SUBJECT: APRIL 2012 HISD TAKS EXIT-LEVEL PERFORMANCE OF RETESTERS

The Houston Independent School District (HISD) received the results from the April 2012 administration of the TAKS Exit-Level Exam. This was a special exam only offered to eleventh and twelfth-grade HISD students who had not yet passed each or any of the TAKS subtests (English/language arts, math, social studies, and science) during the prior administrations. The data presented provide a status report identifying the number of students by subject who still need to pass the TAKS to graduate. The next testing opportunity will be during the week of July 9–12, 2012.

There were 422 eleventh-grade students who were expected to be tested during the April 2012 administration of the TAKS Exit-Level Exam. Of these students, 341 were actually tested, 21 were counted as absent, and 60 were not tested due to other reasons. There were 1,046 twelfth-graders who were expected to be tested during the April 2012 administration of the TAKS Exit-Level Exam. Of these students, 890 were actually tested, 13 students were counted as absent, and 142 were not tested for other reasons. The results from an analysis of the performance of students who were administered the exam at the districtwide and school levels are presented in the following summary and attached tables.

Table 1 provides HISD student performance for the 2012 April TAKS Exit-Level exams by subtests, for grades eleven and twelve. The results are presented for the following demographic groups: all students, racial/ethnic subgroups, economically disadvantaged students, limited English proficient students, and those students served by Special Education. The districtwide results from Table 1 examine the number of eleventh and twelfth-grade students retesting on the April Exit-Level TAKS, the percent of these students that met the state's passing standard, and the number of students who failed to meet the state's passing standard.

All Students-Eleventh Grade

- On the 2012 April administration of the TAKS Exit-Level Exam, 341 eleventh-grade students took at least one subject test. Of these students, 21 percent met the standard on all subject tests they took. These students have now met the TAKS graduation requirement. Conversely, 269 of those students tested still have failed at least one TAKS test needed to graduate. This compares to 236 juniors not having passed TAKS at this time in 2011.
- The highest passing rate for all eleventh graders was in social studies at 51 percent, followed by English/Language Arts at 39 percent. The lowest passing rate for all eleventh-grade retesters was in mathematics, where 20 percent of the students assessed met the passing standard. Mathematics also had the highest number of retesters with 243, followed by science, with 221.






All Students-Twelfth Grade

- On the April 2012 administration of the TAKS Exit-Level Exam, 890 twelfth-grade students took at least one subject test. Of these students, 27 percent passed all subject tests they took. These students have met the TAKS requirements for graduation. Conversely, 654 of the seniors tested still have failed at least one TAKS test needed to graduate. This compares to 769 seniors at this time in 2011 not having passed TAKS.
- The highest passing rate for twelfth graders was in social studies where 46 percent of the students assessed met the passing standard. The lowest passing rate was in mathematics, where 21 percent of the 520 twelfth-grade students assessed met the passing standard. After the April 2012 retest, 409 seniors still have not passed the mathematics exam, and 309 have not passed the science exam.

Figure 1 shows the district percents passing for both grade levels by subject, and **Figures 2 and 3** present the number tested and the number failing for grades 11 and 12 by subject.







Results by Number of Tests Taken

Districtwide results for eleventh and twelfth-grade students by the number of tests taken for the April 2012 Exit-Level TAKS retest are presented in **Table 2**.

- Total
- On the April 2012 exit-level retest, 148 of the 341 eleventh-graders tested only took one subject test and 34 percent met the passing standard. Of the eleventh-grade students who took two or more tests, the percents passing ranged from 7 percent to 15 percent.
- For twelfth-grade students, 517 of the 890 seniors taking the April 2012 exit-level retest only took one subject test, and 39 percent met the passing standard. Of the twelfth-grade students who took two or more tests, the percents passing ranged from 8 percent to 11 percent.

School-Level Results

School-level results for eleventh and twelfth-grade students for the April 2012 Exit-Level TAKS retest are presented in **Table 3**, with Apollo campus results in **Tables 4 and 5** (see attachment). Additional graphs by campus can be found in **Appendix A** and results for Apollo campuses can be found in **Appendix B**. The passing standard for retesting students is the state standard that was applicable on the exit-level test during the student's first attempt on the test. The school-level results include the number taking, the percent passing, and the number that did not meet the passing standard for each subject.




























Appendix B: 2011 and 2012 TAKS April TAKS Exit Retest Results for Apollo Schools
