Superintendent of SchoolsSUBJECT: **DISTRICT AND SCHOOL RESULTS OF THE STUDENT SUCCESS INITIATIVE FROM THE APRIL 2007 MATH TAKS ADMINISTRATION FOR GRADE 5**

This report supersedes the April 23, 2007 report. School and administrative district data have been added for a complete analysis of the district's results.

Enacted by the 76th Texas Legislature in 1999, the Student Success Initiative's (SSI) goal is to ensure that all students receive the instruction and support they need to be academically successful in reading and mathematics. Grade advancement requirements were applied to the Grade 3 reading test starting in 2002–03, and to the Grade 5 reading and mathematics tests beginning with the 2004–05 school year. The SSI requirements will be phased in for the Grade 8 reading and mathematics tests beginning in the 2007–08 school year. As specified by these requirements, a student may advance to the next grade level only by passing these tests or by unanimous decision of his or her grade placement committee that the student is likely to perform at grade level after additional instruction.

The first administration of the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) mathematics test to students in fifth grade was given on April 3, 2007. If unsuccessful after the first administration, students will receive additional state-mandated instruction and will take the math test again on May 15, 2007. A Grade Placement Committee (GPC) will address students unsuccessful on the second administration of the reading and/or math sections of the TAKS. The GPC will create an educational plan based on the instructional needs of each student. These students will be given a third opportunity to pass the TAKS during summer school on June 26, 2007. Fifth-grade students who do not pass the reading and math TAKS after the third opportunity will automatically be retained. However, parents can appeal these results to the GPC, and the committee may decide to promote an individual student if there is consensus that the student is likely to succeed in the next grade.

Results

The TAKS math districtwide results are presented in this memo with region and school-level data provided in the attachment. Third and fifth-grade reading results were distributed previously, but are shown in the attachment. **Tables 1 and 2** present the math results from the April 2007 English and Spanish TAKS for overall student performance and for student groups. The 2006 TAKS first administration results are provided for comparison purposes.

- For the Student Success Initiative, the most pragmatic comparison involves contrasting student performance on the passing standards for the past two years. Expressly, 74% of HISD fifth graders met the passing standard on the English math TAKS in April of 2006, while 81% met the passing standard in April of 2007. The remaining 2,406 fifth-graders, who did not pass, will take the math TAKS again in May.
- Each student group from April 2007 exhibited an increase in passing rates when the results of 2007 were compared with the 2006 results, except the White student group which remained the same. The largest increase was the African American students who increased by 9 percentage points.
- Although the percent commended increased for all fifth-grade students on the math TAKS from 29% in 2006 to 33% in 2007, the largest increase was exhibited by LEP students with an increase of 6 percentage points. White students decreased performance by 2 percentage points.
- The average scale scores improved from 2006 to 2007 for all students from 2239 to 2276. Improvement in scale scores was found for each student group except the White student group which showed the same scale scores as the 2006 administration.

- On the Spanish TAKS, expressly, 56% of HISD fifth graders met the Spanish TAKS passing standard in April of 2006, while 49% met the passing standard on the first administration in 2007. The remaining 40 students who did not pass will be tested again in May.
- The percent of fifth-grade students taking the Spanish TAKS math test that reached the commended level decreased from 15% in spring 2006 to 14% in April 2007 for all students. The average scale score for all students decreased by 72 points.

The results from the April 2007 English and Spanish TAKS are presented in **Table 3** as the percentage of fifth-grade students passing math at the state standard and percent commended. Districtwide performance is compared to statewide results for overall student performance and for student groups.

- On the April 2007 TAKS first administration, the state had a higher overall passing rate with 85% of fifth graders passing the English math TAKS compared to the HISD passing rate of 81%.
- White fifth graders attending HISD schools had a higher passing rate in math, 94%, than the statewide rate, 92%. HISD limited English proficient students out performed the state by four percentage points. The state's passing rate was higher, or equal to HISD's for all the other student groups in 2007.
- For the 2007 English math TAKS, the state had a higher overall commended rate, with 39% of the fifth graders performing at that level, compared to the HISD commended rate of 33%. White HISD students reached the commended level at a higher rate than the state with a rate of 57% compared to the state rate of 51%.
- On the April 2007 first administration Spanish TAKS, HISD fifth-grade students performed one percentage point below the state cohort in math. Specifically, the HISD

passing rate for all fifth-grade students taking the Spanish TAKS was 49% as compared to the state passing rate of 50%.

- On the Spanish version of the fifth-grade TAKS math, HISD students out-performed the statewide level of commended performance. Specifically, the HISD commended rate for all fifth-grade students taking the Spanish TAKS was 14%, as compared to the state commended rate of 11%.

Charts graphically depicting the above information are provided as attachments. Two years of HISD and state performance on TAKS math are compared for the fifth grade. Charts are presented for the percent passing and percent commended. School-level results are also included in the attached tables. Third-grade and fifth-grade reading and fifth-grade math results from the 2006 first administration of the TAKS in English and Spanish are presented. The following notable results were found.

- On the English fifth-grade math TAKS, 45 of the 180 schools, or 25%, with five or more students tested, had a passing rate of approximately 90% or better. Three schools, Burrus, T. H. Rogers, and Wharton Elementary School, had a passing rate of 100% on this first administration.
- On the Spanish fifth-grade math TAKS, 1 of the 2 schools, with five or more students tested, had a passing rate of approximately 90% or better. Burnet Elementary school had a passing rate of 92%.

Students who did not pass the fifth-grade math test in April will have two additional opportunities to pass the test to meet the state promotion standard requirements under the SSI. Fifth graders will also have to pass the TAKS reading test under the SSI to be promoted to the sixth grade.





