U.S. ARMY RESERVE INNOVATION COMMAND MINUTEMAN SCHOLARSHIP

## 100% Tuition, Monthly Stipend, Books and Pay

### FROM THE COMMANDER,

The U.S. Army Reserve Innovation Command is looking for highly qualified HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS and COLLEGE STUDENTS that are interested in careers in the Army Reserve to sponsor for Minuteman Scholarships. The skills gained from Army ROTC and ultimately, as an officer in the Army Reserve, will set you apart from your peers in school and your civilian careers. No matter which path you follow to become an Army Reserve officer, you'll gain the opportunity to excel as an individual and as a leader.

### WHAT IS THE MINUTEMAN SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Minuteman program is a Reserve Officer's Training Corps Guaranteed Reserve Forces Duty scholarship. All qualified applicants for ROTC scholarships may apply for consideration for a Minuteman. The scholarship covers full tuition and fees (uncapped) or \$10,000 per year toward room and board at any college or university served by an Army ROTC program. Scholarship recipients also receive a yearly book allowance of \$1,200 and a monthly stipend of \$420 while attending school enrolled in the ROTC program. Scholarship recipients must serve in the Simultaneous Membership Program, in which they participate in an Army Reserve unit's monthly drills and a 14-day annual training for which they are paid as an E-5/ Sergeant. After graduation and commissioning, Scholarship recipients are guaranteed placement in the Army Reserve. Reserve assignments will be based on cadets geographic preference.

### REQUIREMENTS

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Between ages of 17-30\*
- Valid Chapter 2 MEPS physical
- Currently in the Army Reserve or eligible for enlistment
- Ability to pass Army Physical Fitness Test (APFT)
- Meet Army Physical standards (AR600-9)
- Receive Major Subordinate Command Commander Endorsement
- Acceptance letter to a college or university with a ROTC program
- 19 ACT, 1000 SAT or 2.5 or higher College GPA
- Participate in Simultaneous Membership Program

*\* Must not turn age 31 by Dec. 31st of commissioning year*

### MINUTEMAN SCHOLARSHIPS BENEFITS

- Choose from 2, 3, or 4 year scholarships
- Choose 100% Tuition and Fees or \$10,000 in Room and Board.
- Receive \$420 a month ROTC stipend
- Receive a yearly book allowance of \$1,200
- Earn E-5/Sergeants pay while serving as an SMP with a Reserve unit close to school/home.
- Prior Service cadets may use MGIB on 2 year scholarship.
- Prior Service may use Post 9/11 benefits for all scholarships if eligible.
- Available to Graduate students (Receive up to a 2YR scholarship)
- While serving as an SMP you qualify for Low-Cost Tricare Health and dental care
- Guaranteed a commission in the USAR
