- 1. Celebrations: Our MOCK results were very good. We are several points away from an A. We have 35 students who need to improve to meets or masters to get there. I'm confident that we will move forward and get to that goal.
- 2. Enrollment: We are currently at our lowest enrollment since I've been here. We currently have a total of 604 students. We need to recruit more students. We have received some students from other countries, which is good, but we need to continue with our recruitment efforts and our Pre-K enrollments. Our projection for next year is 565. This is about \$150,000 less that we will have for next year. We have a couple of teachers that will not be returning, and we will be closing these two positions. We are funding two positions through ESSER.
- 3. TTESS- Before the end of the year I will be giving a presentation of what TTESS will include. We will be working and collaborating a lot closer together in order to better support our students.
- 4. Technology- We are responsible for technology now. Everything will have to be purchased by the school. If you have any TOL devices, please turn those to us.
- 5. School Supply List- It is that time of year to turn in your supply list for next school year. Please go ahead and start working on those to turn in later. I will post a message on the Falcon news for the due date.
- 6. Summer School- Will be \$40 an hour. Several of you have applied and we will be sharing the campus with Carrillo Elementary. Next week you should review what grade level you will be teaching. Please ensure that you invite students who need to be here.
- 7. Budget- Instructional Resources. Please make a list of items that you really need and turn that in so that we may start ordering.
